

Through the Years...

Women's rowing first started at UCLA in 1970 from a support group for the men's program known as "Shell and Oar."

Three years later, in 1973, Larry Daugherty was named the first head coach of UCLA women's rowing. The women still struggled for intercollegiate status, but they eventually won in 1974 through the determination of the athletes and the support of then Vice-Chancellor Norman P. Miller.

In 1975, just one year after the inception of the sport into the collegiate ranks, UCLA won the National Championships in the lightweight four.

In 1976, the Miller Cup Invitational was established in honor of Dr. Miller for his commitment to the program. That same year, UCLA won its first conference championship in the Pac-8, and the varsity eight won the Western Sprints Championships.

Under Daugherty, the Bruins also won the NWRA Southwest Regional Championships in 1977, 1980, and 1982.

In the mid 80's, UCLA women's rowing reappeared in the national spotlight. In 1984, under coach Jean Reilly, the Bruins were national chempions in the varsity four and lightweight four, and in 1985, they repeated as national chempions in the varsity four.

In the Pac-10 conference, UCLA holds two team titles from 1990 and 1991. The Bruins were the varsity four champions in 1984 and both the varsity eight and second varsity eight champions in 1990 and 1991.

At the end of the 1991 season, women's rowing was released by the UCLA Athletic Department and picked up the following year by UCLA Recreation.

UCLA announced on Feb. 9, 2001 that it would once again sponsor rowing as an intercollegiate sport, active for the 2001-02 season. Now under the NCAA, UCLA women's rowing is in its seventh season as a scholarship sport.

The Bruins have regrouped under head coach Amy Fuller Kearney. She has already reestablished an alumni base and strengthened old ties and traditions, as well as introducing some new ones into the program.

Pac-10 Conference The Conference of Champions

The Pac-10 Conference's 146 team titles in the last 17 seasons have come in 24 different men's and women's sports. The Pac-10 has led the nation in NCAA Championships 41 of the last 47 years and has finished second five times.

Spanning nearly one century of outstanding athletics achievement, the Pac-10 has captured 359 NCAA titles (254 men's, 105 women's), far outdistancing the runner-up Big Ten Conference's 212 titles.

The Conference's reputation is further proven in the annual United States Sports Academy Directors' Cup competition, the prestigious award that honors the best overall collegiate athletics programs in the country. Stanford continued its remarkable run in 2006-07, winning its 13th consecutive Directors' Cup. In 2006-07, seven of the Top-30 Division I programs hailed from the Pac-10, including No. 1 Stanford, No. 2 UCLA, No. 5 USC, No. 9 California, No. 10 Arizona State, No. 24 Arizona and No. 29 Washington. The Pac-10 landed five programs in the Top-10, two more than the second-place SEC (2).

In 2006-07, the Pac-10 won eight NCAA titles to lead the nation. It should be noted that the Pac-10 total does not include California's national championship in men's rugby or Washington's national championship in men's crew, as they are not counted as NCAA titles. The Pac-10 led the nation with the most NCAA titles in women's sports with five.

Participation in the postseason was a common occurrence for the Conference in 2006-07. Of the 22 sports sponsored by the Pac-10, 19 witnessed at least half its teams participating in NCAA or other

postseason action. The men sent 62 of a possible 90 teams into the postseason (68.1 percent), while the women sent 74 of a possible 100 teams (74.0 percent).

The Pac-10 was the premier basketball conference in 2006-07, sending six teams to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. UCLA advanced to the Final Four for the second straight season, falling to Florida in the semifinals.

The Bruins captured the Pac-10 regular season championship, while Oregon earned the Pacific Life Pac-10 Tournament crown. On the women's side, four teams competed in the NCAA Tournament. Arizona State reached the Elite Eight for the first time in school hsitory, while Stanford claimed the 2006-07 regular season title and the State Farm Pac-10 Tournament Trophy.

In men's sports, Pac-10 members have won 254 NCAA team championships, far ahead of the 195 claimed by the runner-up Big Ten. Men's NCAA crowns have come at a phenomenal rate for the Pac-10 - 15 basketball titles by five schools (more than any other conference), 49 tennis titles, 45 outdoor track and field crowns and 26 baseball titles.

Pac-10 members have won 25 of the last 38 NCAA titles in volleyball, 33 of the last 48 in water polo, and 202 total swimming and diving national championships.

Individually, the Conference has produced an impressive number of NCAA men's individual champions as well, claiming 1,146 NCAA individual crowns.



On the women's side, the story is much the same. Since the NCAA began conducting women's championships 26 years ago, Pac-10 members have claimed at least four national titles in a single season on 18 occasions. Overall, the Pac-10 has captured 105 NCAA women's crowns, easily outdistancing the SEC, which is second with 70. Pac-10 members have dominated a number of sports, winning 19 softball titles, 17 tennis crowns, 11 of the last 17 volleyball titles, 11 of the last 18 tropies in golf and eight in swimming and diving.
