

Season In Review



A Look Back at 2011-12

The Bruins completed the season with an overall record of 14-16 and a 9-9 mark (T-5th) in Pac-12 conference play.

The Bruins played with a short roster due to injuries to senior post Jasmine Dixon (September achilles tendon), junior forward Atonye Nyingifa (December ACL), freshman guard Moriah Faulk (January ACL). Neither freshman guard Alexis Perry (shoulder) or junior guard Jackie Shepard (shoulder) made it into a game. In fact, junior forward/guard Markel Walker missed the first seven games of the season while recovering from off-season thumb surgery.

Gardner, the lone active senior member of the team, became the 26th member of the UCLA 1,000-point club during the season with a basket at Stanford. She finished her career with 127 games played, tied for third on the all-time list. Her total of 92 career three-point field goals made ranks seventh on the all-time list.

Walker came on to lead the Pac-12 conference in rebounding (11.0) and became the first Bruin player to average a double-double (14.9 ppg) since 1994-95 (Kisa Hughes (16.4p, 10.4r)).

Sophomore guard Thea Lemberger averaged 12.0 points in 34.6 minutes per game after scoring just eight points and playing a total of 108 minutes in her freshman season. She played at least 30 minutes in 28 straight games.

Sophomore center Corinne Costa entered the UCLA record books with her seven block efforts against Cal and Washington.

UCLA allowed opponents an average of 62.8 points per game which ranked as the sixth-lowest total in school history. The squad totaled xx blocks on the season, a total which ranks xx on the all-time school list.

Defense

UCLA allowed opponents an average of 62.8 points per game which ranked as the sixth-lowest total in school history. It was the fifth-straight season in which the UCLA defense has given up an average which has

merited a listing among the top 10 lowest in school history --- 2010-11 No. 1 at 55.3; 2009-10 No. 2 at 57.5; 2008-09 No. 5 at 61.6; 2007-08 No. 7 at 66.3.

Blocks Record

Corinne Costa set a school record with seven blocks in a game against California on Dec. 29 (old mark was six by Natalie Williams in 1992) and then matched it in a home game versus Washington on Feb. 2.

Costa finished the season with a total of 50 rejections which was the second-most in school history and most by a women's player at UCLA since Necie Thompson had 53 in 1980-81.

The Bruin team set a single-game school record with 13 blocked shots against California on Dec. 29, which broke the previous mark of 12 on Dec. 4, 1980 against Texas A&M.

Walker Triples

Markel Walker recorded the fifth triple double in Bruin history and the first since Noelle Quinn in 2004 when she had 14 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists in a game against Washington State.

Walker also led the Pac-12 in rebounding with a 11.0 caroms per game mark. It was the first time a Bruin player has finished the season with a double-figures rebound average since Kisa Hughes pulled down 10.4 per game in 1994-95. Natalie Williams, with a 13.1 mark in 1993-94, was the last Bruin to finish a season with at least an 11.0 rebound per game average.

1,000-Point Plus

Senior guard Rebekah Gardner became the 26th Bruin women's player to reach the 1,000-point milestone for their careers during the season --- it came in a game at Stanford.

Pac-12 Rankings

Rebekah Gardner ranked 4th in scoring, 6th in minutes played, 8th in steals, 19th in rebounding, 8th in free throw percentage, 10th in offensive rebounds.

Markel Walker led the Pac-12 in rebounding (11.0) and ranked 8th in scoring, 5th in assists, 4th in steals,

11th in assist/turnover, 1st in offensive rebounds, 2nd in defensive rebounds.

Thea Lemberger ranked 5th in minutes played, 10th in three-point shots made, 15th in scoring, 13th in assists, 9th in free throw percentage.

Corinne Costa ranked 3rd in blocked shots and Mariah Williams rated 15th in assists.

The Bruin team ranked in the top five in the conference in three-point shot defense, steals, turnover margin, and offensive rebounds.

Conference Honors

Senior guard Rebekah Gardner, junior forward Markel Walker and sophomore guard Thea Lemberger each received Pac-12 honors from the league's coaches. Gardner and Walker were named to the 15-player All-Pac-12 squad. Lemberger earned honorable mention.

Let's Get Academic

Three Bruins were named to the Pac-12 Conference All-Academic teams. Guards Rebekah Gardner, Mariah Williams and Thea Lemberger earned honorable mention.

National Rankings

In the final NCAA rankings of the season, Markel Walker was ranked 10th in the nation in rebounding.

Notes

Rebekah Gardner finished her career with 127 games played which is tied for third on the all-time school list. She had 92 three-point shots made which ranks seventh all-time.
