#### **MLB DRAFT NOTES**

Selected in the 2011 MLB Draft by the Kansas City Royals in the 15th round (No. 456 overall)...was also chosen in the 2008 MLB Draft by the Colorado Rockies in the 41st round after his senior year at Red Mountain High School.

#### **AS A JUNIOR (2011)**

Played in all 59 games, making 58 starts (57 at first base and one as the designated hitter)...led UCLA with a .320 batting average in 2011, totaling three home runs, 15 doubles, 40 RBI and a .424 slugging percentage...finished the season first on the ballclub with 24 mutliple-hit games, including a season-best four-hit effort and six three-hit games...was second on the team with eight multiple-RBI games, including a team-leading three four-RBI games...batted .336 in all 27 Pac-10 games, finishing conference play



with one home run, eight doubles, 18 RBI and four stolen bases in four attempts...led UCLA with a .357 batting average in 27 road games, going 41-for-115 with one homer, 18 RBI and 16 runs...hit safely in eight of the team's final nine games...batted .500 in a three-game series at Arizona State (May 27-29), going 7-for-14 with one home run, two doubles, six RBI and three runs as the Bruins clinched the outright Pac-10 title that weekend...went 4-for-4 with one home run, one double, four RBI and two runs in a 7-0 victory at Arizona State (May 28)...had consecutive three-hit games at Pepperdine (May 3) and at Oregon (May 6) on a week in which the Bruins went 4-0.

### **AS A SOPHOMORE (2010)**

Played in 63 games, making 40 starts (22 at first base, 18 at third base)...was second on the ballclub with a .345 batting average, tied for the team lead in home runs with nine and led the Bruins with 52 RBl...tied for sixth in the Pac-10 with 52 RBl...finished the year with seven doubles, three triples, 35 runs and a team-leading .575 slugging percentage...stole eight bases in nine attempts...ranked fourth on the team with 19 multiple-hit games and was tied for first (with Cody Regis) with 15 multiple-hit games, including two four-hit efforts and four three-hit performances...batted .281 in the postseason, going 9-for-32 with two home runs, seven RBI and five runs...went 6-for-13 with one home run, five RBI and three runs in a three-game series sweep of Nebraska (March 5-6)...went 3-for-4 with one homer, three RBI and two runs in the series finale against Nebraska (March 6), a 5-4 victory — scored the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth, tagging up from third base on a sacrifice fly to center field by Tyler Rahmatulla...had a season-best day in the series opener against Oral Roberts (March 20), going 4-for-4 with one home run, four RBI and two runs...went 3-for-5 in the series opener against Cal Poly (March 25), collecting one triple, one double and two RBI...went 4-for-6 in two games against Stanford (April 1 and 3)...had a flare single to center field in the bottom of the ninth against Stanford (April 1) to score the game-winning run and extend UCLA's record to 22-0...went 2-for-5 with one triple, one double, one run and one RBI in a 10-0 victory at UC Riverside (April 13)...went 4-for-13 with one home run, four runs and three RBI in a three-game series versus Oregon (April 16-18)...went 5-for-9 in a three-game series sweep at California (May 21-23)...had an RBI-pinch-hit single to hand UCLA the lead in the eighth inning in the series opener (May 21) ...went 1-for-2 with a two-run pinch-hit triple in the second game of the series at California (May 22)...went 3-for-4 with one home run, three RBI and

One-year letterwinner at South Mountain Community College (Phoenix) under head coach Todd Eastin...batted .361 in 60 regular-season games for South Mountain as a freshman (2009)...earned second-team NJCAA All-Region I honors, securing second-team all-conference accolades...ranked sixth in the Arizona Community College Athletic Conference (ACCAC) with 70 hits and third with seven triples...totaled three home runs, 16 doubles, 40 RBI and 36 runs...posted a .425 on-base percentage.
