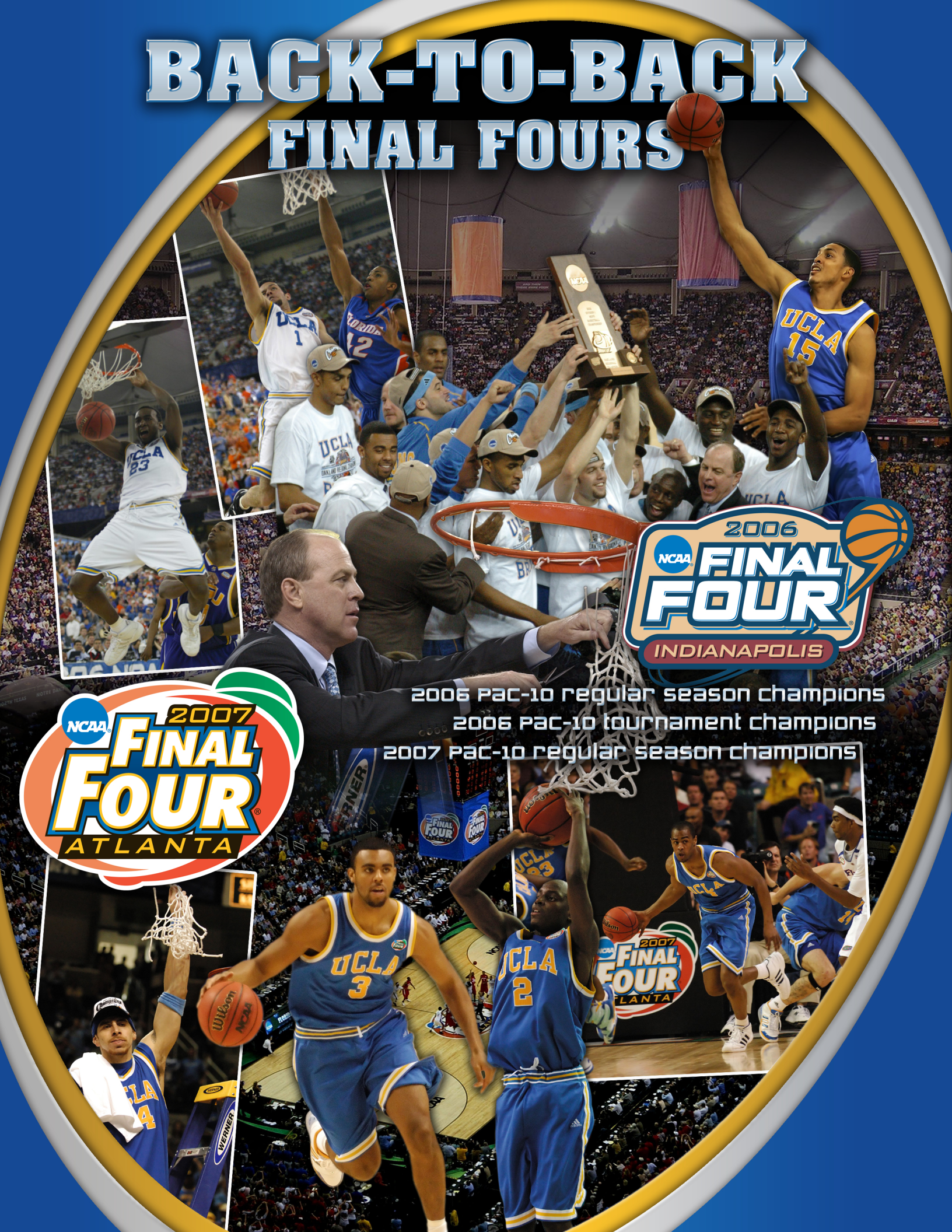

THE BEN HOWLAND ERA

TWO FINAL FOUR APPEARANCES IN FOUR SEASONS

- ▶ Has led UCLA to three NCAA Tournaments, including two Final Fours, in four seasons
- ▶ Guided the Bruins to Pac-10 regular season titles in 2005-06 and 2006-07
- ▶ UCLA's 62 wins over the last two seasons are the most in a two-year span in UCLA men's basketball history
- ▶ Named National and Pac-10 coach of the year in 2005-06, leading UCLA to a 32-7 mark
- ▶ Under coach Howland, the Bruins posted a perfect 16-0 mark at home in 2006-07
- ▶ Has led three teams to the NCAA Tournament (UCLA, Pittsburgh, Northern Arizona)
- ▶ At UCLA, has had five NBA draft selections, including two first-round picks
- ▶ Has totaled a 91-41 overall record in four seasons at UCLA, including a 47-25 Pac-10 mark
