## Through the Years...

Women's rowing first started at UCLA in 1970 from a support group for the men's program known as "Shell and Oar."

Three years later, in 1973, Larry Daugherty was named the first head coach of UCLA women's rowing. The women still struggled for intercollegiate status, but they eventually won in 1974 through the determination of the athletes and the support of then Vice-Chancellor Norman P. Miller.

In 1975, just one year after the inception of the sport into the collegiate ranks, UCLA won the National Championships in the lightweight four.

In 1976, the Miller Cup Invitational was established in honor of Dr. Miller for his commitment to the program. That same year, UCLA won its first conference championship in the Pac-8, and the varsity eight won the Western Sprints Championships.

Under Daugherty, the Bruins also won the NWRRA Southwest Regional Championships in 1977, 1980, and 1982.

In the mid 80's, UCLA women's rowing reappeared in the national spotlight. In 1984, under coach Jean Reilly, the Bruins

were national champions in the varsity four and lightweight four, and in 1985, they repeated as national champions in the varsity four.

In the Pac-10 conference, UCLA holds two team titles from 1990 and 1991. The Bruins were the varsity four champions in 1984 and both the varsity eight and second varsity eight champions in 1990 and 1991.

At the end of the 1991 season, women's rowing was released by the UCLA Athletic Department and picked up the following year by UCLA Recreation.

UCLA announced on Feb. 9, 2001 that it would once again sponsor rowing as an intercollegiate sport, active for the 2001-02 season. Now under the NCAA, UCLA women's rowing is in its eighth season as a scholarship sport.

The Bruins have regrouped under head coach Amy Fuller Kearney. She has already reestablished an alumni base and strengthened old ties and traditions, as well as introducing some new ones into the program.

## Pac-10 Conference The Conference of Champions

Entering the 2009-10 season, the Pacific-10 Conference continues to uphold its tradition as the "Conference of Champions." Pac-10 members have claimed an incredible 166 NCAA team titles over the past 19 seasons, for an average of nearly nine championships per academic year.

Even more impressive is the breadth of the Pac-10's success, as those 166 team titles have come in 26 different men's and women's sports. The Pac-10 has led the nation in NCAA Championships 43 of the last 49 years and finished second five times.

Spanning nearly a century of outstanding athletic achievements, the Pac-10 has captured 380 NCAA titles (261 men's, 119 women's), far outdistancing the runner-up Big Ten Conference's 222 titles.

The Conference's reputation is further proven in the annual United States Sports Academy Directors' Cup competition, the prestigious award that honors the best overall collegiate athletics programs in the country. Stanford won its 15th-consecutive Directors' Cup in 2008-09. Eight of the top 25 Division I programs were from Pac-10 member institutions: No. 1 Stanford, No. 4 USC, No. 7 California, No. 11 Washington, No. 12 Arizona State, No. 16 UCLA, No. 22 Oregon and No. 24 Arizona. The Pac-10 landed three programs in the top-10, one more than the second-place ACC, Big Ten and SEC (2).

The Pac-10 captured a nation's-best 11 NCAA titles in 2008-09. The total does not include a national title in men's rowing, which Washington claimed by taking top honors at the IRA Championships Regatta.

On the men's side, Pac-10 members have won 261 NCAA team championships, far ahead of the 200 claimed by the runner-up Big Ten. Men's NCAA Crowns have come at a phenomenal rate for the Pac-10 - 15 basketball titles by five schools (more than any other conference), 50 tennis titles, 44 outdoor track and field crowns, and 26 baseball titles. Pac-10 members have won 24 of the last 40 NCAA titles in volleyball, 35 of the last 50 in water polo, and 21 in swimming & diving national championships.

Individually, the conference has produced an impressive number of NCAA men's individual champions, as well, boasting 1,169 individual crowns.

On the women's side, the story is much the same. Since the NCAA began conducting women's championships 28 years ago, Pac-10 members have claimed at least four national titles in a single season on 20 occasions, including 2008-09. Overall, the Pac-10 has captured 119 NCAA women's titles, easily outdistancing the SEC, which is second with 74. Pac-10 members have dominated a number of

sports, winning 21 softball titles, 18 tennis crowns, 13 of the last 19 volleyball titles, 13 of the last 20 trophies in golf and 11 in swimming & diving.

Pac-10 women athletes shine nationally on an individual basis, as well, having captured an unmatched 525 NCAA individual crowns, an average of more than 18 championships per season.
