UCLA IN MIDWEEK ACTION

The Bruins host UC Irvine on Tuesday night at 6 p.m. in their final midweek home game of the 2012 season. UCLA and UC Irvine split a pair of midweek games last spring, before the Anteaters edged the Bruins, 4-3, in the final game of the NCAA Regional at Jackie Robinson Stadium. UCLA and UC Irvine have split the two midweek games each of the last five seasons (2007-11), with UCLA last sweeping the midweek series in 2006. The Bruins have posted a perfect 6-0 record in midweek ballgames this season.

WATSON ON THE MOUND

Freshman left-hander Grant Watson is slated to start on the hill for UCLA this Tuesday. Watson has started each of UCLA's previous six midweek games, in addition to making four starts on the weekend. He is tied for the Pac-12 lead with seven wins, having gone 7-1 with a 4.96 ERA in 52.2 innings, the third-highest total on the staff. Watson has pitched in 20 games (10 starts), tied for the fourth-most appearances among Pac-12 pitchers. Watson did not receive a decision in last Tuesday's 12-4 win against Cal State Northridge.

WEEKEND AT OREGON STATE

UCLA lost two of three games at Oregon State over the weekend and is currently tied for second place in the Pac-12 standings with Oregon (11-7), as both teams are one game behind Arizona (12-6). Adam Plutko scattered two hits in 7.2 scoreless innings on Friday night to earn the victory as UCLA blanked the Beavers, 4-0. The Bruins were shut out, 3-0, on Saturday before losing, 7-6, in the series finale on Sunday. Shane Zeile (4-for-7, .571) and Cody Regis (4-for-10, .400, one home run) were UCLA's leading hitters in Corvallis, Ore.

HOT HITTING HEINEMAN

Junior catcher Tyler Heineman ranks second in the Pac-12 with a .405 batting average and leads the conference with a .500 on-base percentage. Heineman had a 15-game hitting streak snapped in UCLA's 4-0 victory at Oregon State on Friday night. The resident of Pacific Palisades, Calif., has hit safely in 31 of 35 games and has posted a team-leading .459 batting average in conference games. Heineman has made 30 starts behind the plate and five starts as the designated hitter, throwing out 12 of 30 attempted base stealers (40 percent).

MR. VERSATILITY

Junior Trevor Brown enters Tuesday night's game batting .311 with a team-leading 31 RBI in 36 games. Brown has emerged the last three seasons as UCLA's most versatile position player. The former standout at Hart High School (Valencia, Calif.) can play behind the plate and at each of the four positions around the infield. He has made 16 career starts at catcher, started 30 games at first base this season and started 24 games at second base in 2011. In addition he has made seven career starts as UCLA's third baseman.

LEADING OFF

Junior center field Beau Amaral has raised his batting average over 100 points the last six weeks. A career .331 hitter for the Bruins, Amaral is currently hitting at a .344 clip with four home runs, four triples, seven doubles and a conference-best 44 runs. Amaral's 44 runs scored have already surpassed his team-leading 37 runs scored in 2011. Over UCLA's last 21 games, he has batted .420 (37-for-88) with 29 runs and 22 RBI. Amaral's career-best 21-game hitting streak ended on Sunday in UCLA's 7-6 loss to Oregon State.

ROAD WARRIORS

Since the start of the 2010 season, UCLA has gone 47-23 in all road and neutral site contests. The Bruins have opened this season with an 11-3 record away from home, posting a 6-3 record on the road in Pac-12 games. Last year, UCLA went 14-13 in road/neutral site games, while in 2010 the Bruins went 15-4 on the road and 7-3 at neutral sites. In conference action, UCLA has tallied a 26-10 road record since 2010.

MULTIPLE APPEARANCES

Four UCLA pitchers rank among the top six in pitching appearances in the Pac-12. David Berg (24) and Ryan Deeter (22) are first and second, respectively, in that category. Scott Griggs, Grant Watson and ASU's Robert Rabago are tied for fourth in the category (20). In addition, Griggs is tied for second in the Pac-12 with eight saves, having gone 0-1 with a 1.27 ERA in 21.1 innings as the Bruins' closer (33 strikeouts, 18 walks).

POWER SUPPLIER

Junior right fielder Jeff Gelalich leads UCLA with six home runs and enters Tuesday night's game with a .365 batting average, 26 RBI and 34 runs. Gelalich is tied for the conference lead in stolen bases (12) with Oregon's Aaron Payne. He has started all 36 games for the Bruins in right field and opened the season by reaching base safely in UCLA's first 25 contests. Gelalich has posted a career .312 batting average with 10 home runs and 52 RBI.

WELL-TRAVELED BRUINS

In their eighth season under head coach John Savage, the Bruins have regularly played non-conference road series against teams away from the West Coast. In early March, UCLA swept a three-game series at then-No. 9 ranked Georgia. Last season, the Bruins played three consecutive extra-inning games at Nebraska. Aside from traveling to Omaha, Neb., for the 2010 College World Series, UCLA played three games in the Whataburger College Classic in Corpus Christi, Calif., that season. In 2009, UCLA spent three consecutive weekends on the road away from the West (at the Houston College Classic, Oklahoma and East Carolina).

WHAT'S ON DECK

UCLA hosts a three-game Pac-12 series against No. 13 Stanford beginning Friday, April 27. Game time is 6 p.m. The Bruins will send sophomore right-hander Adam Plutko to the mound in the series opener. Stanford will counter with junior right-hander Mark Appel. Stanford won the first and third game of a three-game set at Sunken Diamond in Palo Alto, Calif., last season. Next week, UCLA plays at Long Beach State on Tuesday (May 1), before hosting a three-game series against No. 15 Purdue on Saturday (doubleheader) and Sunday.

EXPERIENCED OFFENSE

UCLA's roster currently features five players who have played in at least 100 career games and eight players who have seen action in at least 60 career games. The Bruins' offense ranks second in the Pac-12 in batting average (.313), first in on-base percentage (.399) and tied for fourth in runs scored (239, with Arizona). Tyler Heineman (.405), Jeff Gelalich (.365) and Cody Keefer (.361) all rank within the top-10 in batting average in the Pac-12..

WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

Through 10 weeks, UCLA has had six Pac-12 Player/Pitcher of the Week award selections. Beau Amaral (March 26, April 16) and Jeff Gelalich (Feb. 29, March 13) have twice captured Player of the Week honors. Adam Plutko earned Pitcher of the Week honors (March 13) after throwing a complete game shutout at Georgia (March 9). Grant Watson was named Pitcher of the Week (March 20) after logging two wins in three games.

BULLPEN BRAWN

UCLA's bullpen has gone 9-3 with a 1.96 ERA in 124.0 innings, combining for 107 relief appearances through the team's first 36 games. In fact, the team's relief corps has held the opposition to 10 runs (eight earned) and 37 hits through the last 16 games (3-2 record, 1.19 ERA, with a .180 batting average). Scott Griggs has pitched nine scoreless innings, surrendering three hits, while logging 13 strikeouts and two hits in the last 16 games.

NEWS AND NOTES

UCLA had a 12-game winning streak earlier this year, the program's longest streak since opening 2010 with 22 consecutive victories ... Beau Amaral's 21-game hitting streak that ended April 22 was the longest by a UCLA ballplayer since 2001 (Josh Canales, 24-game streak) ... Tyler Heineman currently sports a .500 on-base percentage, which would stand as the program's highest OBP since 1997 (Troy Glaus, .520) were the season to end today ... UCLA closer Scott Griggs' eight saves ranks seventh (tied) on the school's single-season record list.

SEVEN-YEAR COMPOSITE

In conference games since 2006, UCLA ranks second in wins (102) and win percentage (.600). Through games played on Sunday, the Bruins rank fourth in total wins (238) and win percentage (.598). UCLA won the Pac-10 Conference title in outright fashion in 2011 for the first time since 1986 (three-way tie in 2000). The Bruins finished second in 2010 and earned a third-place finish from 2006 through 2009.

Brandon Crawford – San Francisco Giants (Shortstop)

- Opened the 2012 season as San Francisco's starting shortstop after having played in 66 games in 2011
- Started all 158 games in his three seasons at UCLA (2006-2008), leading the Bruins to the postseason each year
- Selected in the fourth round of the 2008 MLB Draft by his hometown San Francisco Giants

Ben Francisco – Toronto Blue Jays (Outfielder)

- Was traded to Toronto in the offseason after playing for Philadelphia in 2009, 2010 and 2011
- Helped lead Philadelphia to its second consecutive National League pennant in October 2009
- Selected in the fifth round of the 2002 MLB Draft by Cleveland after his junior season at UCLA

David Huff – Cleveland Indians (Left-Handed Pitcher)

- Led Cleveland with 11 wins on the mound during rookie campaign in 2009 (went 11-8 in 23 starts)
- Served as UCLA's No. 2 starter in 2006 after having transferred from Cypress College
- Selected No. 39 overall in the supplemental first round of the 2006 MLB Draft by Cleveland

Casey Janssen – Toronto Blue Jays (Right-Handed Pitcher)

- Returned to Toronto's big league club in 2009 after having missed all of 2008 with a shoulder injury
- Totaled a 4.34 ERA and 22-15 record in 54 games (43 starts) through 265.1 innings in four years at UCLA
- Selected in the fourth round of the 2004 MLB Draft by the Toronto Blue Jays

Josh Roenicke – Colorado Rockies (Right-Handed Pitcher)

- Traded to Colorado (from Toronto) midway through 2011, pitching in 19 games for the Rockies out of the bullpen
- Made his major league debut in Sept. 2008 with Cincinnati, who chose him in the 10th round of the 2006 MLB Draft
- Starred as a center fielder and relief pitcher at UCLA – did not pitch regularly until the 2006 season

Chase Utley – Philadelphia Phillies (Second Baseman)

- Helped Philadelphia win the 2008 World Series and return as the National League Champions in 2009
- Has posted a career .290 batting average and 188 home runs through 10 major league seasons
- Selected No. 15 overall in the first round of the 2000 MLB Draft by the Philadelphia Phillies

UCLA's roster features 13 players who have been selected in the MLB Draft at least once. All 13 of those players were drafted following their senior seasons of high school. The Bruins' freshman class includes three players drafted as high school seniors in June 2011, while the sophomore class features six players drafted out of high school.

HIGHLY DRAFTED

Head coach John Savage has produced 51 MLB Draft selections in his seven seasons at UCLA. Last June, right-handers Gerrit Cole (Pittsburgh) and Trevor Bauer (Arizona) became the first and third overall selections in the MLB Draft. Three of Savage's pitchers have already been promoted to the major leagues (Hector Ambriz, David Huff and Josh Roenicke). Most recently, three-year UCLA shortstop Brandon Crawford was promoted to the San Francisco Giants in May 2011. Of the 51 draft selections, 16 have been selected in the first 10 rounds.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

UCLA's 35-man roster features 32 players from California and one from Arizona, Nevada and Washington. The team includes nine juniors, 13 sophomores and 13 freshmen. Redshirt junior Chase Brewer is the team's most veteran member.
