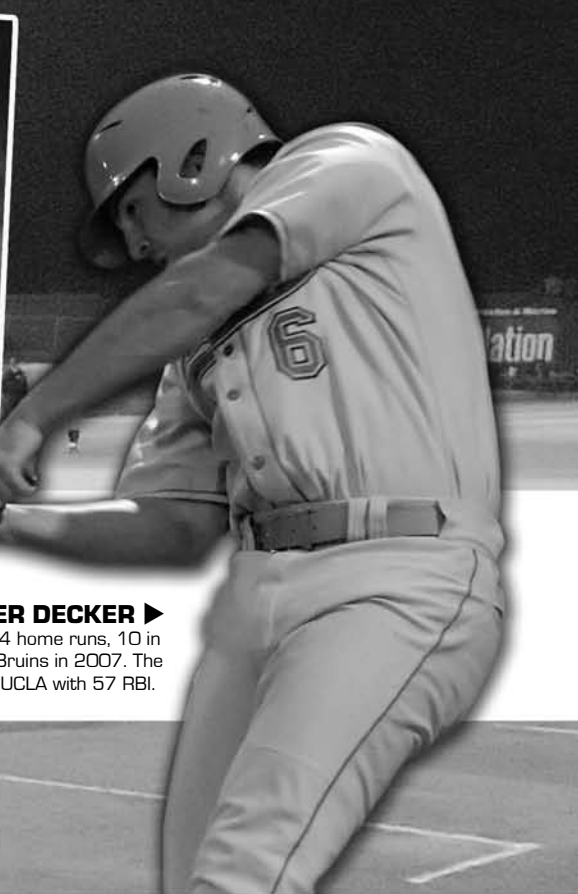
Tim Murphy hurled a complete game victory in the Long Beach Regional final, sending off a well-deserved Bruin celebration at Blair Field on June 3.





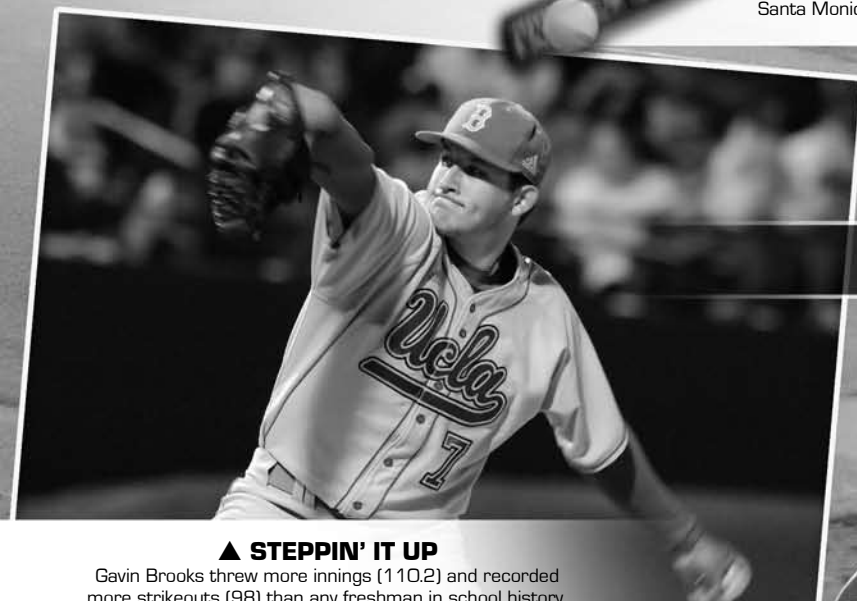
▲ BRUIN BACKSTOP
