UCLA HEADS TO DESERT, FACES NO. 3 ARIZONA STATE

Bruins seek strong Pac-10 finish at Arizona State with three regular-season games remaining

LOS ANGELES – UCLA opens a three-game Pac-10 series at No. 3 Arizona State for the final weekend of regular-season action this spring. At third place in the Pac-10 standings, the Bruins look to improve their conference resume in Tempe, Ariz., this weekend. Last May, UCLA dropped the series opener to the Sun Devils at Jackie Robinson Stadium, 10-5, before rebounding with an 8-3 win in the series' second contest. UCLA absorbed an 8-7 loss to Arizona State in the series finale. The Bruins currently trail first-place Arizona State by five games in the Pac-10 standings.

UCLA AT A GLANCE

- UCLA has played the nation's No. 1 most difficult strength of schedule (as projected by Boyd's World).
- UCLA has gone 7-5 in three-game weekend series (including 3-3 series record in weekend road trips).
- UCLA has played 16 games against top-25 RPI opponents (11 road, 3 home, 2 neutral site contests).
- UCLA's schedule has featured 22 games against top-50 RPI teams, the highest total on the West Coast.
- UCLA leads the Pac-10 in games played and victories against top-25 ranked teams (Baseball America poll).
- UCLA has gone 24-17 since March 10, as its 56-game schedule features 30 games away from home.
- UCLA has played four series versus potential national No. 1 postseason seeds (ASU, CSF, ECU, OKLA).
- UCLA's pitching staff leads the conference in strikeouts (488) and ranks fourth in team ERA (4.24).

THIS WEEKEND'S SERIES

UCLA enters the final weekend of the regular season having gone 13-8 through its last 21 games. The Bruins currently rank fourth in the Pac-10 Conference in team batting average (.287) and team ERA (4.24). Since opening the season 2-10, UCLA has rebounded with a 24-17 record in its last 41 contests. Arizona State enters the weekend series ranking second in team batting average (.306) and first in team ERA (2.74). Arizona State has clinched its third consecutive Pac-10 title after having swept Oregon (May 15-17).

VERSUS THE SUN DEVILS

UCLA opens its three-game series at Arizona State in third place in the Pac-10, five games behind the first-place Sun Devils. Last season, UCLA earned one victory in a three-game series against Arizona State at Jackie Robinson Stadium. UCLA hit at a .302 clip against Arizona State one year ago, and batted .333 against the Sun Devils in a three-game series at ASU in 2007. The Bruins last won a three-game Pac-10 series against Arizona State in 2006, when UCLA downed the Sun Devils in the final two games at Jackie Robinson Stadium.

ROAD WARRIORS

UCLA is playing the most challenging schedule in the nation, as projected by Boyd's World (national strength of schedule ranking service). After opening the season with a three-game home series, the Bruins spent four consecutive weekends on the road – in the Houston College Classic (Feb. 27-March 1), at Oklahoma (March 6-8), at East Carolina (March 13-14) and at USC (March 21-23). UCLA has played six weekend trips away from southern California. The Bruins began 2009 by playing 22 of their first 33 games away from home. UCLA's final four games are being played on the road at top-3 ranked competition (Baseball America poll).

TOP PITCHING STAFFS

UCLA and Arizona State feature two of the nation's top pitching staffs. In fact, Arizona State and UCLA rank first and second, respectively, in Pac-10 team ERA (conference games only). The Sun Devils boast a 2.92 team ERA in Pac-10 play, while UCLA has compiled a 3.79 team ERA in conference action. Nationally, the Bruins have posted the 25th-lowest team ERA (4.27) through Sunday's games. Additionally, UCLA ranks eighth in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (9.5) and 18th in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings (8.86).

A LOOK AT THE PACK

UCLA opens the final weekend of regular-season play in third place in the Pac-10. At 14-10, the Bruins currently trail conference leader Arizona State (19-5) by five games. Washington State (16-8) stands in second place, and Washington (13-11) and Oregon State (13-11) share fourth place (Washington wins tiebreak, head-to-head series). Stanford (12-12) occupies sixth place while USC has moved into seventh place (11-13). Arizona (10-14), California (8-16) and Oregon (4-20) round out the conference's 10 teams.

STRIKEOUT MACHINE

UCLA's pitchers have recorded 488 strikeouts in 468.2 innings, the highest strikeout total in the Pac-10 through Tuesday's action. The Bruins have recorded more strikeouts than any UCLA team since 2000, when the staff registered 531 strikeouts in 64 games (highest single-season strikeout total on record at UCLA). The Bruins' pitching staff has collected 10 or more strikeouts in 24 games this spring, including in six of the last eight contests. Freshmen right-handers Gerrit Cole (95) and Trevor Bauer (87) lead UCLA in that category. In Pac-10 games, Cole ranks third in strikeouts (63) and Bauer is ninth (49).

TALENTED YOUNGSTER

Freshman right-hander Trevor Bauer leads UCLA with eight wins (8-3 record) and a 2.90 ERA in a team-high 96.1 innings. Bauer began the season in the bullpen before moving into a midweek starting role. After shutting down San Diego State (March 11) and Pepperdine (March 25) in midweek starts, Bauer has excelled in the weekend rotation. In nine starts, Bauer has gone 6-0 with a 3.06 ERA, collecting 62 strikeouts in 70.2 innings. In Pac-10 action, Bauer leads UCLA with a 6-0 record, totaling 49 strikeouts and nine walks in 57.1 innings.

UPPER DECKER

Senior first baseman Cody Decker has tallied a team-leading 20 home runs and 50 RBI. Hitting at a .326 clip, Decker also leads UCLA with a .695 slugging percentage, 52 runs and 36 walks and is second with 61 hits. With his home run Tuesday at UC Irvine, Decker has become the first Bruin to belt 20 or more homers in one season since three players accomplished the feat in 2000 (Forrest Johnson, 23; Chase Utley 22; Bill Scott 21). He has compiled a career-best 12-game hitting streak and has reached base via hit or walk in the last 21 contests. Decker leads the Bruins with career totals of 46 home runs, 150 RBI and 175 hits.

CENTER STAGE

Junior Blair Dunlap has started 52 games in center field for UCLA this spring. Headed into the Bruins' final weekend of the regular season, he is hitting at a .296 clip (63-for-213) and leads UCLA with 63 hits, 17 doubles and 14 stolen bases. Dunlap ranks second on the team with 104 total bases and 43 runs and is third on the club with 36 RBI. He has cranked five of his six home runs this season in Pac-10 play. Through the team's last nine games, Dunlap is batting at a .364 clip, going 12-for-33 with two doubles and 10 runs.

SENIOR CONTRIBUTOR

Senior Gino Aielli has played a major role in UCLA's success this spring and currently leads the team with a .374 batting average (46-for-123). Aielli, who has split time between third base, catcher and designated hitter, has collected five three-hit games and one five-hit effort. A former two-year standout at Saddleback Junior College (2006-07), Aielli played in just six games last spring for UCLA before making the most of his playing time in 2009. He has hit at a .486 clip (18-for-37) with 12 runs in the Bruins' last nine games.

CASEY AT THE BAT

Junior infielder Casey Haerther has compiled a .309 batting average and .476 slugging percentage in 49 games. Haerther ranks second on the ballclub with nine home runs and 41 RBI. The resident of Chatsworth, Calif., logged a career-high five RBI in a 2-for-4 effort against Long Beach State on April 28. Haerther's most impressive performance of the season came in a 17-2 victory at USC on March 23, when the Bruins' infielder went 4-for-4 with three runs and three RBI at Dedeaux Field.

FIRE AWAY

A key starter in UCLA's pitching rotation since the season's opening weekend, freshman right-hander Gerrit Cole has logged a 4-7 record and 3.55 ERA, the third-lowest earned-run average on the team. Cole leads UCLA with 95 strikeouts, tied for the third-highest total among Pac-10 pitchers. Cole's .199 opponent batting average ranks third-lowest in the conference. Cole ranks eighth among Pac-10 pitchers with 78.2 innings and is averaging 10.9 strikeouts per nine innings. His most dominant outings came at East Carolina (March 13, 5.0 IP, 12 K) and in a one-hit effort versus Washington (8.0 IP, 13 K, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 H).

RECORD WATCH

Senior first baseman Cody Decker ranks eighth on UCLA's career home runs list with 46 (trails Ryan McGuire, 47). Senior left-hander Brendan Lafferty has moved into third place on the career pitching appearances list (93), trailing Chuck Yeager (111) and Bill Wennick (119). Senior right-hander Jason Novak is tied for sixth on the same list, having pitched in 85 career games. Junior left-hander Gavin Brooks is tied with four other players for 10th place on the career saves list (8), and is tied for fifth on the single-season saves list (8).

CELEBRATING THE SENIORS

UCLA honored seven players on "Senior Day" on Sunday, May 17, as the Bruins hosted their final regular-season home game. The Bruins' seniors stepped up, helping UCLA secure a 7-0 lead through two innings. Gino Aielli went 3-for-4 with three runs, and Dustin Quist (redshirt junior) was 3-for-4 with an RBI-double. Cody Decker belted his team-leading 19th home run, going 3-for-4 with four RBI and Blair Dunlap (redshirt junior) went 3-for-5 with one pair of runs. On the mound, seniors Brendan Lafferty and Jason Novak each held Cal State Fullerton scoreless, as the duo combined for three strikeouts in 2.1 innings of relief.

IN HONOR OF JACK

A circular black patch with the initials "JG" adorn the left sleeve of UCLA's uniforms, in honor of the late Jack Gifford. Among the program's most loyal and passionate supporters, Gifford played for UCLA alongside former head coach Gary Adams in the early 1960s. Gifford, who passed away on Jan. 11, 2009, and his wife Rhodine generously funded the construction of UCLA's state-of-the-art hitting facility. Named in their honor, the Jack and Rhodine Gifford Hitting Facility stands 23-feet high and spans 10,500-square feet.

HUFF PROMOTED TO MAJORS

Former UCLA pitcher David Huff was promoted to the Cleveland Indians' 25-man roster last weekend. Huff made his major league debut as Cleveland's starting pitcher on Sunday, May 17. He was tagged with the loss, surrendering seven runs and seven hits in 3.2 innings. Huff led the Bruins' to the NCAA Malibu Regional in 2006, going 7-4 with a 2.98 ERA that spring. Six other Bruins are currently on major league rosters, including Garrett Atkins (Colorado), Eric Byrnes (Arizona), Ben Francisco (Cleveland), Casey Janssen (Toronto) and Chase Utley (Philadelphia). Former UCLA standout Troy Glaus (St. Louis) is currently on the 15-day disabled list.

MINOR LEAGUE UPDATE

Three former UCLA pitchers are pitching in the minors at the triple-A level – Hector Ambriz (Reno Aces, Arizona), Dave Johnson (Memphis Sounds, Milwaukee), and Josh Roenicke (Louisville Bats, Cincinnati). Ambriz and Roenicke starred on the mound at UCLA as recently as 2006 under head coach John Savage. Former UCLA shortstop Brandon Crawford (2006-08) has been promoted from San Jose (high-A) to Connecticut (double-A, San Francisco Giants), where he has batted .273 through his first eight games.

ALL-AMERICA CANDIDATE

6 – CODY DECKER – Sr., INF – Santa Monica, Calif. (Santa Monica High School)

One of UCLA's most veteran players in 2009, senior first baseman Cody Decker has developed into one of the West Coast's premier power hitters. Not only does Decker lead the Pac-10 Conference with 20 home runs, he ranks in the top-10 in several other offensive categories. A solid defensive asset at first base, Decker has committed just three errors in the field in four seasons at UCLA (.995 fielding percentage). He has posted career highs this season in batting average, home runs, total bases, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and walks. Below is a look at Decker's senior season.

- Among Pac-10 hitters, Decker ranks first in home runs (20), tied for second in runs (52), third in slugging percentage (.695) and walks (36), fourth in total bases (130) and ninth in on-base percentage (.441).
- In Pac-10 play, Decker has batted .329 (26-for-79) with eight homers, 18 RBI, five doubles, 23 runs, a .444 on-base percentage and .696 slugging percentage (24 games, 23 starts).
- He enters the final weekend of the regular season ranking eighth on UCLA's career home runs list (46 round-trippers, trailing Ryan McGuire's 47-home run total in seventh place).

FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICA CANDIDATES

11 – TREVOR BAUER – RHP – Valencia, Calif. (Hart High School)

Among the Pac-10 Conference's leaders in numerous pitching categories, freshman right-hander Trevor Bauer has helped spearhead UCLA's weekend rotation alongside fellow freshman Gerrit Cole and junior Charles Brewer. Bauer enrolled at UCLA for the winter quarter in January 2009 after having graduated from Hart High School (Newhall, Calif.) one semester early in December 2008. A top student who intends to major in engineering, Bauer leads UCLA with eight wins (8-3 record), 96.1 innings and a team-low 2.90 ERA. The list below features Bauer's top accomplishments as a freshman in 2009.

- Among Pac-10 pitchers, Bauer ranks second in innings pitched (96.1), tied for second in wins (8), sixth in strikeouts (87) and ERA (2.90) and 10th in opponent batting average (.227).
- In Pac-10 play, Bauer has gone 6-0 with three complete games, a 2.83 ERA, 49 strikeouts, nine walks ... pitched 57.1 innings, recording a .230 opponent batting average and one save (nine games, six starts).
- As a starting pitcher (nine starts), Bauer has posted a 6-0 record and 3.06 ERA, registering 62 strikeouts and 14 walks in 70.2 innings ... he has limited the opposition to a .218 batting average.
- Bauer has become one of three pitchers in UCLA history to notch eight or more wins as a freshman – his eight victories are tied with Josh Karp (eight wins, 1999) and trail Pete Janicki (nine wins, 1990).
- Bauer stands 14.1 innings shy of UCLA's record for most innings pitched by a freshman, established by current Bruin junior Gavin Brooks (110.2 innings as a freshman in 2007).
- Among Pac-10 pitchers (conference games only), Bauer ranks third in ERA (2.83), fourth in innings pitched (57.1), tied for second in wins (6), ninth in strikeouts (49) and opponent batting average (.230).
- Bauer has fired three complete game victories, including a one-hit shutout of Washington (April 18) ... Bauer tossed UCLA's first one-hitter since April 13, 1998, when Tony Righetti led the Bruins past Hawai'i-Hilo, 16-0 ... Bauer retired the first 13 batters in order before issuing a five-pitch walk with one out in the fifth inning ... his bid for a no-hitter ended with a leadoff single in the sixth inning ... Bauer did not allow any baserunner to advance past first base and faced 28 batters, one batter above the minimum.
- Bauer also tossed complete games at Oregon (May 2) and one week later versus California (May 9) ... he threw nine innings against Cal State Fullerton (May 16) and did not earn a decision in a 6-5, 10-inning loss.

12 – GERRIT COLE – RHP – Santa Ana, Calif. (Orange Lutheran High School)

A fixture in UCLA's weekend rotation since the first series of the 2009 season, freshman right-hander Gerrit Cole has posted some of the nation's most impressive numbers. Entering the final weekend of the regular season, Cole has registered a team-leading 95 strikeouts in 78.2 innings, compiling a .199 opponent batting average. The right-hander has posted a 3.55 ERA and 4-7 record (4-6 as a starter), as UCLA has scored 14 runs in his six losses as the Bruins' starting pitcher (2.33 runs scored by UCLA per game). Cole has allowed just 27 hits in 37.1 innings in his six losses, limiting the opposition to a .211 average in those games. The list below features Cole's top accomplishments as a freshman in 2009.

- Among Pac-10 pitchers, Cole ranks third in opponent batting average (.199), tied for third in strikeouts (95), and tied for eighth in innings pitched (78.2).
- In Pac-10 play, Cole has gone 3-3 with one complete game, a 3.42 ERA, 63 strikeouts, 21 walks ... pitched 52.2 innings, recording a .182 opponent batting average in eight starts.
- Cole currently stands three strikeouts shy of UCLA's record for most strikeouts by a freshman, established by current Bruin junior Gavin Brooks (98 strikeouts as a freshman in 2007).
- Among Pac-10 pitchers (conference games only), Cole ranks third in strikeouts (63) and opponent batting average (.182) and tied for seventh in innings pitched (52.2).
- Through last Sunday's action, Cole ranked eighth in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings (6.21) and 20th in strikeouts per nine innings (10.92) and total strikeouts (95).

In his fifth season as head coach, John Savage has established UCLA as a perennial national contender. In 2008, he became UCLA's first head baseball coach to lead the program to three consecutive postseas.

In June 2006, the Bruins played in the Malibu Regional. UCLA swept

the 2007 Long Beach Regional before advancing to the Super Regional at Cal State Fullerton, UCLA's first Super Regional appearance since 2000. In 2008, the Bruins advanced to the Regional Final at Cal State Fullerton.

Savage has also made significant strides on the recruiting trail, helping UCLA land four recruiting classes ranked in the top-13 by *Baseball America*. In the fall of 2005, Savage's first recruiting class at UCLA was ranked No. 5 in the nation by *Baseball America*. His second recruiting class was ranked No. 13, and has last two classes have been ranked No. 7, nationally, by *Baseball America*.

Aside from featuring winning teams, outstanding recruiting classes, and consistently challenging schedules, Savage has made significant improvements to Jackie Robinson Stadium. Under Savage's guidance, the ballpark now features a 10,500-square foot hitting facility, a new grass field surface, a state-of-the-art backstop, the installation of over 1,000 chairback seats and renovated bullpens.
