

NO. 4 STANFORD BLASTS NO. 13 UC SAN DIEGO, 22-12

The Cardinal scored the first three goals of the match and led 13-6 at the break to cruise to victory

LOS ANGELES – The No. 4 Stanford men's water polo team opened the SoCal Tournament with a 22-12 non-conference win over No. 13 UC San Diego at Sunset Canyon Recreation Center on Saturday morning. Four players (Alex Avery, Jeffrey Schwimer, Jacob Smith and Ryan Brown) each scored three goals to lead Stanford (5-2). Junior goalkeeper Brian Pingree recorded nine stops in the cage for the Cardinal. UC San Diego (6-6) was led by sophomore Brian Donohoe and junior Graham Saber, who each scored two power play goals for the Tritons. Junior goalie David Morton had six saves for UC San Diego.
