## PACIFIC-10 CONFERENCE OUTDOOR TRACK AND FIELD ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- Pacific-10 Conference outdoor track and field athlete of the week honors for the week of May 5-11:

**Men's Track Athlete of the Week:** **ANDREW WHEATING, OREGON** (So., Norwich, Vt.). Wheating won the 1,500 meters at Friday's Oregon Twilight Meet in a time of 3:38.60. That time is the best in the nation this season (all levels) and met the Olympic Trials A Standard. That time also ranks sixth on Oregon's career top-10.

**Men's Field Athletes of the Week:** **GREG GARZA, UCLA** (Sr., Indio, Calif.). The senior All-American posted the No. 2 discus mark in the NCAA this season with his season-best mark of 204-9 at the Modesto Relays. Garza was the top collegiate finisher and fifth overall in the competition which featured Olympians and former All-Americans.

**Women's Track Athlete of the Week:** **NICOLE BLOOD, OREGON** (So., Simi Valley, Calif.). Blood was the top collegian (3rd overall) in the 1,500 meters at Friday's Oregon Twilight Meet in a time of 4:14.73. That time leads the Pac-10 and ranks second nationally. That time also ranks fourth on Oregon's career top-10.

**Women's Field Athlete of the Week:** **JACQUELYN JOHNSON, ARIZONA STATE** (Sr., Yuma, Ariz.) Johnson scored 6,307 points to win her third Pac-10 heptathlon crown. Her score is a Pac-10 record, a Pac-10 meet record, an ASU school record, an ASU Sun Angel Stadium record, the third-best total in NCAA history and the best score by a collegiate athlete since 1995. In individual events, Johnson set school heptathlon records in the 100m hurdles (13.21), high jump (1.81m), long jump (6.30m), javelin (48.50m) and both the first day (3,700) and second day (2,607) point totals.
