

Season In Review



A Look Back at 2009-10

The Bruins completed the season with an overall record of 25-9 and a 15-3 mark in the Pac-10, good for second place in the conference. It was the ninth time in the last 13 seasons that the Bruin program has finished among the conference's top four teams (only one Pac-10 program has a better track record in that period).

The 25 wins were the fourth-best total in school history. The 15 conference wins matched UCLA's best Pac-10 total ever. The second-place finish was UCLA's best since it captured a share of first place in the 1998-99 season.

The team held opponents to 57.5 points per game which ranked as the lowest mark in school history. A .371 opponent shooting % on the season rated as the second-lowest in school history. The Bruins rattled off 10 straight wins along the way to 25, which was the longest streak since the 1998-99 team also posted 10 consecutive victories.

Coach of the Year

Nikki Caldwell was named Pac-10 Coach of the Year in votes by the media and the conference coaches. She is the first UCLA women's coach to win this honor. Caldwell is the first Bruin to be named Conference Coach of the Year since Billie Moore earned WCAA honors in 1984-85.

Dixon Sees 30/20

Sophomore Jasmine Dixon became just the second Bruin to ever score at least 30 points and grab at least 20 rebounds in a game. Dixon totaled 31 points and collected 20 caroms in a come-from-behind win at Oregon. Natalie Williams is the other Bruin to reach these numbers (32, 25 v. Arizona State in 1994).

Great Start

The 2009-10 squad became just the fourth UCLA team to have won at least 14 games by Feb. 1 on the calendar --- the 2008-09 team won 14; the 1998-99 team won 17; the 1980-81 team won 19.

Defense

UCLA held 30 opponents to 70 points or less on the season. Early in the year, UCLA held eight straight opponents to less than 60 points, one shy of the school record stretch of nine games set in 1974-75.

On Feb. 6, the Bruins surrendered a season-low 32 points in a win at Cal. The two teams set a school mark for fewest points scored by both teams -- 76 (44-32). The previous record was 85 (49-36 loss to USC on Feb. 17, '08). Cal's 32 points were the fewest by an opponent since UC Santa Barbara scored 31 on Dec. 15, 1984. UCLA's 44 points were the fewest ever by a Bruin squad in a winning effort. UCLA enjoyed a 14-8 lead at halftime, tying the NCAA record for fewest combined points in a half.

11-For-11

The 11 scholarship players who suited up in 2009-10 each made at least one start.

Campbell's No. 1

Guard Doreena Campbell finished the season ranked No. 1 on the all-time free throw shooting percentage list (.821) and three-point field goal percentage shooting (.412). Campbell's .884 free throw percentage last season was the fourth-best in school history. Her mark of .406 three-point shooting percentage rated seventh.

Tukiainen A Gamer

Senior guard Erica Tukiainen finished her career with 128 games played which ranks as the second-most in school history. Tukiainen also finished with 103 career three-points shots made which ranked her fifth all-time. She wound up her career with a three-point shooting percentage of .389 which ranks fourth all-time. Her 49 three-points shots last season ranked as tied for the fifth-best total ever. Her .430 three-point shooting percentage rated fourth-best.

Pac-10 Rankings

Jasmine Dixon ranked sixth in the league in scoring (15.3), seventh in rebounding (8.0), second in field goal % (.550), and third in steals (2.2). Markel Walker was 22nd in scoring (10.8), eighth in rebounding (7.5), seventh in field goal % (.480), 12th in assists (2.6), and fifth in steals (2.0).

Doreena Campbell finished second in free throw percentage (.884), tied for seventh in assists (3.1), 24th in scoring (9.8) and seventh in assist/turnover ratio (1.1). Darxia Morris was 30th in scoring (8.6), fifth in assists (3.1), and fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.3). Erica Tukiainen ranked

second in three-point field goal percentage (.430) and ninth in three-point field goals made (1.4), and Rebekah Gardner finished 14th in blocked shots (0.7).

The Bruins led the Pac-10 in steals (10.6) and ranked second in scoring defense (57.5), scoring margin (+10.3), field goal percentage (.440), and field goal percentage defense (.371).

Conference Honors

Doreena Campbell and Jasmine Dixon were named to the first-team all-conference squad, as voted upon by the coaches. Markel Walker received honorable mention and was selected by the media onto the All-Pac-10 first team. Walker was also selected to the Pac-10 All-Freshman team and honorable mention All-Defensive squad.

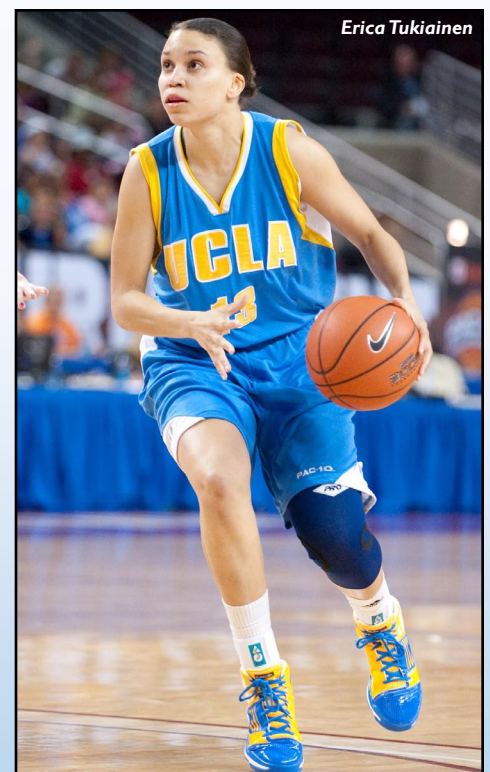
Walker was named Pac-10 Player of the Week after helping the Bruins to home wins over the Oregon schools. Dixon earned her first conference Player of the Week honors after leading the Bruins to a pair of wins at the Oregon schools. Both players were named to the State Farm All-Pac-10 Tournament squad.

Let's Get Academic

Three Bruins were named to the Pac-10 Conference All-Academic team. Allison Taka repeated as a first-team selection. Erica Tukiainen earned second-team accolades. Rebekah Gardner made honorable mention.

By the Numbers

With 107 team blocked shots, the Bruins registered the second-most rejections in school history. The Bruin three-point shot made total of 126 ranked as sixth-best in school listings. The 366 three-point shots attempted was sixth on that list. The Bruin three-point shooting percentage of .344 was the seventh-best in school history. UCLA limited opponents to just 57.5 points per contest, the lowest figure ever. The opponent shooting mark of .371 was the second-lowest on record. The 362 steals and 2,307 points scored each ranked ninth on their lists. The total of 1,332 rebounds ranked seventh on the all-time list.
