## MIDWEEK MEETING IN FULLERTON

With eight games remaining on their regular-season schedule, the Bruins will play at No. 8 Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday. UCLA defeated the Titans, 4-2, when the two schools faced each other at Jackie Robinson Stadium on April 10. Grant Watson, slated to start this Tuesday, earned the victory in the previous meeting by limiting Cal State Fullerton to two runs and four hits in six innings. He did not allow any hits until the top of the fifth inning in that game. The Bruins last played at Cal State Fullerton on March 29, 2011, dropping a 5-3 decision that evening.

## UCLA SWEEPS WASHINGTON

The Bruins posted a perfect 4-0 record last week, winning at Pepperdine (6-2) on Tuesday before sweeping Washington in Seattle over the weekend. Jeff Gelalich led the offense by hitting .444 (8-for-18) with three home runs, while the pitching staff limited the opposition to seven runs in four games (1.50 ERA). UCLA has won 13 of its last 18 games, including seven of its last eight contests. The Bruins swept Washington for the fourth straight season and extended their winning streak against the Huskies to 14 games (dating back to April 26, 2008).

## GELALICH LEADS OFFENSE

Jeff Gelalich ranks first in batting average (.391) and second in on-base percentage (.474) in the Pac-12, through Sunday's games. He belted three home runs in four games for UCLA last week and is tied for fourth in the Pac-12 Conference with nine round-trippers. The junior outfielder from La Verne, Calif., leads UCLA with 22 multiple-hit games and is among the conference's top performers in hits (2nd, 72), slugging percentage (5th, .582), walks (t-5th, 26), runs scored (t-6th, 44) and stolen bases (t-1st, 15).

## BRUINS' BACKSTOP

Tyler Heineman has batted .358 with 24 RBI and 35 runs in 46 games, making 38 starts at catcher. Named to the revised watch list for the 2012 Johnny Bench Award last week, Heineman has thrown out 15 of 35 attempted base stealers (42.9 percent). The switch-hitting catcher from Pacific Palisades, Calif., has hit safely in 38 of 46 contests. As a team, UCLA's defense ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in caught stealing percentage (45.4 percent).

## TUESDAY'S STARTER

Grant Watson has gone 8-2 with a 4.95 ERA, serving as a starter during four weekends and in all midweek games as well as a reliever. Watson and teammates Ryan Deeter and Scott Griggs are tied for second in the Pac-12 in pitching appearances (28). Watson is also tied for fifth in wins (8) with Stanford's Mark Appel. He has started all nine midweek games for UCLA, going 5-0 with a 2.91 ERA in those contests (43.1 innings).

## VALUED IN RELIEF

David Berg set UCLA's freshman single-season appearances record on Sunday, pitching in his 35th game and earning the victory as the Bruins downed Washington, 4-2. Through Sunday's games, Berg ranked first in the Pac-12 in ERA (1.40) and opposing batting average (.169). In addition, Berg ranked fourth in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings (5.26). The right-hander from Covina, Calif., has pitched in UCLA's last 10 games, logging a 0.64 ERA with 13 strikeouts and no walks in 14.0 innings (one run allowed, 10 hits surrendered).

## ROAD WARRIORS

Since the start of the 2010 season, UCLA has gone 52-23 in all road and neutral site contests. The Bruins have opened this season with a 16-3 record away from home, posting a 9-3 mark on the road in Pac-12 games. Last year, UCLA went 14-13 in road/neutral site games, while in 2010 the Bruins went 15-4 on the road and 7-3 at neutral sites. UCLA has gone 29-10 in Pac-12 Conference road games since 2010. In addition, the Bruins have logged five Pac-12 road sweeps in the last three years (2010 UW, Cal; 2011 Oregon; 2012 UW, Utah).

## CENTER STAGE

Beau Amaral enters Tuesday night's game with a .317 batting average and Pac-12-best 53 runs scored. Amaral has compiled a .324 career batting average in 170 games (163 starts), the most career games played or starts of any player currently on UCLA's roster. Amaral has started in center field and served as UCLA's leadoff hitter in all 48 games this spring. Amaral and Jeff Gelalich are tied for the team lead with 17 extra-base hits.

## GRIGGS SETS SAVES RECORD

Scott Griggs picked up his 13th save in UCLA's 4-2 win at Washington on Sunday, establishing the school's new single-season saves record. Griggs eclipsed Gabe Sollecito's 12-save total from 1992 after having recorded his fifth save in the last three weeks. The junior right-hander from Alamo, Calif., has scattered 10 hits in 28.2 innings (.104 opposing batting average) and is tied for second on the staff with 49 strikeouts.

## WELL-TRAVELED BRUINS

In their eighth season under head coach John Savage, the Bruins have regularly played non-conference road series against teams away from the West Coast. In early March, UCLA swept a three-game series at then-No. 9 ranked Georgia. Last season, the Bruins played three consecutive extra-inning games at Nebraska. Aside from traveling to Omaha, Neb., for the 2010 College World Series, UCLA played three games in the Whataburger College Classic in Corpus Christi, Calif., that season. In 2009, UCLA spent three consecutive weekends on the road away from the West (at the Houston College Classic, Oklahoma and East Carolina).

## MR. VERSATILITY

Junior Trevor Brown has emerged as UCLA's most versatile position player. In three seasons, he has played catcher, first base, second base, third base and right field. Batting .300 with three homers and a team-best 38 RBI this season, Brown has made 18 career starts at catcher and 38 starts at first base this season, after having started 24 games at second base in 2011. He has made nine career starts at third base. Brown made his debut in the outfield (right field) on May 8 at Pepperdine and has played shortstop in summer leagues.

## WEEKLY AWARD WINNERS

Through 13 weeks, UCLA has had seven Pac-12 Player/Pitcher of the Week award selections. Beau Amaral (March 26, April 16) and Jeff Gelalich (Feb. 29, March 13) have twice captured Player of the Week honors. Adam Plutko (March 13, May 7) has twice secured Pitcher of the Week honors this season. Grant Watson was named Pitcher of the Week (March 20) after logging two wins in three games.

## ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Sophomore right-hander Ryan Deeter has secured Capital One Academic All-District VIII team honors, as announced by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Deeter has gone 1-0 with a 0.76 ERA in 23.2 innings. The Bruins' reliever from Newark, Calif., is tied for second among Pac-12 pitchers with 28 appearances (all in relief). Deeter has logged 20 strikeouts and 11 walks, limiting the opposition to a .200 batting average.

## NEWS AND NOTES

UCLA's defense has committed just two errors in the last nine games ... the Bruins have tallied the nation's best winning percentage away from home (.842 win percentage, includes road and neutral site games) ... UCLA has swept three teams on the road this season (at Georgia, at Utah, at Washington) ... the Bruins' next five games are all on the road before closing the season at home versus USC (May 25-27) at Jackie Robinson Stadium.

## SEVEN-YEAR COMPOSITE

In conference games since 2006, UCLA ranks second in wins (106) and win percentage (.602). Through games played May 13, the Bruins are tied for third in total wins (247) and rank fourth in win percentage (.600). UCLA won the Pac-10 Conference title in outright fashion in 2011 for the first time since 1986 (three-way tie in 2000). The Bruins finished second in 2010 and earned a third-place finish from 2006 through 2009.

### Brandon Crawford – San Francisco Giants (Shortstop)

- Opened the 2012 season as San Francisco's starting shortstop after having played in 66 games in 2011
- Started all 158 games in his three seasons at UCLA (2006-2008), leading the Bruins to the postseason each year
- Selected in the fourth round of the 2008 MLB Draft by his hometown San Francisco Giants

### Ben Francisco – Toronto Blue Jays (Outfielder)

- Was traded to Toronto in the offseason after playing for Philadelphia in 2009, 2010 and 2011
- Helped lead Philadelphia to its second consecutive National League pennant in October 2009
- Selected in the fifth round of the 2002 MLB Draft by Cleveland after his junior season at UCLA

### Casey Janssen – Toronto Blue Jays (Right-Handed Pitcher)

- Returned to Toronto's big league club in 2009 after having missed all of 2008 with a shoulder injury
- Totaled a 4.34 ERA and 22-15 record in 54 games (43 starts) through 265.1 innings in four years at UCLA
- Selected in the fourth round of the 2004 MLB Draft by the Toronto Blue Jays

### Josh Roenicke – Colorado Rockies (Right-Handed Pitcher)

- Traded to Colorado (from Toronto) midway through 2011, pitching in 19 games for the Rockies out of the bullpen
- Made his major league debut in Sept. 2008 with Cincinnati, who chose him in the 10th round of the 2006 MLB Draft
- Starred as a center fielder and relief pitcher at UCLA – did not pitch regularly until the 2006 season

### Chase Utley – Philadelphia Phillies (Second Baseman)

- Helped Philadelphia win the 2008 World Series and return as the National League Champions in 2009
- Has posted a career .290 batting average and 188 home runs through 10 major league seasons
- Selected No. 15 overall in the first round of the 2000 MLB Draft by the Philadelphia Phillies

UCLA's roster features 13 players who have been selected in the MLB Draft at least once. All 13 of those players were drafted following their senior seasons of high school. The Bruins' freshman class includes three players drafted as high school seniors in June 2011, while the sophomore class features six players drafted out of high school.

## HIGHLY DRAFTED

Head coach John Savage has produced 51 MLB Draft selections in his seven seasons at UCLA. Last June, right-handers Gerrit Cole (Pittsburgh) and Trevor Bauer (Arizona) became the first and third overall selections in the MLB Draft. Three of Savage's pitchers have already been promoted to the major leagues (Hector Ambriz, David Huff and Josh Roenicke). Most recently, three-year UCLA shortstop Brandon Crawford was promoted to the San Francisco Giants in May 2011. Of the 51 draft selections, 16 have been selected in the first 10 rounds.

## ROSTER BREAKDOWN

UCLA's 35-man roster features 32 players from California and one from Arizona, Nevada and Washington. The team includes nine juniors, 13 sophomores and 13 freshmen. Redshirt junior Chase Brewer is the team's most veteran member. Brewer, along with juniors Beau Amaral, Trevor Brown, Jeff Gelalich, Scott Griggs, Tyler Heineman, Cody Keefer and Cody Regis, and redshirt sophomores Ryan Deeter, Matt Giovino and Aaron Weimer are the remaining members from UCLA's 2010 College World Series team.

## STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

UCLA has gone 14-8 against teams ranked in Baseball America's weekly top-25 poll this season. The Bruins enter this week having played the No. 1-ranked strength of schedule, as ranked by Boyd's World (boydsworld.com, a nationally-respected ranking service). Likewise, WarrenNolan.com has tabbed the Bruins' schedule as the No. 2 most challenging slate through the first 13 weeks of the regular season.

John Savage became UCLA's first head coach to lead the Bruins to the finals of the College World Series in 2010, guiding UCLA to a 51-17 record last season. Previously, he became the first head coach in program history to have led UCLA to three consecutive NCAA Regionals (2006-08). Named the Bruins' head coach in the summer of 2004, Savage has led UCLA to NCAA postseason appearances in five of his seven years in Westwood. Additionally, he has helped the program produce 51 MLB Draft selections.
