

NO. 4 STANFORD DEFEATS NO. 8 LONG BEACH STATE, 9-8

LOS ANGELES – The No. 4 Stanford men's water polo team won a third-round consolation bracket match at the SoCal Tournament with a 9-8 conference win over No. 8 Long Beach State at Spieker Aquatics Center on Sunday morning. Junior Jacob Smith led the Cardinal with five goals, including the game-winning penalty score with 1:45 left in the fourth period. Junior goalie Brian Pingree registered eleven saves in goal for Stanford (6-3). Freshman Dan Matulis added three more goals (two on the power play) to lead Long Beach State (6-5). Sophomore goalkeeper Matthew Kubeck recorded nine stops in the cage for the 49ers.
