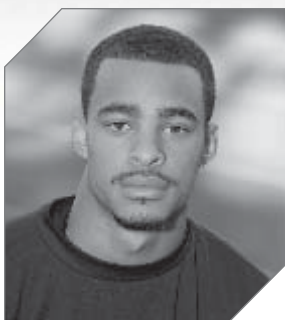

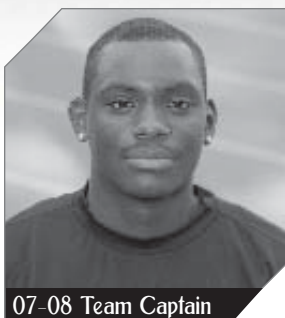

Won the Pac-10 title in the 110mH with a lifetime-best 13.48 (No. 3 all-time at UCLA) ... Placed third in the high hurdles at USC (13.76) and at the UCSD Invites (14.01) ... Won the Cal/Nevada Championships crown (14.08) ... In indoor track, was ranked seventh in the country in the 60m hurdles (7.73/school record) ...
