THE WEEK AHEAD

UCLA returns home to host UC Irvine on Tuesday evening before opening a three-game series at Jackie Robinson Stadium this weekend against Arizona State. The Bruins have not played UC Irvine in 2010, as the two teams will face each other again in Irvine on May 11. This week's contest against UC Irvine is UCLA's second to final home midweek game of the year. Admission to Tuesday's game for both adults and children costs \$2, as part of UCLA's ongoing "Two-Dollar Tuesday" promotion. Right-hander Garrett Claypool will start for the Bruins.

HISTORY VERSUS IRVINE

The Bruins play their first of two games this season against UC Irvine on Tuesday evening at Jackie Robinson Stadium. UCLA dropped two of three games to UC Irvine in 2009. The Anteaters won, 7-4, on a Sunday afternoon at the Minute Maid Classic and secured a 5-4 victory in extra innings May 19 during the final week of the regular season in Irvine. UCLA notched an 8-3 victory at home against UC Irvine on April 9. Since assuming the head coaching job at UCLA, John Savage has guided the Bruins to an 8-4 mark against the Anteaters.

TUESDAY'S STARTER

Senior right-hander Garrett Claypool will take the hill for the Bruins against UC Irvine on Tuesday evening. Claypool enters the midweek contest with a 5-1 record, ranking third in the Pac-10 with a 2.27 ERA. Claypool leads all Pac-10 pitchers with a .173 opponent batting average, having registered 53 strikeouts and 11 walks in 47.2 innings. Through his four-year UCLA career, the native of West Hills, Calif., has been relied upon as the Bruins' midweek pitcher. He has gone 11-5 with a 3.28 ERA in 66 career games (28 starts, all in midweek action).

RANKED TERRITORY

In the latest college baseball polls, seven Pac-10 teams are ranked among the top-25 by at least one of five publications. Six Pac-10 teams are listed among the top-25 by *Baseball America*, Rivals.com and *Collegiate Baseball*. The NCBWA (Writers' Association) has ranked seven Pac-10 teams in their top 25 spots, while the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll has pegged five Pac-10 programs in the top-25. UCLA has posted a 7-3 record against teams ranked in the top-25 (week of game) by *Baseball America*.

ON TO THE NEXT ONE

Slated to start Friday against Arizona State, sophomore Gerrit Cole enters the week as the Pac-10 Conference leader in strikeouts (86) and ranks third in opponent batting average (.186). Cole recorded 10 strikeouts and no walks in a no-decision last Friday evening at then-No. 17 Arizona, limiting the host Wildcats to two runs and seven hits in a season-high eight innings. The resident of Santa Ana, Calif., has tallied 10 or more strikeouts in three starts this season and accomplished that feat in three starts one year ago.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Sophomore Trevor Bauer pitched his first complete game of the season (fifth of his career) on Saturday night, striking out 13 batters and walking one to lead the Bruins past Arizona, 6-2. Bauer allowed two runs and 10 hits in nine innings, earning the victory to improve to 6-2 on the season. The native of Valencia, Calif., secured his first Pac-10 win of the spring. Bauer ranks second in the Pac-10 in strikeouts (85), behind teammate Gerrit Cole (86), and is tied for fourth with 66.2 innings pitched (with USC's Ben Mount).

LEADING OFF

Freshman Beau Amaral ranks fourth on the ballclub with a .350 batting average, having gone 8-for-15 (.533) in four games last week. Amaral has played in 32 games in his rookie campaign, starting 25 contests as UCLA's center fielder. The former standout at Huntington Beach High School belted his second home run of the season, going 2-for-4 with two RBI, in a midweek loss to Long Beach State on April 20. In three games at then-No. 17 Arizona over the weekend, Amaral batted .545 (6-for-11).

CAPACITY CROWDS

UCLA encourages its fans to arrive early for this weekend's series against Arizona State, as capacity crowds are anticipated. The Bruins have posted a 17-5 record in 22 home games. UCLA welcomed 1,986 fans in a 5-1 win over Oregon on Sunday, April 18, in one of the best draws to Jackie Robinson Stadium in recent history. To accommodate the near record-breaking crowds, UCLA has added seating for up to 650 additional fans at Jackie Robinson Stadium, allowing the facility to accommodate more than 2,000 spectators.

DAILY DOUBLE

Senior Blair Dunlap leads the team with 16 doubles, ranks second with 46 hits (behind Tyler Rahmatulla's 48 hits) and is third with a .362 batting average. Dunlap has moved into a three-way tie for ninth place on UCLA's career doubles list (44, tied with Brandon Crawford and Pete Zamora). Dunlap led the Bruins with 17 doubles last season. UCLA's most veteran hitter, Dunlap has compiled a .301 career batting average in 171 games, totaling 64 career extra-base hits (15 home runs, five triples and 44 doubles).

"HE GONE"

Through Sunday's Pac-10 action, UCLA leads the conference with 403 strikeouts (ahead of second-best Arizona State, 328) and has averaged 11.0 strikeouts per nine innings. The Bruins' three weekend starting pitchers rank first, second and fourth, respectively among the Pac-10's strikeout leaders — Gerrit Cole (86), Trevor Bauer (85) and Rob Rasmussen (72). Garrett Claypool sits just outside the Pac-10's top-10 strikeout leaders (53). Prior to last weekend's games, UCLA ranked first, nationally, in strikeouts per nine innings.

WORTH AN ESPY

Sophomore Dean Espy has excelled as a corner infielder in his first season with the Bruins. Leading UCLA with a .371 batting average, Espy transferred to UCLA last summer after having starred at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix in 2009. He leads the Bruins in RBI (33) and slugging percentage (.619) and is tied with Brett Krill, Tyler Rahmatulla and Steve Rodriguez for the team lead in home runs with five. In addition, Espy ranks second on the team in Pac-10 play with a .359 batting average and leads UCLA with 14 hits.

RAMMING SPEED

Sophomore Tyler Rahmatulla stands as the only player for UCLA to have started all 36 games (all at second base). Rahmatulla enters Tuesday's game against UC Irvine ranking second on the team with a .366 batting average and is first among all hitters with 48 hits, 33 runs, 29 walks and a .483 on-base percentage. Rahmatulla has tallied the game-winning RBI in seven games this season. The former standout at Mater Dei High School ranks fourth in the Pac-10 with a .483 OBP and leads the conference with six sacrifice flies.

SHOW STOPPER

Sophomore right-hander Dan Klein has been named to the Midseason Stopper of the Year Watch List, as announced in mid-April by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers' Association. Klein leads UCLA and ranks third in the Pac-10 with seven saves, having logged a 3-0 record and 0.64 ERA. The resident of Los Alamitos, Calif., has tallied 36 strikeouts and seven walks in 28.0 innings. Klein is currently tied for seventh place on UCLA's single-season saves list with Bobby Roe (1998).

RANK THIS

UCLA has gone 7-3 against teams ranked in *Baseball America's* top-25 poll (team ranked in poll on day of game). UCLA defeated then-No. 25 Oklahoma, 5-2, on March 14 before winning two of three games against No. 19 Stanford, No. 17 Oregon State and No. 17 Arizona. One year ago, the Bruins went 8-13 against top-25 competition, playing more games and earning more victories against top-25 teams than any other Pac-10 program. UCLA is slated to play at least seven more games against top-25 ballclubs this year.

MAKING HISTORY

UCLA's 16-inning victory three weeks ago at Oregon State marked the program's longest game (by innings) since an 18-inning game at Arizona State on Feb. 23, 1990. The Bruins lost 6-5 in the series opener at Arizona State that evening before 4,037 fans. The longest extra-inning game in Pac-10 history came in 1972, as Washington and Oregon State played a 20-inning contest (date, score unknown). UCLA's 3-1 win against Oregon State lasted six hours, 23 minutes and featured 12 pitchers (eight by Oregon State, four by UCLA).

HOW WE COMPARE

Through Sunday's games, UCLA's pitching staff leads the Pac-10 in ERA (2.80), strikeouts (403) and opponent batting average (.213). The Bruins rank second in wins (29) and have allowed the fifth-fewest walks (114). UCLA's offense ranks fourth in the Pac-10 in batting average (.313) and slugging percentage (.462) and is third in on-base percentage (.403). The Bruins are third in the Pac-10 with 31 home runs and are fourth with 82 doubles. UCLA's .973 fielding percentage is the second-highest mark among Pac-10 programs.

RANKINGS ROUNDUP

The Bruins opened the week ranked No. 5, nationally, by *Baseball America* and the ESPN/USA Today Coaches' Poll. In addition, UCLA was ranked No. 4 by Yahoo! Sports/Rivals.com and No. 9 by Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers' Association (NCBWA). The Bruins were ranked No. 1 by *Baseball America* and Yahoo! Sports/Rivals.com on April 12, marking UCLA's first midseason No. 1 ranking since earning the top spot on March 3, 1997, from both *Baseball America* and *Collegiate Baseball*.

LOOKING FOR RELIEF

UCLA's bullpen has gone 7-2 with a 2.95 ERA and nine saves through 36 games. The Bruins' relief corps has logged 122 strikeouts and 38 walks, posting a .217 opponent batting average. Eight relief pitchers have combined to make 90 appearances out of the bullpen. No relief appearance may have been more impressive than that of right-hander Garrett Claypool in UCLA's 16-inning triumph at Oregon State on April 10. Claypool earned the victory that evening, limiting the Beavers to one hit in 4.2 scoreless innings.

NOTES ON A STREAK

UCLA opened the season by winning its first 22 games, the Bruins' best-ever start to any baseball season in the program's 91-year history. Prior to going 22-0 in 2010, UCLA's best starts on record took place in 1978 (8-0) and in 1997 (7-0). The Bruins won their first 22 games, outscoring their opponents by a combined 189-59 margin. UCLA posted a .356 batting average during its record streak while the pitching staff logged a 2.22 ERA and 273 strikeouts through 199.0 innings (12.4 strikeouts per nine innings).

- UCLA had 10 players during its win streak post batting averages above .300 (minimum 40 at-bats)
- The starting rotation went 17-0, compiling a 2.20 ERA with 194 strikeouts and 52 walks.
- Tyler Rahmatulla led UCLA's offense with a .451 batting average (37-for-82), 37 hits and 24 runs.
- Gerrit Cole went 6-0 with a 2.49 ERA and 61 strikeouts through 43.1 innings in seven starts.
- Dan Klein tossed 17.2 scoreless innings as the closer, totaling five saves while earning two victories.
- UCLA opened 22-0 and Arizona State started 24-0 – both schools lost their first game on Friday, April 2.

NOT FAR BEHIND

During the Bruins' 22-0 start, UCLA trailed in eight ballgames and was tied (without trailing) in two games. The Bruins twice overcame a deficit of three runs, most recently by scoring two runs in the fourth inning and two in the eighth against Cal Poly on March 26, to secure their 19th consecutive win. The Bruins have won two games in walkoff fashion, ironically, in back-to-back games. A sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth inning against Nebraska (March 6) and versus UC Riverside (March 9) helped UCLA claim its ninth and 10th wins.

NEWS AND NOTES

► UCLA's 2010 roster features three players with immediate connections in the major leagues. Niko Gallego (son of Mike) and Beau Amaral (son of Rich) both have fathers who played in the major leagues after having excelled at UCLA. Mike Gallego played 13 seasons in the majors (1985-1997), spending the 1985 through 1991 campaigns with the Oakland A's. Rich Amaral played in the big leagues for 10 seasons, spending his first eight with the Seattle Mariners. Dean Espy's father, Duane, played eight seasons in the minors before serving as both a minor league head coach and major league hitting coach (2000-02 San Diego, 2003-06 Colorado).

► UCLA defeated USC, 6-1, before 14,588 fans at Dodger Stadium in a non-conference game on Sunday, Feb. 28. Playing in the first-ever "Dodgertown Classic", the Bruins and Trojans played under sunny skies at Dodger Stadium on the final day of the second weekend of the 2010 college baseball season. Vanderbilt defeated Oklahoma State, 7-6, in the first of two games at Dodger Stadium that day. That marked the largest crowd to watch a UCLA baseball game since the 1997 College World Series.

► The Bruins' 2010 schedule features 56 games against a total of 25 teams. In all, UCLA has played games against teams from nine conferences. After the Pac-10, the Bruins have played more games against Big West opposition than any other conference. UCLA's key non-conference victories have included a 9-2 win at home against Vanderbilt on Friday, Feb. 26. The Bruins handed the Commodores (then 4-0) their first loss in their first 15 games. UCLA also defeated then-No. 25 Oklahoma, 5-2, on Sunday, March 14 at the Whataburger College Classic. The Bruins snapped the Sooners' 10-game win streak and gave them their second loss in 17 games.

HEADED TO UCLA IN 2010-11

Sixth-year head coach John Savage announced the signing of eight high school seniors to National Letters of Intent during the early signing period in November 2009. These eight players will enroll at UCLA for the fall quarter in Sept. 2010 in time for the 2011 baseball season.


