

2002 UCLA BRUINS SOFTBALL

A 3-0 start to UCLA's seven-game homestand has vaulted the Bruins into a tie for second place in the Pac-10 standings. UCLA will look to extend its four-game winning streak this weekend, as it plays host to Oregon State on Friday and Oregon on Saturday and Sunday. Against Oregon State, the Bruins hold a 59-5 advantage in the all-time series (3-1 in 2001), while UCLA has a 48-7 record against the Oregon Ducks, including a 3-0 mark in 2001.'

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KEIRA GOERL NAMED PAC-10 PITCHER OF THE WEEK

UCLA sophomore **Keira Goerl** earned her third Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week of the season on Tuesday, after posting a 2-0 weekend with a 0.00 ERA. In Friday's game against Stanford, Goerl came in to the game in the top of the third inning, with the Bruins trailing 2-1. She proceeded to pitch five no-hit innings, as Stanford's only base runner for the remainder of the game was a fifth-inning walk. Goerl struck out four to earn the victory, as UCLA won the game on a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh inning. She then started Saturday's contest against California, pitching all seven innings of the two-hit shutout, striking out five and not allowing a run.

BRUINS POST WEEKEND SWEEP OF BAY AREA SCHOOLS

The Bruins opened their weekend slate with a Friday game against Stanford, with the Cardinal putting up a run in each of their first two at-bats for a 2-0 lead. From that point, UCLA senior **Stacey Nuvean** cut the lead in half with her 12th home run of the season (82nd career), and sophomore **Keira Goerl** pitched five no-hit innings while the Bruins chipped away at Stanford's lead, eventually taking the 3-2 win on a seventh inning sacrifice fly by **Amanda Freed**.

UCLA continued to put up offense on Saturday against California, as an RBI double by **Natasha Watley** and a sac fly by Freed gave UCLA a 2-0 lead before Nuvean connected on her 83rd career home run to seal the 3-0 victory. Sunday's game against the Golden Bears would not be decided as quickly or as easily, as Freed and Cal pitcher Jocelyn Forest both pitched stellar games, taking a 0-0 score to the bottom of the 10th inning. In the tenth, **Toria Auelua** led off with a single, and was pinch-run for by **Casey Hiraiwa**. Hiraiwa was sacrificed to second base by **Monique Mejia**, and came home on a two-out RBI single by Watley, giving UCLA the 1-0 win.

HEAD COACH SUE ENQUIST

The 2002 season marks Sue Enquist's 14th campaign as head coach of the Bruin softball program. It is her 23rd year as part of UCLA's softball coaching staff and her 27th year of involvement with the program as either a coach or player. Enquist has a **678-127-1 (.842)** coaching record and 1,104 wins in her Bruin softball career as a player, assistant coach and head coach, combined. As a player from 1975-78, Enquist became UCLA's first All-American while establishing the Bruin career batting average record of .401. She is still the only UCLA player to complete her career with a batting average over .400.

83 GONE, THREE TO GO FOR NUVEAN

With 13 home runs this season, including homers in three of UCLA's last four games, Bruin slugger **Stacey Nuvean** currently has 83 career home runs, placing her third on the NCAA's all-time list. Nuvean has the best career home run total of any non-Arizona player, and is quickly approaching the NCAA career record of 85 home runs, held by Arizona's Leah Braatz and Laura Espinoza. She needs two home runs to tie and three to break the NCAA career home run record.

Although Cal junior Veronica Nelson has broken the previous NCAA record for walks, Nuvean is now second on the all-time list with 215 career walks, having passed previous record holder, Oregon State's Tarrah Beyster (211), last weekend. Finally, Nuvean ranks fourth on the NCAA's Division I career RBI list with 279. Once again, she is the top non-Arizona player on that list, and needs 37 RBI to move up to third (#3 Espinoza had 315 RBI).

Nuvean has played in 243 games as a Bruin (through April 14), ranking her second in UCLA softball history. She is closing in on Julie Marshall's record for career games played as a Bruin (246), and is on pace to break the record on Apr. 24 at Easton Stadium against Washington.

FREED CLOSES IN ON UCLA WINS RECORD

Senior **Amanda Freed** enters this weekend's play with a career pitching record of 92-17, needing just five more victories to surpass B'Ann Burns (96 from 1994-97) for the UCLA career record. She needs one more victory to tie **Lisa Fernandez** for second on UCLA's all-time list. Freed is also sprinting up the UCLA lists for appearances (120, second to Burns), innings pitched (721.1, fourth) and strikeouts (713, fourth). With her eight-K performance on April 6 at Arizona, Freed became the fourth player in Bruin softball history to record 700 career strikeouts.

Offensively, her career credits are equally impressive. Freed, a member of UCLA's career .300 club (.331 career average through April 14), has become the sixth player in Bruin history to rack up 700+ career at-bats, with 746 (fifth), and is second to teammate Natasha Watley for the UCLA record for career runs scored with 169. She is also second to Watley in career stolen bases with 48. Freed is ranked in doubles (46, 12nd), triples (10, 16th), hits (247, 8th) and RBI (93, 18th).

WATLEY STREAKS INTO RECORD BOOKS

With three stolen bases in game one against Purdue on March 2, junior All-America shortstop **Natasha Watley** became the first Bruin in history to record 100 stolen bases in her UCLA career. Watley currently has 113 career swipes, and is tied for fourth on the Pac-10's career list with Arizona's Amy Chellevoid (1992-95) and Washington's Rosie Leutzinger (1997-2000). Arizona's Vivian Holm is third with 129 stolen bases. She also holds UCLA's career runs scored record with 170.

Also notable this season, Watley has posted an impressive hitting streak, having hit safely in UCLA's first 29 games during the 2002 season. With a 1-for-3 performance in last May's NCAA Championship game, Watley now has two hitting streaks of 30 or more games in as many seasons. She recorded a Pac-10 record 32-game streak a year ago (March 2-May 2). Last year's streak is tied for the fifth-longest in on the NCAA Division I list, while the 2002 version is tied for seventh-best in NCAA history.

BUCK BECOMES VALUABLE UTILITY PLAYER

UCLA's starting shortstop on the 1999 NCAA Championship team, senior **Crissy Buck** continues to spend her time in the Bruin lineup, but has become more of a utility player for head coach Sue Enquist. She is one of five Bruins (Nuveman, Watley, Freed, Mims) to start all 43 games this season.

During the 2002 season, Buck has recorded 28 starts in right field, eight at third base, four in center field, three at second base and one at designated player. She also played a partial game at shortstop, the only player other than Watley to field the position this season.

FIVE CURRENT BRUINS IN USA SOFTBALL'S CORE GROUP

Five current and two former UCLA softball players were chosen by USA Softball as members of its 22-player core group of athletes to move on to its upcoming World Championships camp in May/June 2002 that was named in January. Current players include **Toria Auelua**, **Amanda Freed**, **Stacey Nuveman**, **Tairia Mims** and **Natasha Watley**, while volunteer assistant coach **Lisa Fernandez** and 2001 senior Courtney Dale round out the Bruin contingent. Two additional former Bruins, Lyndsey Klein and Sheila (Cornell) Douty, were added to the list of invitees at the end of March. USA Softball will be going for its fifth consecutive World Championship at the 2002 ISF World Championships in July in Saskatoon, Canada. The U.S. is looking to qualify as the top seed for a third consecutive Olympic Games after winning Gold in 1996 (Atlanta) and 2000 (Sydney).

UCLA has more current or former players among this 42-player group (nine) than any other school. Arizona (six) is the only other school with more than three players invited to the May 30-June 3 team camp at the ARCO Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, CA.

ALL-JUNIOR, ALL-ROOMMATE INFIELD RETURNS IN 2002

After playing together as an infield through the 2001 postseason, the junior combination of **Toria Auelua** (3B), **Natasha Watley** (SS), **Monique Mejia** (2B) and **Tairia Mims** (1B) has played as a set for the majority of this season, including all five Pac-10 games. The foursome has shared an apartment or dorm room suite since their arrival in Westwood in the fall of 1999.

THROW SOME GROUND BALLS, THEY'RE MORE DEMOCRATIC

As Crash Davis said to Nuke La Loosh in the movie *Bull Durham*, "Strikeouts are boring, besides that, they're fascist. Throw some ground balls, it's more democratic." Bruin pitchers **Amanda Freed** and **Keira Goerl** could be given that same piece of advice.

This year, strikeouts have been the popular path to outs for the Bruin pitching staff, as Goerl has six double-figure strikeout games with two 9-K performances, while Freed had a 12K day against Cal State Fullerton on Feb. 27, a 10K no-hitter against Virginia on March 9, and has three 9K performances. Both have impressive strikeout-to-walk ratios in the circle, with Freed checking in at 3.7:1 (123K, 33 BB) and Goerl at 4.4:1 (184K, 42BB). In 2001, each had one double-figure strikeout performance, with Goerl's coming in a 14-inning game. Freed had one game with nine K's, while Goerl had two. In relation to innings pitched, Goerl is picking up 1.3 strikeouts per inning (143.0 IP) this season, while Freed at one K/IP.

2002: YEAR OF THE BRUIN NO-HITTER?

Through the first six weeks of the 2002 season, Bruin pitchers have combined for six no-hitters, the highest total for a Bruin squad since Dee Dee Weiman and B'Ann Burns combined for 10 no-nos during the 1994 season. So far this year, sophomore **Keira Goerl** has posted four no-hitters, while senior **Amanda Freed** has two. In 1994, Weiman had five no-hitters, Burns had three, and two no-hitters were shared between the two pitchers.

BRUINS DOMINATE PAC-10 STATISTICS

The top two hitters in the country, based on batting average, wear a Bruin uniform.

UCLA leads the nation's premier softball conference in team batting average (.351) and team ERA (0.71), and have players leading the league in eight offensive and two pitching statistical categories. At the top of the batting average list are **Stacey Nuveman** (.541) and **Natasha Watley** (.521), and both players lead additional offensive categories. Nuveman currently leads all three of the categories that define offensive production, adding the slugging percentage (1.010) and on-base percentage (.658) numbers to top the Pac-10.

Watley adds a list of leads to her second-place batting average ranking, leading the league in runs scored (47), hits (75), triples (5), stolen bases (29) and steal attempts (34).

In the circle, **Keira Goerl** (0.59) leads the Pac-10 in ERA with **Amanda Freed** (0.82) standing in third place. Goerl also leads the Pac-10 in opposing batting average, holding opposing offenses to a .113 clip.
