Bruins looking for sixth regional title; fifth tournament victory this season.

The No. 1/2-ranked UCLA women's golf team heads to the NCAA Central Regional Championship, hosted by Notre Dame University, May 5-7 at the Warren Golf Course in South Bend, Ind.

The Warren Golf Course plays a par of 72 over 6,208 yards and the tournament format is 54 holes of stroke play with five players counting four scores for the team competition.

There are three NCAA regional sites (East, Central and West) each containing 24 teams and six individuals. The low eight teams and two individuals (independent of a qualifying team) from each regional will advance to the NCAA Championship, which will take place from May 17-20 to at the Traditions Golf Club in College Station, TX.

There are six other consensus top-25 teams in the Central Regional along with UCLA (Duke, LSU, Arkansas, Wake Forest, Texas and Notre Dame) and two others that are ranked in the top-25 in one poll (Tulane and Stanford).

In the Carrie Forsyth Era, the Bruins have enjoyed consistent success in regional competition. Since 2001, the Bruins have recorded nine straight podium finishes at the NCAA Regional, capturing five titles and recording three runner-up results.

Forsyth has also coached three individual regional winners who have won four regional crowns. Maria Jose Uribe was the Bruins' most recent regional champion, capturing titles in 2008 and '09. Other winners include Hannah Jun (2004) and Sydnee Michaels (2007).

Forsyth has guided the Bruins to 38 tournament titles in her 12-year tenure as the Bruins' coach. This season, the Bruins have won four times, tied for most in the country with Purdue and Notre Dame. They have been ranked 1st or 2nd nationally for most of the season, and enter the Central Regional as the No. 2 ranked team by GolfStat and *GolfWeek*.

The All-Pac-10 awards were announced this week and UCLA was well represented. Stephanie Kono, Lee Lopez and Tiffany Lua were named to the All-Pac-10 First Team and Ani Gulugian and Glory Yang secured 2nd team honors. Forsyth has now landed 12 different players on the All-Pac-10 1st Team during her tenure and 21 players overall have earned all-conference honors for UCLA in the last 12 years.
