THE WEEK AHEAD

UCLA hosts Long Beach State on Tuesday evening in the two teams' final meeting of the 2010 season. The Bruins defeated Long Beach State, 10-1, in their fourth game of the season on Tuesday, Feb. 23, at Blair Field in Long Beach. In that contest, senior Garett Claypool earned his first victory of the year, allowing one run and five hits through seven innings. This weekend, UCLA will play a three-game Pac-10 series at Arizona. The Bruins will be looking for their fifth consecutive series victory against the Wildcats.

CAPACITY CROWDS

The Bruins have enjoyed strong crowds at home, posting a 17-4 record in 21 games played at Steele Field at Jackie Robinson Stadium. Last weekend, the Bruins dropped two of three games at home to Oregon. In the series finale on Sunday, UCLA welcomed 1,986 fans in one of the best draws to Jackie Robinson Stadium in recent history. To accommodate the near-record-breaking crowds, UCLA has added seating for up to 650 additional fans at Jackie Robinson Stadium, allowing the facility to accommodate as many as 2,000 spectators.

SENIOR SUCCESS

Senior Garett Claypool will make his seventh start of the season on Tuesday night against Long Beach State. Claypool has gone 5-1 with a Pac-10 leading 1.85 ERA in 43.2 innings this spring, having totaled 50 strikeouts and 10 walks while holding the opposition to a conference-best .158 batting average. In six starts, he has gone 4-1 with a 2.10 ERA, collecting 35 strikeouts and eight walks in 34.1 innings. Throwing in relief, Claypool earned the victory in UCLA's 16-inning game at Oregon State (April 10), allowing one hit in 4.2 scoreless innings.

RANKINGS ROUNDUP

The Bruins open the week ranked No. 5, nationally, by *Baseball America* and *Rivals.com*. In addition, UCLA is ranked No. 6 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll, No. 7 by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers' Association (NCBWA) and No. 8 by *Collegiate Baseball*. The Bruins were ranked No. 1 by *Baseball America* and *Rivals.com* on April 12, marking UCLA's first midseason No. 1 ranking since earning the top spot on March 3, 1997, from both *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball*.

"HE GONE"

UCLA enters Tuesday's action leading the Pac-10 with 368 strikeouts (ahead of second-best Arizona State, 309). The Bruins' three weekend starting pitchers are the conference's top three strikeout leaders - Gerrit Cole (76), Trevor Bauer (72) and Rob Rasmussen (69). Garett Claypool sits just outside the Pac-10's top-10 strikeout leaders with 50 punchouts. As a team, the Bruins are averaging 11.2 strikeouts per nine innings and have surrendered 6.5 hits per nine innings.

WORTH AN ESPY

Sophomore Dean Espy has excelled as a corner infielder in his first season with the Bruins. Leading UCLA with a .400 batting average, Espy transferred to UCLA last summer after having starred at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix in 2009. He leads the Bruins in RBI (29) and slugging percentage (.667) and is tied with Brett Krill and Steve Rodriguez for the team lead in homers, with five. In addition, Espy leads the Bruins in Pac-10 play with a .407 batting average and 11 hits.

RAMMING SPEED

Sophomore Tyler Rahmatulla has been one of two Bruins (with freshman Cody Keefer) to have started all 32 games. Rahmatulla enters the week second on the team in batting average (.383) and ranks first among all UCLA hitters with 44 hits, 31 runs, a .500 on-base percentage and nine stolen bases. Rahmatulla has tallied the game-winning RBI in seven games this season, including last Tuesday evening's 10-0 victory at UC Riverside. He is tied for third (with three players) in the Pac-10 in on-base percentage (.500).

DAILY DOUBLE

Senior Blair Dunlap leads the team with 16 doubles, ranks second with 41 hits and is third with a .366 batting average. Dunlap is tied for ninth place on UCLA's career doubles list with 44 two-baggers. The resident of Mission Viejo, Calif., netted his 44th career double in the Bruins' 5-1 victory on Sunday against Oregon, pushing himself into a three-way tie on the career list with Brandon Crawford and Pete Zamora. Dunlap, who led UCLA with 17 doubles in 2009, is five doubles shy of fifth place on the school's all-time list.

SIX IN A ROW

Left-hander Rob Rasmussen has earned the victory in each of his last six starts (dating back to a 5-2 win over then-No. 25 Oklahoma on March 14). Sporting a 6-0 record this spring, Rasmussen has posted a 2.52 ERA, collecting 69 strikeouts and 21 walks in 50.0 innings. The native of Arcadia, Calif., limited Oregon to four hits in 6.1 scoreless innings last Sunday, striking out six batters while walking two.

NOTES ON A STREAK

UCLA opened the season by winning its first 22 games, the Bruins' best-ever start to any baseball season in the program's 91-year history. Prior to going 22-0 in 2010, UCLA's best starts on record took place in 1978 (8-0) and in 1997 (7-0). The Bruins won their first 22 games, outscoring their opponents by a combined 189-59 margin. UCLA posted a .356 batting average during its record streak while the pitching staff logged a 2.22 ERA and 273 strikeouts through 199.0 innings (12.4 strikeouts per nine innings).

- UCLA had 10 players during its win streak post batting averages above .300 (minimum 40 at-bats)
- The starting rotation went 17-0, compiling a 2.20 ERA with 194 strikeouts and 52 walks.
- Tyler Rahmatulla led UCLA's offense with a .451 batting average (37-for-82), 37 hits and 24 runs.
- Gerrit Cole went 6-0 with a 2.49 ERA and 61 strikeouts through 43.1 innings in seven starts.
- Dan Klein tossed 17.2 scoreless innings as the closer, totaling five saves while earning two victories.
- UCLA opened 22-0 and Arizona State started 24-0 - both schools lost their first game on Friday, April 2.

NOT FAR BEHIND

During the Bruins' 22-0 start, UCLA trailed in eight ballgames and was tied (without trailing) in two games. The Bruins twice overcame a deficit of three runs, most recently by scoring two runs in the fourth inning and two in the eighth against Cal Poly on March 26, to secure their 19th consecutive win. The Bruins have won two games in walkoff fashion, ironically, in back-to-back games. A sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth inning against Nebraska (March 6) and versus UC Riverside (March 9) helped UCLA claim its ninth and 10th wins.

Sixth-year head coach John Savage became UCLA's first head coach to lead the Bruins to three consecutive NCAA Regionals (2006-08). Named the Bruins' head coach in the summer of 2004, Savage has helped UCLA produce 31 Major League Draft selections.

UCLA has collected the second-most wins (55) and second-highest winning percentage (.561) among Pac-10 teams (conference games only) from 2006-09. With the Bruins sporting a 21-0 record, Savage has pushed UCLA to its most games over .500 in his six seasons (previous, 10 games over in May 2006). UCLA has not been as many as 23 games over the .500 plateau since finishing the 1997 season with a 45-21-1 overall mark under former head coach Gary Adams.
