



### 2011 Meet Summaries

### Meet I - at #5 Utah (Jan. 7)

UCLA dropped its season opener to fifth-ranked Utah in Salt Lake City, 195.7-195.3. The Bruins trailed throughout the meet and had their comeback hopes dashed by a pair of falls on balance beam in the final rotation. Down by just .025 points after the second rotation, the Bruins had six hit floor exercise routines but a few stumbles that contributed to a team total of 48.85, and they found themselves down by .05 going into the final rotation. But falls from two of the last three competitors prevented UCLA from catching up to the Utes. The Bruins scored 48.475 on beam, while Utah scored 48.825 on floor to clinch the win.

### Meet 2 - Pac-10 Showcase (Jan. 9)

In its second meet in three days, UCLA finished in second place at the Pac-10 Showcase, scoring 195.925 to finish behind Stanford (196.625). Elyse Hopfner-Hibbs won the all-around with a 39.55 and also took first place on beam and floor with scores of 9.95. Stanford grabbed the lead from the get-go and never relinquished it, starting out with a meet-best 49.15 in the first rotation. UCLA nearly matched the Cardinal in rotation two with a score of 49.125 on vault but was never able to get any closer. The Bruins had to count a fall on balance beam but held off Oregon State for second place after a meet-high 49.25 on floor.

### Meet 3 - at Southern Utah (Jan. 14)

With an experimental lineup that had II routines being competed for the first time, No. 5 UCLA faltered on two events and suffered a 194.75-194.425 loss at No. 23 Southern Utah. Three Bruins were injured either before or during the meet, causing even more shuffling of the lineup. UCLA got into a hole early after two falls on bars in rotation one but caught up by the halfway mark after a strong vault set. The Bruins could not hold on to the lead, however, with a disastrous floor set that could only score 47.95. A 49.1 team total on beam in the final rotation gave the Bruins a chance to come back from a .525 deficit, but 9.7+ scores from Southern Utah's last two floor performers sealed the Thunderbirds' win.

Freshman Sydney Sawa added a 39.025 in her all-around debut.

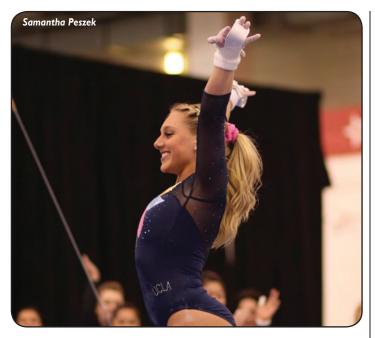

### Meet 5 - at Oregon State (Jan. 28)

Ninth-ranked UCLA went 24-for-24 to defeat seventh-ranked Oregon State on the road with a season-high score of 196.675, edging the Beavers by .05 with a fourth rotation rally on the balance beam. The victory was UCLA's first in a dual meet this year. The Bruins had 18 of 24 scores of 9.8 or higher and no score under 9.725. The team achieved season-highs on bars (49.275), beam (49.175) and floor (49.25) and surpassed its overall team season-high by .75. The Bruins had to make up half-a-tenth on beam in the last rotation and got five solid scores of 9.8+, including a 9.9 from Brittani McCullough and a 9.85 from Elyse Hopfner-Hibbs to close out the meet.

Three Bruin out-of-bounds deductions on floor exercise proved to be the difference between first and third place. Four Bruins took home first-place finishes - Tauny Frattone on vault, Samantha Peszek and Elyse Hopfner-Hibbs on bars, and Olivia Courtney on floor. UCLA claimed the highest team totals on vault (49.2), bars (49.275) and beam (48.975, tied with Stanford).
