The second-ranked UCLA men's golf team prepares for the NCAA West Regional Championship at The Farms Golf Course in Rancho Santa Fe, CA, May 19-21.

UCLA has won three NCAA Regional titles: 2009 (Central), 2004 and '03 (West). The Bruins placed second in the 2007 West Regional, third in the 2010 East Regional, tied for fourth in the 2005 West Regional and fifth in the 2008 West Regional.

Under Coach Derek Freeman, the Bruins have won one regional championship (2009) and a national championship (2008). Since 2003, the Bruins have recorded eight straight Top 10 regional results and have qualified for the NCAA Championship in each of those seasons, a school record.

Two UCLA players have won NCAA Regional individual titles: 2004 (West) Travis Johnson tied for first and 2006 (East) Kevin Chappell won in Florida.

In nearly four years as head coach, Freeman has guided the Bruins to a total of 11 tournament victories. In 2010-11, the Bruins have won three tournaments: The Gifford Collegiate Championship in November, the Battle at the Beach in February and the 65th Western Intercollegiate in April.

Overall, four UCLA players have won six individual titles this season: sophomore Pontus Widegren won the first major tournament of the season — the Fall Preview — in September; sophomore Mario Clemens won the Cal Poly Invitational in October; freshman Patrick Cantlay won the Gifford Collegiate Championship in November, tied for first in the Amer Ani Invitational in February and won the USC Invitational in March; and junior Gregor Main won the Del Walker Intercollegiate in March.

The Bruins received one of six regional No.1 seeds. The others are Florida (Golden Ocala GC, Ocala, FL), Georgia Tech (Pete Dye River Course, Blacksburg, VA), Alabama (Wolf Run GC, Zionsville, IN), Oklahoma State (Colorado National GC, Boulder, CO) and Texas A & M, (Omni Tucson National, Tucson, AZ).

Overall, eight Pac-10 teams received berths for regional competition, including USC, a No. 3 seed in the West. Cal, Washington and Arizona will compete at Tucson National. Arizona State travels to Colorado, Stanford visits Indiana and Oregon goes to Florida.
