

Season In Review



A Look Back at 2010-11

The Bruins completed the season with an overall record of 28-5 (.848 winning percentage, third-best ever by UCLA team) and a 16-2 mark in the Pac-10, good for second place in the conference. It was the 10th time in the last 14 seasons that the Bruin program has finished among the conference's top four teams (only one Pac-10 program has a better track record in that period).

The 28 wins were the second-most in school history. The 16 conference victories were UCLA's best Pac-10 total ever. With 22 wins in its first 24 contests, UCLA achieved its best season start of all-time. The two-year win total of 53 victories (28 and 25 last season) were the most in program history. The 12 wins in true road games also set a school mark. The No. 3 seed into the NCAA Tournament equaled the highest in program history.

The team held opponents to 55.3 points per game which was the lowest mark in school history. A .385 opponent shooting % on the season rated as the fifth-lowest in school history and the total of 420 steals was sixth-best. UCLA held a national ranking in the Associated Press poll for each week during the season for just the sixth time in program history.

Road Warriors

Coach Nikki Caldwell's squad posted a 16-3 record away from Pauley Pavilion. That mark included a 12-2 ledger in true away contests which bettered the old school record of 11 road wins in a season (1991-92). The eight Pac-10 conference contests won on the road were the most ever by a Bruin team. UCLA swept road series at the Washingtons, at the Arizonas and at the Oregons in a conference schedule for just the fourth time ever (also 2010, 1992, 1988).

Defense

UCLA held 31 opponents to 70 points or less on the season, including 16 to less than 50 points.

Votes Are In

The final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll listed the Bruins No. 13, the program's highest season-ending ranking since it was seventh at the conclusion of the 1999 season. UCLA was ranked No. 8 on the final AP

regular season poll, its best finish since a seventh-place ranking in the 1981 poll.

Campbell Ranks

Guard Doreena Campbell finished her career ranked 15th on the all-time school scoring list (1,283). She also was listed eighth on the all-time assist mark (415), eighth on the made three-point shot list (85), third on the games played list at 127 (tied with Christina Nzekwe). She also ranks fourth in free throw percentage (.808) and sixth in three-point field goal percentage (.360).

Campbell became just the fourth Bruin player to record at least 1,000 points, 400 rebounds and 400 assists for a career during the season (also Noelle Quinn, Nikki Blue, Ann Meyers).

1,000-Point Plus

Senior guard Doreena Campbell (24th) and Darxia Morris (25th) each reached the 1,000-point milestone for their careers during the season --- Campbell in a game against Notre Dame and Morris in a contest at Oregon.

Pac-10 Rankings

Jasmine Dixon ranked eighth in the league in rebounding (7.3), fourth in fg % (.529), third in steals (2.4/g), and third in offensive rebounds (3.4/g). Atonye Nyingifa ranked fifth in fg% (.516).

The Bruins led the Pac-10 in scoring defense (55.3), rebounding defense (30.7), steals (12.7), turnover margin (+4.8).

Conference Honors

Doreena Campbell, Jasmine Dixon and Darxia Morris were named to the first-team all-conference squad, as voted upon by the coaches. Campbell joined Noelle Quinn, Nikki Blue and Maylana Martin as the only UCLA players to earn All-Pac-10 honors following all four seasons of play. In addition, Dixon and Morris were named to the honorable mention All-Defensive team.

Campbell joined Morris on the all-tournament squad at the Pacific Life Pac-10 Tournament. Morris was named Pac-10 Player of the Week twice during the season.

Let's Get Academic

Three Bruins were named to the Pac-10 Conference All-Academic teams. Mariah Williams earned second-

team honors. Rebekah Gardner and Markel Walker made honorable mention.

National Rankings

In the final NCAA rankings of the season, UCLA was listed in the Top 30 in six categories --- 6th in steals (12.7), 15th in turnover margin (+4.79), 21st in rebound margin (6.5), 22nd in field goal% (.445), 26th in scoring defense (55.3), 30th in scoring margin (10.3).

Thank You Fans

The total of over 34,000 fans which attended Bruin home games in 2011 was the third-highest since data was first recorded in 1988-89. The per game average of 2,270 was the fourth-best during that period.

Notes

UCLA advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the 11th time in school history. It marked the first back-to-back NCAA appearances since the Bruins made three straight trips to the Dance in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

It was the first back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1997-98 (20) and 1998-99 (26). It was the 11th 20-win campaign in program history. UCLA finished the year having posted a 43-8 record in its last 51 games played. Six of the eight losses have come at the hands of teams ranked in the top-five in the nation at the time of the contest (Stanford-three times in 2011 and twice in 2010; Nebraska in the 2010 NCAA Tournament; 19th-ranked Gonzaga in the 2011 NCAA Tournament; unranked LSU in 2011).

After three seasons as head women's basketball coach at UCLA, Nikki Caldwell stepped down on April 2 to become the head coach at LSU. In her three years, Caldwell led the Bruins to 72 victories, two consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and two appearances in the Pac-10 Tournament championship game.
