### UCLA FOOTBALL FACTS

- Only eight schools in the nation have recorded more bowl victories than UCLA (10) over the last 23 **years.** (Among those schools, UCLA's winning percentage of .625 ranks seventh)
- UCLA has more bowl wins (10) in the last 23 years than any other school in the Pac-10.
- No other school in the Pac-10 has more final Associated Press Top 25 rankings than the Bruins over the last 23 years.
- Only eight schools, none from the Pac-10, have been ranked in the Top 10 more often than UCLA in the last 23 seasons.
- 135 of UCLA's last 143 games

- Eight Bruin players and three coaches have been elected to the National Football Foundation Hall of Fame.
- UCLA's eight-game winning streak against USC between 1991 and 1998 is the longest in the history of the series.
  - Sixteen Bruin football players have earned NCAA Post-Graduate **Scholarships.** (Five — Carlton Gray in 1992, George Kase in 1995, Chris Sailer and Shawn Stuart in 1998 and Danny Farmer in 1999—in the last 13 seasons).
    - Seventeen UCLA football players have been selected to CoSIDA Academic All-America teams.
