

NO. 2 UCLA HOLDS OFF NO. 7 PACIFIC, 13-11

UCLA trailed 3-2 in the second quarter but regained the lead at 4-3, a lead they would not relinquish

LOS ANGELES – The No. 2 UCLA men's water polo team won a second-round winner's bracket match at the SoCal Tournament with a 13-11 non-conference win over No. 7 Pacific at Spieker Aquatics Center on Saturday afternoon. Sophomore Josh Samuels led the Bruins (7-1) with four goals, while sophomore Griffin White scored three goals (two on power plays) for UCLA. Junior goalkeeper Andrew Mesesan returned to the cage after sitting out the Bruins' first match of the day and recorded four saves. Freshman Balazs Erdelyi led Pacific (7-3) with a match-high five goals. Freshman goalie Alex Malkis registered three saves for the Tigers.
