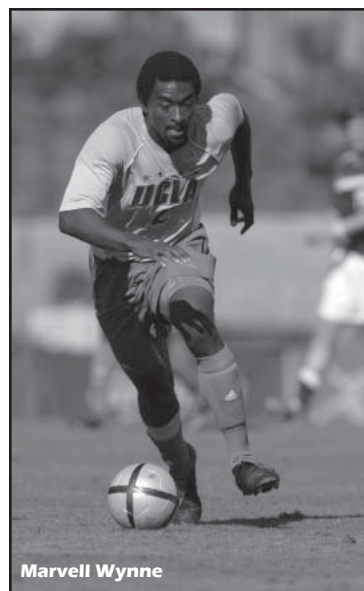

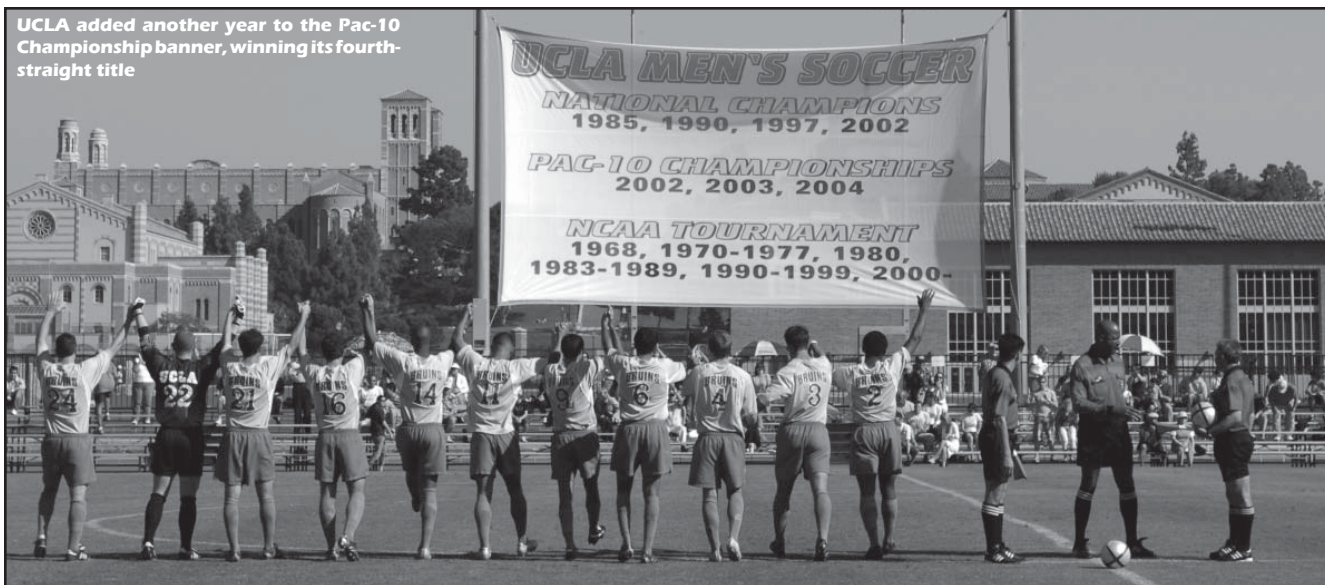

UCLA added another year to the Pac-10 Championship banner, winning its fourth-straight title



UCLA WINS 4TH-STRAIGHT PAC-10 TITLE

The Bruins were the first team to earn a spot in the 2005 NCAA Tournament after they clinched the Pac-10 title with a 1-0 win over Stanford on Nov. 4 and a 1-1 tie against Cal on Nov. 6. The Pac-10 title was UCLA's fourth consecutive, making seniors Jordan Harvey, Evan Corey, Nate Pena and Ryan Valdez the first players in UCLA history to win a conference championship all four years. The Bruins' NCAA Tournament appearance was their 23rd consecutive and 33rd overall. UCLA lost, 3-0, to SMU in the second round of the NCAA Tournament to finish the season with a 12-5-3 overall record and a 7-1-2 record in Pac-10 play.

DEFENSIVE LOCKDOWN

UCLA ranked amongst the nation's leaders in defense all season and finished the year ranked first in shutout percentage (0.70), 12th in goals against average (0.67) and 16th in shots on goal save percentage (0.829). Goalkeeper Eric Reed ranked sixth in the nation in goalkeeping (0.598) and in shots on goal save percentage (0.843).

MOVING UP RECORD BOOKS

The 2005 Bruins recorded 14 shutouts on the year, second-most in school history, and allowed just 14 goals, ranked fourth-best in school history. UCLA had a six-game consecutive shutout streak, the third-longest streak in school history.

Goalkeeper Eric Reed's 12 shutouts rank third on the UCLA single-season charts. With a career goals against average of 0.67 entering the 2006 season, Reed ranks second on the career charts.

STINGY HOSTS

The 2005 Bruins became the first Pac-10 and UCLA team to shut out all home opponents in the regular season. In their eight regular

season home games, the Bruins went 7-0-1 and allowed zero goals and just 63 shots (7.9 avg.). UCLA owns an all-time record of 47-8-3 at Frank W. Marshall Field.

BRUINS DOMINATE EVENTUAL NCAA CHAMPION MARYLAND

Amongst the highlights of the Bruins' season was a 4-0 thumping of eventual NCAA champion Maryland on Sept. 4 in UCLA's home opener. In his first collegiate start, freshman Sal Zizzo scored a goal and recorded two assists, and Maxwell Griffin, Evan Corey and Luke Mehring also registered goals for the Bruins. The Bruin defense shut down Maryland, allowing only seven shots, none of which were on goal.

ALL-AMERICAN DUO

Defender Marvell Wynne and defensive midfielder Patrick Ianni were the stalwarts of the UCLA defense and were duly rewarded in the post-season, being named NSCAA/adidas All-Americans. Wynne was a first-team selection, and Ianni was a second-team honoree, extending UCLA's streak to 23 consecutive years with an All-American. Wynne and Ianni were also semifinalists for the M.A.C. Hermann Trophy.

In addition to their defensive prowess, the duo also contributed offensively. Wynne had one goal (game-winner against Loyola Marymount) and three assists, while Ianni recorded two goals, including the game-winner at Washington, and two assists.

ALL-REGION/ALL-CONFERENCE HONOREES

Wynne and Ianni led a group of four UCLA players named to the NSCAA/adidas All-Far West team. The duo earned first-team honors, while forward and leading scorer Kamani Hill (7 goals, 8 assists, 22 points) was a second-team honoree. Goalkeeper Eric Reed (0.598 GAA) received third-team acclaim.

All four of the All-Region honorees were also named to the All-Pac-10 first team. Jonathan Bornstein (5 goals, 2 assists), Jordan Harvey (3 goals, 2 assists), Brandon Owens (contributed to 13 shutouts) and Sal Zizzo (1 goal, 5 assists) earned second-team honors, and defender Brad Rusin received honorable mention acclaim.

ZIZZO NAMED PAC-10 FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

Midfielder Sal Zizzo was named the Pac-10 Freshman of the Year after leading all conference rookies in assists (5) and points (7). He was also selected to *Soccer America's* All-Freshman second team and earned second-team All-Pac-10 acclaim, becoming the only freshman in the conference to make the first or second team.

ACADEMIC STANDOUTS

Junior defender Luke Mehring earned CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District 8 honors with a 3.4 GPA in History. Mehring was also selected to the Pac-10 All-Academic team (second-team), along with Evan Corey (first-team, 3.41 gpa), Eric Reed (second-team, 3.21), Greg Folk (honorable mention) and Mike Zaher (honorable mention).

WYNNE PICKED NO. 1 IN MLS DRAFT

After Marvell Wynne's All-America season, he was selected No. 1 in the 2006 Major League Soccer draft by the New York Red Bulls. He became the third UCLA player to be selected No. 1 overall in the league's history. Patrick Ianni was also a first-round pick, being selected No. 8 overall by the Houston Dynamo. Local team Chivas USA selected Jonathan Bornstein in the fourth round, and the Colorado Rapids chose Jordan Harvey in the supplement draft. All four players made the opening day roster, giving UCLA a total of 22 former players on MLS rosters in 2006.

BRUINS IN THE CONFERENCE

Men's soccer is in its seventh year as a Pacific-10 Conference sanctioned sport. Six Pac-10 teams comprise the Pac-10 Men's Soccer Conference - UCLA, California, Oregon State, Stanford, Washington and 2005 addition San Diego State.

In 2005, three conference teams advanced to the NCAA Tournament - UCLA, California and San Diego State. The Bruins won their fourth consecutive Pac-10 title, posting a 7-1-2 league mark.

The Pac-10 branched out of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) after the 1999 season to form its own conference. Since 2000, the Pac-10 has had at least three teams advance to the NCAA Tournament every season.

The Pacific-10 Conference continues to uphold its tradition as the "Conference of Champions." Pac-10 members have claimed an incredible 137 NCAA team titles over the past 16 seasons, for an average of more than eight championships per academic year.
