

2002 UCLA BRUINS SOFTBALL

UCLA continued its Pac-10 hot streak last week with a four-game sweep of Washington and the Bay Area schools. This weekend, the Bruins will complete their final Pac-10 road trip of the season, taking on Oregon and No. 16 Oregon State. UCLA swept the Oregon schools earlier this season, taking one game from the Beavers and two from the Ducks at Easton Stadium. UCLA holds a 50-7 all-time record against Oregon (including 2-0 this season) and a 60-5 record against the Beavers (1-0 this year).

GOERL, NUVEMAN WIN PAC-10, NFCA WEEKLY HONORS

UCLA's **Keira Goerl** and **Stacey Nuveman** swept the Pac-10's Pitcher and Player of the Week honors for April 29. Goerl, a sophomore from Moreno Valley, CA, earns her fourth Pitcher of the Week honor of the 2002 season, while Nuveman, a senior from LaVerne, CA, earns her second Player of the Week honor this season. Nuveman was named the NFCA Player of the Week on Wednesday.

Goerl pitched a no-hitter against No. 6 California on Friday, her fifth of the season, between double-figure strikeout games against No. 8 Washington (13 K's on Wednesday) and No. 7 Stanford (11 K's on Sunday). **Nuveman** tied the NCAA home run record on Saturday at Stanford, while hitting .667 for the week. She was 8-for-12 with two doubles, five RBI, two walks and the record-tying home run.

UCLA ROLLS TO 4-0 WEEK VS. WASHINGTON, BAY AREA SCHOOLS

The Bruins started last week's slate by completing their seven-game homestand with a dramatic 5-3 win over No. 8 Washington. Down 3-0 going into the bottom of the sixth inning, **Stacey Nuveman** connected on a bases loaded RBI single before **Claire Sua** smashed a grand slam home run, giving UCLA the 5-3 win. Pitcher **Keira Goerl** struck out 13 in the game.

Friday afternoon saw the Bruins taking on No. 6 California in Berkeley, with Goerl pitching her fifth no-hitter of the season. Nuveman celebrated her 24th birthday by going 3-for-4 at the plate with two RBI while catching Goerl's no-hitter. **Tairia Mims** also went 3-for-4, providing UCLA's other RBI in the 3-0 victory.

Saturday saw an offensive explosion for the Bruins, with UCLA putting up 10 runs in the top of the third inning. UCLA sent 14 batters to the plate in that inning, with three players (**Natasha Watley**, **Amanda Freed** and Nuveman) earning two hits in the frame. All nine lineup spots scored at least one run in the 13-2 win. Offensive highlights included Nuveman's NCAA record-tying home run, and home runs in consecutive ABs by Sua. On Sunday, Goerl completed her perfect week with a 2-0 victory over Stanford, striking out 11 batters. Mims hit a two-out solo home run in the first inning, which proved to be the game winner.

NUVEMAN TIES NCAA CAREER HOME RUN RECORD

On Sat., Apr. 27, in the third inning of UCLA's game at No. 7 Stanford, UCLA senior catcher **Stacey Nuveman** hit her 85th career home run, tying the NCAA record held by Arizona's Leah Braatz and Laura Espinoza. Nuveman reached the mark in the 249th game of her career, as opposed to 251 and 271 for Espinoza and Braatz, respectively.

Also notable is Nuveman's pace for career slugging percentage. Entering Wednesday's game against Washington, Nuveman holds a career slugging percentage of .940, nearly 150 points higher than the current NCAA career record of .797, held by Braatz. She will also break UCLA's record for career batting average, as she is currently hitting .468 for her career, an average that would rank second on the NCAA's all-time list.

Although Cal junior Veronica Nelson has broken the previous NCAA record for walks, Nuveman is now second on the all-time list with 220 career walks, having passed previous record holder, Oregon State's Tarrah Beyster (211). Finally, Nuveman ranks fourth on the NCAA's Division I career RBI list with 289. Once again, she is the top non-Arizona player on that list, and needs 26 RBI to move up to third (#3 Espinoza had 315 RBI).

HEAD COACH SUE ENQUIST

The 2002 season marks Sue Enquist's 14th campaign as head coach of the Bruin softball program. It is her 23rd year as part of UCLA's softball coaching staff and her 27th year of involvement with the program as either a coach or player. Enquist has a **685-127-1 (.843)** coaching record and 1,110 wins in her Bruin softball career as a player, assistant coach and head coach, combined. As a player from 1975-78, Enquist became UCLA's first All-American while establishing the Bruin career batting average record of .401. She is still the only UCLA player to complete her career with a batting average over .400.

FREED MOVES TO SECOND ON UCLA WINS LIST

Senior **Amanda Freed** enters this weekend's play with a career pitching record of 94-17, needing just two more victories to tie B'Ann Burns (96 from 1994-97) for the UCLA career record. She passed current assistant coach **Lisa Fernandez** with her 13-2 win over Stanford on April 27. Freed is also sprinting up the UCLA lists for appearances (122, second to Burns), innings pitched (733.1, second) and strikeouts (730, fourth). With her eight-K performance on April 6 at Arizona, Freed became the fourth player in Bruin softball history to record 700 career strikeouts.

Offensively, her career credits are equally impressive. Freed, a member of UCLA's career .300 club (.329 career average through April 28), has become the sixth player in Bruin history to rack up 700+ career at-bats, with 771 (second), and is second to teammate Natasha Watley for the UCLA record for career runs scored with 175. She is also second to Watley in career stolen bases with 50. Freed is ranked in doubles (48, 2nd), triples (11, 14th), hits (254, 5th) and RBI (96, 18th).

WATLEY STREAKS INTO RECORD BOOKS

With three stolen bases in game one against Purdue on March 2, junior All-America shortstop **Natasha Watley** became the first Bruin in history to record 100 stolen bases in her UCLA career. Watley currently has 116 career swipes, and is fourth on the Pac-10's career list. Arizona's Vivian Holm is third with 129 stolen bases. Watley also holds UCLA's career runs scored record with 179.

Also notable this season, Watley is nearing the 100 hit plateau, which would make her the first Bruin with two 100-hit seasons. She has also posted an impressive hitting streak, having hit safely in UCLA's first 29 games during the 2002 season. With a 1-for-3 performance in last May's NCAA Championship game, Watley now has two hitting streaks of 30 or more games in as many seasons. She recorded a Pac-10 record 32-game streak a year ago (March 2-May 2). Last year's streak is tied for the fifth-longest in on the NCAA Division I list, while the 2002 version is tied for seventh-best in NCAA history.

BUCK BECOMES VALUABLE UTILITY PLAYER

UCLA's starting shortstop on the 1999 NCAA Championship team, senior **Crissy Buck** continues to spend her time in the Bruin lineup, but has become more of a utility player for head coach Sue Enquist. She is one of five Bruins (Nuveman, Watley, Freed, Mims) to start all 50 games this season.

During the 2002 season, Buck has recorded 27 starts in right field, 13 at third base, five at second base, four in center field and one at designated player. She also played a partial game at shortstop, the only player other than Watley to field the position this season.

2002: YEAR OF THE BRUIN NO-HITTER?

With **Keira Goerl's** no-hitter against No. 6 California on April 2, the Bruin pitching staff has combined for seven no-hitters, the highest total for a Bruin squad since Dee Dee Weiman and B'Ann Burns combined for 10 no-nos during the 1994 season. So far this year, sophomore **Keira Goerl** has posted five no-hitters, while senior **Amanda Freed** has two. In 1994, Weiman had five no-hitters, Burns had three, and two no-hitters were shared between the two pitchers.

FIVE CURRENT BRUINS IN USA SOFTBALL'S CORE GROUP

Five current and four former UCLA softball players were chosen by USA Softball as members of its 22-player core group of athletes to move on to its upcoming World Championships camp in May/June 2002 that was named in January. Current players include **Toria Auelua**, **Amanda Freed**, **Stacey Nuveman**, **Tairia Mims** and **Natasha Watley**, while volunteer assistant coach **Lisa Fernandez** and 2001 senior Courtney Dale round out the Bruin contingent. Two additional former Bruins, Lyndsey Klein and Sheila (Cornell) Douty, were added to the list of invitees at the end of March. USA Softball will be going for its fifth consecutive World Championship at the 2002 ISF World Championships in July in Saskatoon, Canada. The U.S. is looking to qualify as the top seed for a third consecutive Olympic Games after winning Gold in 1996 (Atlanta) and 2000 (Sydney).

UCLA has more current or former players among this 42-player group (nine) than any other school. Arizona (six) is the only other school with more than three players invited to the May 30-June 3 team camp at the ARCO Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, CA.

THROW SOME GROUND BALLS, THEY'RE MORE DEMOCRATIC

As Crash Davis said to Nuke La Loosh in the movie *Bull Durham*, "Strikeouts are boring, besides that, they're fascist. Throw some ground balls, it's more democratic." Bruin pitchers **Amanda Freed** and **Keira Goerl** could be given that same piece of advice.

This year, strikeouts have been the popular path to outs for the Bruin pitching staff, as Goerl has nine double-figure strikeout games with three 9-K performances, while Freed had a 12K day against Cal State Fullerton on Feb. 27, a 10K no-hitter against Virginia on March 9, an 11-K performance on April 21 and has three 9K performances.

Both have impressive strikeout-to-walk ratios in the circle, with Freed checking in at 3.7:1 (140K, 38BB) and Goerl at 4.5:1 (230K, 51BB). In 2001, each had one double-figure strikeout performance, with Goerl's coming in a 14-inning game. Freed had one game with nine K's, while Goerl had two. In relation to strikeouts per seven innings (how the NCAA tabulates leaders), Goerl is recording 9.0 K/7 IP, while Freed checks in at 7.2 K/7 IP.

BRUINS DOMINATE PAC-10 STATISTICS

Two of the top three hitters in the country, based on batting average, wear a Bruin uniform.

UCLA leads the nation's premier softball conference in team batting average (.350) and team ERA (0.71), and have players leading the league in eight offensive and two pitching statistical categories. At the top of the batting average list are **Stacey Nuveman** (.554, 1st NCAA) and **Natasha Watley** (.503, 3rd NCAA), and both players lead additional offensive categories. Nuveman currently leads all three of the categories that define offensive production, adding the slugging percentage (1.038) and on-base percentage (.669) numbers to top the Pac-10.

Watley adds a list of leads to her second-place batting average ranking, leading the league in hits (92), triples (6), stolen bases (32) and steal attempts (39).

In the circle, **Keira Goerl** (0.55) leads the Pac-10 in ERA with **Amanda Freed** (0.88) standing in third place. Goerl also leads the Pac-10 in opposing batting average, holding opposing offenses to a .104 clip.

INJURY REPORT

Junior second baseman **Monique Mejia** will be out of the lineup for approximately three weeks after suffering an open dislocation of the middle finger on her left (glove) hand. She had four stitches to close the wound. Mejia injured the hand while sliding head-first into the bag while stealing second base in the fifth inning of UCLA's April 19 game against Oregon State.
