

NO. 13 UC SAN DIEGO DEFEATS NO. 9 PEPPERDINE, 8-7

The Tritons led 3-1 at the half and held off a late Pepperdine rally to seal the win

LOS ANGELES – The No. 13 UC San Diego men's water polo team won a third-round consolation bracket match at the SoCal Tournament with a 8-7 non-conference win over Pepperdine at Spieker Aquatics Center on Sunday morning. Senior Bryce Madsen and sophomore Brian Donohoe led the Tritons with two goals apiece, including Donohoe's eventual game-winning score with 51 seconds left in the fourth period. Junior goalie David Morton registered six saves in goal for UC San Diego (8-6). Sophomores Danny White and Spencer Hamby added two more goals each to lead Pepperdine (7-7). Senior goalkeeper Bryce McLain recorded eight stops in the cage for the Waves.
