### Bruins and Hurricanes to Meet This Thursday in NCAA Round of 16

After moving through NCAA Regional play without dropping a point, the seventh-seeded UCLA men's tennis team (19-4) heads to College Station, Texas this week for the remaining rounds of the NCAA Championships, May 14-19, at Texas A&M's George P. Mitchell Tennis Center. The Bruins will take on unseeded Miami (16-8) in a round of 16 showdown this Thursday at 4:00 p.m. (PST). The winner of that match advances to play either 15th-seeded Texas A&M or second-seeded Mississippi in the quarterfinals on Saturday at 3:00 p.m. (PST).

### Following the Action

Fans who are not making the trip to College Station, Texas this week can still follow the action online at Texas A&M's official athletic website: [www.aggieathletics.com](http://www.aggieathletics.com). Live stats and live video will be provided free of charge. In addition, the men's team final on May 19 will air live on ESPN at Noon (PST).

### UCLA vs. Miami

UCLA takes a 10-0 all-time record against Miami into this Thursday's match. The last time the two teams faced off was two years ago in the first round of the ITA National Team Indoors in Chicago, a 4-1 Bruin victory. The last NCAA Tournament meeting between the two teams was back in 1987 in Athens, Ga. UCLA won that quarterfinal encounter by a score of 5-1.

### UCLA Makes 33rd NCAA Tournament

UCLA's selection to the 64-team NCAA field makes it 33 straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the program. In fact, UCLA is the only school to compete in every NCAA Tournament since the team format was adopted in 1977. The Bruins rank second in all-time NCAA Championships with 16.

### UCLA is 5-4 Against the Field

UCLA's 2009 record against the other 15 teams still alive in the NCAA Tournament stands at 5-4. The Bruins' wins have come over Boise State (6-1), Stanford (4-3), USC (4-3 & 5-2), and Illinois (4-2). UCLA's four losses - its only four of the year - have come against Stanford (4-3), Ohio State (4-0), Baylor (4-3) and Virginia (4-3).

### Bruins Cruise Through Regional Play

UCLA won both of its NCAA Regional matches last week, as the Bruins improved to 24-0 in regional play since its inception in 1998. UCLA failed to yield a point in either match, defeating both Southern Illinois and Hawai'i by 4-0 scores.

### Repeat in College Station?

UCLA's most recent NCAA title was actually captured at Texas A&M's George P. Mitchell Tennis Center in 2005. The Bruins defeated top-seeded and undefeated Baylor, 4-3 in a match that many still consider the most exciting championship in tournament history. Coincidentally, the last time UCLA was a No. 7 seed was back in 2005.

### Winning Streak Reaches 12

UCLA takes a 12-match winning streak into this Thursday's meeting with Miami. The Bruins' last loss was a 4-3 defeat to No. 5 Stanford on Feb. 28. UCLA's 12-match streak is currently the country's fourth longest behind Virginia (31), Ole Miss (19) and Baylor (14).

### Going for 20

At 19-4 overall, UCLA is just one win away from registering the program's 11th straight 20-win season, and 14th in head coach Billy Martin's 16 years as head coach.

### Another Pac-10 Title in the Books

UCLA captured the program's 33rd conference championship on April 17, posting a 5-2 victory over No. 7 USC at the Los Angeles Tennis Center. Both the Bruins and Trojans entered the final match of the regular season with perfect 5-0 records in league play. UCLA won the doubles point and then received singles wins from Haythem Abid, Holden Seguso, Nick Meister and Amit Inbar. It marked the Bruins' second victory over the Trojans this season, as UCLA also took a 4-3 non-conference road win back on March 5.

### Abid Named First-Team All-Pac-10

UCLA's Haythem Abid earned first-team All-Pac-10 honors last week, headlining a group of six Bruins who were recognized by the conference. Michael Look and Matt Brooklyn were named to the All-Pac-10 second team, while Holden Seguso, Nick Meister and Harel Srugo earned honorable mention acclaim. It marks the third career All-Pac-10 honor for Abid, who was chosen first-team in 2007 and second team in 2006. *(Complete 2009 All-Pac-10 teams can be found on page 3).*

### UCLA in the Campbell's/ITA Rankings

UCLA checked in at No. 7 in the final Campbell's/ITA Rankings of the regular season released last Tuesday. New rankings will not be released again until the end of the NCAA Championships. Individually, Haythem Abid is UCLA's highest ranked player at No. 49. He is followed by No. 64 Matt Brooklyn, No. 100 Michael Look and No. 107 Nick Meister. In doubles, Abid and Meister are the Bruins' highest ranked team at No. 29. Meister is also ranked with Michael Look at No. 52. Amit Inbar and Harel Srugo check in at No. 80.

### Inbar/Srugo Undefeated

UCLA's No. 2 doubles team of Amit Inbar and Harel Srugo has been fantastic this season, posting a perfect 13-0 record. The two players, both from Israel, did not start teaming together until a Feb. 27 showdown against Cal. They were initially UCLA's No. 3 doubles team but quickly moved into the No. 2 slot after enjoying so much success.

### Abid Earns NCAA Singles Berth

Junior Haythem Abid received an at-large selection to the 2009 NCAA Singles Championships and will be competing in the event at the conclusion of the team tournament, May 20-25, in College Station, Texas. Abid last played the tournament in 2007, falling to Georgia's Luis Flores, 6-3, 4-6, 6-2 in the opening round. Matt Brooklyn was chosen as the sixth singles alternate to this year's tournament and will get into the tournament if six players withdraw prior to the start of play. The Bruins did not have any doubles teams selected to compete this year.

### Did You Know?

UCLA owns a perfect 11-0 record when winning at the No. 1 singles position. All four of the Bruins' losses this year have come following at loss at the top spot.

### UCLA Offers a Second Chance for Brooklyn, Inbar

Just one year removed from playing at other universities, junior Matt Brooklyn and sophomore Amit Inbar are both making a difference for UCLA this season. Brooklyn, who was Arizona State's top player from 2006-2008, was forced to seek out another program after the Sun Devils dropped men's tennis following the 2008 season. Ranked No. 64 nationally in singles, he is currently playing No. 1 for the Bruins this year. Inbar, who was the top player at Maryland as a freshman last year, chose to come out west for a warmer climate and the chance to win a national title. He owns a 20-9 overall singles record and is currently undefeated at No. 2 doubles with partner Harel Srugo.

### Brooklyn Leads Team in Ranked Wins

Junior Matt Brooklyn leads the team in wins over ranked opponents with eight. His highest ranked win on the season came over No. 16 Bradley Klahn of Stanford at the Sherwood Collegiate Cup in January. Four other players are tied with four ranked wins on the season. The highest ranked opponent defeated by a UCLA player this season was No. 1-ranked Robert Farah of USC, who lost 6-4, 6-3 to Haythem Abid on March 5.

### Meister's 25 is Tops

With 25 singles victories thus far, sophomore Nick Meister is on the verge of leading the team in singles wins for the second year in a row. Meister, who takes a 25-7 overall record into this week's round of 16, leads Matt Brooklyn (22-11) by three wins. Ranking third on the team in wins is Amit Inbar with 20. Meister led the team in singles wins as a freshman in 2008 as he was the only player to reach the 30-win mark (30-10).

## Kwinta Returns to College Station

When the Bruins take the courts for practice at the George P. Mitchell Tennis Center this week, assistant coach Kris Kwinta might be seen re-enacting a special moment over on court No. 3. After all, it was at that court that Kwinta registered one of the biggest wins in UCLA history, as his three-set victory over Lars Poerschke clinched the 2005 national championship for UCLA. The Bruins, who were crushed by Baylor, 4-0 in the 2004 final, were a heavy underdog heading into the rematch in College Station, as Baylor was the top seed and owned a 57-match winning streak. After falling behind 3-1, UCLA looked like it was going to succumb to the Bears once again. However wins by Philipp Gruendler and Alberto Francis kept the Bruins in it. Kwinta, who had lost the first set, managed to battle back to take the next two sets 6-4, 6-4, giving UCLA its first national championship since 1984 (16th overall). When Poerschke's forehand sailed long on match point, Kwinta threw his racket over the fence before being mobbed by teammates. That final still goes down as one of the most exciting in NCAA history.

## Success at the Bottom

Although the Bruins feature one of the more balanced attacks in the country, it's hard to ignore just how good UCLA has been at the Nos. 4-6 singles positions this year. Consider this. The Bruins take a 56-8 record at those three spots into this week's NCAA Round of 16. That is compared to just a 34-24 record at the Nos. 1-3 slots. Much of the Bruins' success at the back can be attributed to Amit Inbar and Nick Meister, who are 17-3 and 17-2, respectively at the Nos. 4-6 spots.

## Not So Fast

Any team assuming it is going to beat UCLA just because it wins the doubles point might want to think again, as the Bruins actually own a winning record (4-3) when losing the doubles point. The Bruins have battled back to post wins over Fresno State, San Diego State, Illinois and Stanford, all after falling behind 1-0. On the other side of the coin, the Bruins are 15-1 when taking the doubles point.

## Streiking at the Right Time

Nick Meister takes an 11-match singles winning streak into the NCAA Round of 16. He has also won 14 of his last 15, with his lone loss coming to USC's Matt Kecki on March 5. Amit Inbar is also playing well, winning 12 of his last 13 matches. In fact, he recently had his 11-match winning streak snapped when he fell to Stanford's Bradley Klahn, 6-3, 6-2 in the first round of the Pac-10 Championships. Klahn went on to win the tournament.

## Martin's Quarterfinal Streak

In 15 seasons as head coach at UCLA, Billy Martin has never had a team finish out of the top 5 at the NCAA Championships. In other words, the Bruins have never lost prior to the quarterfinals during Martin's tenure as head coach.

## Going For 105

The UCLA women's water polo team recently captured the school's 104th NCAA Team Championship on Sunday, defeating USC, 5-4 in the title match in Maryland. UCLA leads the nation in NCAA Team Championships and was the first school to reach 100 NCAA Championships when the women's water polo team won the title in 2007. Stanford ranks second in all-time NCAA Championships. USC is third.

## Look Excels in the Classroom

As good as Michael Look has been on the court this year - he is 19-8 in singles and ranked No. 100 nationally - he just might be even better in the classroom, as the Bruin senior was recently named UCLA's Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year. Look, from Redcliffe, Australia, carries a 3.91 GPA (highest among UCLA male student-athletes) and is majoring in business-economics with a minor in accounting.

## Head Coach Billy Martin

UCLA head coach Billy Martin owns a 366-69 (.841) overall coaching record in his 16th season at the helm of the Bruin tennis program. Martin led UCLA to the school's 16th NCAA title in men's tennis in 2005, ending a 20-year title drought for the program. Inducted into the ITA Tennis Hall of Fame in 1996, Martin's playing career is full of highlights. To this very day he is still regarded as one of the best junior players in the history of the sport. He captured the 1973 and '74 singles titles at Junior Wimbledon, the Junior U.S. Open and Junior Orange Bowl tournaments. Inside Tennis Magazine recently ran an article that named him Junior Player of the Century. As a Bruin freshman, he guided the 1975 team to one of its best seasons, posting a perfect 19-0 dual-match record en route to an NCAA team championship. He captured the 1975 NCAA Singles Championship before leaving school to pursue a professional tennis career.
