OKLAHOMA STORYLINES

- The Sooners won their eighth consecutive NCAA Tournament First Round game with a 78-73 win over 11-seed Central Michigan. OU is in its 16th NCAA Tournament, and 14th consecutive, the nation's seventh longest active streak and 13th longest in history. Oklahoma is a No. 6 seed for the third consecutive year.
- Oklahoma's second round game versus UCLA is a rematch of a Nov. 14 game. The Sooners lost 86-80 in Norman.
- Junior guard Aaryn Ellenberg owns OU's single-season record for 3-pointers made with 107 this season. Ellenberg made two 3-pointers against West Virginia in the Big 12 Tournament to match and then pass Erin Higgins (2003-07) for Oklahoma's career record, now 276.
- The Sooners are 18-0 this season when leading at halftime; 4-11 when tied or trailing; 22-1 when their field goal percentage is higher than their opponent's; and 19-1 when holding their opponent to 40 percent or lower field goal shooting.
- Oklahoma is 0-2 versus the AP Top 10; 1-5 versus the AP Top 25; and 21-6 versus unranked teams.
- Senior forward Joanna McFarland averaged 2.0 points, 4.0 rebounds (2-8 FG) before being benched after three games in favor of Manning. In 30 games since, McFarland averaged 10.2 points and 10.8 rebounds (started last 24 games). She has nine or more rebounds in 25 of those 30 games. Since returning to the starting lineup, McFarland averages 11.1 points and 11.3 rebounds.
- The Sooners suffered injuries to four players, including three starters before conference play. OU lost junior center Lyndsey Cloman (back) and sophomore forward Kaylon Williams (Achilles) in the preseason; freshman guard Maddie Manning (ACL) in practice Nov. 28; and senior guard Whitney Hand (ACL) in the first half of a game versus North Texas Dec. 6. Additionally, Tara Dunn, who joined at semester, is inactive due to a knee injury.

Just a junior, Aaryn Ellenberg now owns Oklahoma's top two 3-point shooting seasons and the career record.

Ellenberg has 107 3-pointers in 2012-13, breaking Oklahoma's single-season record she set as a freshman with 94 in 2010-11.

Ellenberg passed Erin Higgins, who totaled 268 through the 2003-07 seasons, for OU's career record in a Big 12 quarterfinal on March 9.

Oklahoma's 85-77 win over Kansas on March 2 captured its eighth consecutive 20-win season and the program's 18th overall. The win also guaranteed a first-round bye in the Big 12 tournament for the fifth consecutive season.

Oklahoma's men's basketball team captured its 20th win on March 6, marking the 12th season both programs have reached the benchmark in the same year (1984, 1985, 1986, 1995, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2013).

COALE TO LEAD USA AT WORLD UNIVERSITY GAMES

OU head coach Sherri Coale will lead Team USA at the 2013 Women's World University Games this summer in Kazan, Russia. It is Coale's first head coaching assignment with USA Basketball. Coale served as an assistant for the 2001 bronze-medal winning Junior World Championship Team and as a USA Basketball Women's Collegiate Committee member from 2005 to 2008. She will be assisted by Marist's Brian Giorgis and Penn State's Coquese Washington.

HAND NAMED TO INAUGURAL ALLSTATE WBCA GOOD WORKS TEAM

OU's Whitney Hand was named to the Inaugural Allstate WBCA Division I Good Works Team, announced by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Feb. 26.

The WBCA Good Works Team is composed of women's basketball student-athletes who make outstanding contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. These individuals embody the true spirit of "teamwork" and "giving back" through commendable acts of kindness.

ASSISTANT COACH WINS WBCA'S CAROL ECKMAN AWARD

Assistant coach Jan Ross was named winner of the 2013 Carol Eckman Award on Feb. 27. The Carol Eckman Award is presented annually to an active WBCA member coach who exemplifies Eckman's spirit, integrity and character through sportsmanship, commitment to the student-athlete, honesty, ethical behavior, courage and dedication to purpose.

ELLENBERG A NAISMITH AWARD CANDIDATE

University of Oklahoma junior Aaryn Ellenberg was designated one of 30 candidates eligible for the Naismith Women's College Player of the Year, as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club Feb. 27. In late March, the Naismith Trophy voting academy will condense the group to four finalists.

INSIDE-OUT OFFENSE

Juniors Aaryn Ellenberg and Nicole Griffin account for 42 percent of Oklahoma's offense, and they score in very different ways.

Ellenberg is the Big 12 leader in 3-pointers made per game (3.2) and 3-point percentage (.415). She ranks seventh and 14th, respectively, in NCAA Division I in the two categories. More than 52 percent of her points come from beyond the arc.

Griffin is OU's most improved player and finds 75 percent of her points in the paint. Her .513 field goal percentage ranks seventh among Big 12 players.

BLOCK PARTY

Aaryn Ellenberg, a 5-7 shooting guard, has 11 blocks in her last 20 games. In 82 career games prior, she totaled only three. Quipped Ellenberg: "I think I'm bigger than I am."

CRUNCH TIME

Aaryn Ellenberg leads the Sooners in scoring at the end of games, averaging 2.8 points over the final five minutes. Ellenberg is .556 (15-of-27) from 3-point range during the interval.

KORNET BACK IN RHYTHM

Against TCU on Jan. 30, Nicole Kornet shook off a nine-game shooting slump in which she was 3-of-26 (.115) from the field, including 17 consecutive misses for 3-point range. Kornet made three of six attempts (3-of-5 from 3-point range) against the Horned Frogs.

Through the next four games, Kornet averaged 4.0 points and 2.0 rebounds (11.3 minutes) and shot 46 percent from the field and 44 percent from 3-point range. In the previous seven Big 12 games, Kornet totaled just three points and five rebounds (7.1 minutes) and hit one of 15 field goal attempts (.067) and zero of nine 3-pointers.

EASY AS 1, 2, 3

Junior guard Aaryn Ellenberg is one of the nation's top 3-point shooters, and is using the shot most effectively at this point of her career. Ellenberg leads the Big 12 in 3-point field goals per game (3.2) and 3-point field goal shooting (.420), and ranks sixth and 14th, respectively, in the NCAA.

Nearly 52 percent of Ellenberg's attempts come from 3-point range, a 10 percent rise over the 42 percent she shot as a sophomore. Ellenberg took 46 percent of her attempts from beyond the arc when she set Oklahoma's single-season record for 3-pointers (94) as a freshman and has broken that with 107 this year.

HAND ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Whitney Hand was voted to the 2012-13 Capital One Academic All-District Women's Basketball Team, selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). It is the second such honor for Hand, who was an Academic All-District First Team member last season. She was the lone Big 12 Conference student-athlete voted to an all-district first team.

Hand graduated with an undergraduate GPA of 3.76, earning her Bachelor's in health and exercise science. The Fort Worth, Texas, native has maintained a 4.00 GPA through her Master's studies in human relations. A member of the preseason Naismith Award watch list, Hand averaged 11.1 points, 7.2 rebounds and 53 percent field goal shooting for the Sooners before suffering an ACL tear on Dec. 6.
