UCLA CLOSES REGULAR SEASON ON HIGH NOTE >>

The Bruins finished the regular season strong, posting impressive wins at Pac-10 Champion Arizona and Pac-10 runner-up Arizona State before dropping the season finale at ASU on Saturday.

LANGENFELD EARNS PAC-10. NATIONAL HONORS >>

UCLA's Megan Langenfeld (Bakersfield, Calif.) earned USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Week and Pac-10 Player of the Week honors on May 15. Langenfeld was the offensive and defensive catalyst for the Bruins this weekend earning her the final Player of the Week honor of the 2007 softball season.

The freshman became the only pitcher in the Pac-10 this season to win games in the same weekend against Pac-10 Champion Arizona and Pac-10 Runner-Up Arizona State, accomplishing the feat on back-toback nights on the road against two of the Pac-10's best pitchers.

In Thursday's win at Arizona, Langenfeld allowed just two earned runs in seven innings in the circle, striking out three. She also connected on a three-run home run in the fifth inning, breaking a 4-4 tie that gave UCLA a 7-4 win over Arizona.

On Friday at ASU, she returned to the circle, allowing just two earned runs with six strikeouts as the Bruins posted a 4-3 win over the Sun Devils. Langenfeld once again contributed offensively, going 2-for-3 at the plate with a two-RBI double in the first inning.

She entered the game in relief on Saturday, coming in during the fifth inning, facing eight batters and allowing only one hit while striking out one.

For the week, Langenfeld posted a 2-0 record with a 1.75 ERA and 10 strikeouts. She pitched 16 of UCLA's 20 innings while hitting .333 at the plate (3-for-9) with two runs scored, a double, a home run and five RBI for a .778 slugging percentage.

SELDEN SETS UCLA CAREER STRIKEOUT RECORD >>

With a strikeout to lead off the third inning of UCLA's 5-3 win over Oregon State on April 29, Anjelica Selden recorded her 1,096th career strikeout to become UCLA's new career leader. She passed Keira Goerl, who recorded 1,095 K's from 2001-04. She currently has 1,104 career strikeouts.

Selden ranks sixth in career victories with an 81-31 record, having passed Bruin legends Debbie Doom and Tracy Compton this season. Selden is also currently fourth in Bruin history with 126 career appearances and second with 774.0 innings pitched in her Bruin career.

COLBURN LEADS BRUIN OFFENSE>>

Junior LF Krista Colburn had big shoes to fill at the top of the UCLA lineup this season. She follows in the footsteps of many of UCLA's recent great players, including Andrea Duran (2005-06), Caitlin Benyi (2004-05), Natasha Watley (2001-03), Amanda Freed (2000-01) and Christie Ambrosi (1997-99).

Colburn has responded to the challenge, leading the Bruins in batting average (.398), at-bats (166), hits (66), triples (2) and is second in stolen bases (11) while turning in a .490 on-base percentage and .602 slugging percentage.

The Pac-10's leader in sacrifice hits a year ago, Colburn currently has two sac bunts on the year with 31 walks and 32 RBI to her credit.

UCLA'S SLATE STANDS UP IN EYES OF NCAA COMMITTEE >>

When the NCAA's final regular season RPI was announced on May 9, the Bruins strength of schedule was quite apparent. Ranked 13th prior to playing one game on the road at No. 1 Arizona and two at No. 5 Arizona State, the Bruins final RPI could easily be ranked in the nation's top-10.

Once the NCAA Tournament field was announced, UCLA had played 19 teams in the 2007 field. That includes 21 games against Pac-10 opponents, at least one team at 13 of the 16 Regional sites and at least one game against seven of the other 15 seeded

SLUGGERS KEEP BRUINS ON TOP >>

UCLA is at the top of the Pac-10 standings for offensive averages, finishing second the Pac in batting average (.306) whil leading in slugging percentage (.500) and on-base percentage (.408) through games of May 12.

The domination is plain in the individual standings as well, as the Bruins have two of the top-10 individual batting averages in the Pac-10 with Krista Colburn ranked fifth (.398) and Lisa Dodd eighth (.382).

UCLA also has two of the top-10 sluggers in the league with Lisa Dodd leading the way with a .704 slugging percentage to rank fourth, followed by Jodie Legaspi (.669/5th) and Colburn (.602/10th).

Legaspi, Dodd and Colburn are also in the conference top-10 in on-base percentage through games of May 6.

DODD AT TOP OF HOMER HEAP >>

Senior 2B/P Lisa Dodd blasted her 13th home run of the season on May 5 vs. Stanford, tying her for fifth in the Pac-10 standings. Two of the three players she trails, Oregon's Ann Marie Topps (18 HR, 59 GP) and ASU's Kaitlin Cochran (18 HR/64 GP) have significantly more games under their belt than Dodd (52 GP).

Dodd also appears in the Pac-10's statistical standings in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, RBI, total bases and walks.

WALK LIKE A LEGASPI >>

Senior shortstop Jodie Legaspi is hitting cleanup for the Bruins in 2007. Although she is ranked on Pac-10 statistical top-10 lists in nine categories, perhaps the most surprising is that her highest rank is in walks with 37 through the regular season. Legaspi is third in the Pac-10 in that category despite playing 12 fewer games than Pac-10 leader Kaitlin Cochran (47 BB/64 GP) and seven fewer than Oregon's Jennifer Salling (44 BB/59 GP).

INTRODUCING NO. 24, LAUREN WILMOTH! >>

The Bruins have added a player to their 2007 roster with women's soccer defender Lauren Wilmoth joining the team just prior to the start of the Stacy Winsberg Memorial Tournament on March 2.

Wilmoth was a starting defender on UCLA's College Cup team in the fall of 2006.

With senior lefty Whitney Holum having three HBP on her stat line, 17 of the 23 Bruins hit by a pitch this season have been lefthanded batters.

HERRERA RECOVERING FROM ACL SURGERY, SCHROEDER HAS KNEE SCOPED >>

Senior Ashley Herrera had successful surgery to repair her torn left anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) on Friday, March 9. The injury was suffered in the sixth inning of UCLA's season-opening game against Texas on Feb. 9, a 1-0 UCLA loss.

Herrera will miss the remainder of the 2007 season. She plans to apply to the Pacific-10 Conference for a medical hardship and use her final season of eligibility in 2008.

Junior IF/DP Jennifer Schroeder had surgery on her right knee on Tuesday. March 8. The exploratory scope debrided synovial tissue and the posterior horn of her meniscus. She is currently rehabilitating from the surgery and her return to the lineup is yet to be determined.

HEAD COACH KELLY INOUYE-PEREZ >>

Kelly Inouve-Perez became the third head coach in the history of the UCLA Softball program on January 1, 2007, following the retirement of Sue Enquist. Plans for the transition were announced on Sept. 26, 2006.

Inouye-Perez is in her 14th season on the UCLA coaching staff, having spent the past 13 years as an assistant coach under Enquist and Sharron Backus, working primarily with the Bruins pitchers and catchers. She becomes just the third head coach in the documented history of UCLA Softball, dating back to the 1975 spring season.

She won three NCAA titles as a player, in 1989, '90 and '92, and was a member of the coaching staff for UCLA's 1999, 2003 and '04 Championships.

JODIE LEGASPI NAMED PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK >>

UCLA senior shortstop Jodie Legaspi earned her first career Pac-10 Player of the Week honor on Tuesday, May 1, when she was announced as the conference's weekly honoree

Legaspi hit .417 (5-for-12) in four games for the Bruins last week with three home runs, a double, nine RBI and four runs scored. She was also perfect in the field at shortstop. UCLA went 3-1 on the week to move into a tie for second in the Pac-10 race at 9-6

UCLA's only setback came on Wednesday at Washington, 8-3. Legaspi did contribute an RBI double in the loss however. Legaspi then ended Friday's game against Oregon with a walk-off single in UCLA's 8-0 win.

Legaspi knocked in five of UCLA's six runs in a 6-3 win over No. 13/14 Oregon State on Saturday. She blasted a two-run homer with two outs in the first inning, then put the game away with a three-run longball in the fifth inning to give the Bruins a 6-1 lead. It was UCLA's first multi-home run game since Feb. 18

Sunday, Legaspi victimized the Beavers again, connecting on a game-tying two-run home run in the fourth inning, then scored UCLA's final run of the day in what would be a 5-3 win. Legaspi had at least one hit and RBI in all four games last week.

In Pac-10 play, Legaspi leads all hitters with 17 RBI, and is second in home runs with six. Legaspi is now seventh at UCLA in career RBI with 153, and sixth in home runs with 42

This is the first career Player of the Week award for Legaspi, and the 97th Player/ Pitcher of the Week award for UCLA.

LISA DODD NAMED PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK >>

UCLA senior 2B/P Lisa Dodd was named the Pac-10 Player of the Week for Feb. 20. She becomes the first Bruin to earn both Player and Pitcher of the Week honors during her career since Amanda Freed earned Pitcher of the Week honors on Mar. 30, 1999, and Player of the Week honors on Feb. 18, 2002.

Dodd helped lead the Bruins to a 5-1 record, hitting .500 (9-for-18) with five runs scored, 12 RBI, a double and three home runs. She also pitched three innings of one-hit softball against Wright State on Feb. 18, striking out three with no walks to earn the victory.

Dodd had at least one hit in each of UCLA's games and at least one RBI in four of the team's six games. Her week started with a first-inning grand slam home run, the fourth of her Bruin career, against UC Riverside. She finished that game going 2-for-3 with five RBI.

MEGAN LANGENFELD NAMED PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK >>

UCLA freshman Megan Langenfeld was named the Pac-10 Softball Player of the Week for Mar. 6-12.

UCLA went 6-0 during the week, 5-0 at the Long Beach State Invitational, and Langenfeld hit safely in every game for the Bruins with the exception of the March 10 game against Canisius when she did not get an official plate appearance while walking once and twice being hit by a pitch.

Langenfeld was a Jill-of-all-trades for UCLA. She homered on Wednesday against Cal State Fullerton, her fourth of the season. had a hit and two sacrifice bunts Friday vs. Southern Utah, then doubled and drove in a run in UCLA's 8-0 win over Eastern Kentucky later that same Friday.

After walking off the two bean balls she absorbed against Canisius, Langenfeld heated up even more, going 2-for-3 against Long Beach State with a triple and RBI in a big Bruin victory. Sunday, Langenfeld again went 2-for-3 against Notre Dame, picking up three more RBI in a 9-3 win.

For the week, the Bakersfield, Calif. native led the Bruins with a .538 batting average (7-for-13) with three runs scored, a double, triple, home run, six RBI, four walks, three hit-by-pitches and two sacrifice bunts. Her on-base percentage of .700 was a teamhigh and she slugged 1.000 for the week, as well as playing perfect defense on 24 chances.

BRUINS SET HOME RUN RECORD AT DESERT CLASSIC >>

UCLA posted a 4-1 record at the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic Feb. 16-18 in Las Vegas and punctuated the weekend with a record-setting day against Wright State on Sun., Feb. 18.

The Bruin bats pounded out a school record seven home runs in the game, including two home runs apiece from freshmen Kaila Shull and Megan Langenfeld. Thirteen of the combined 14 runs scored in UCLA's 12-2 five-inning win crossed the plate on home runs.

Other notables from the weekend included two games with two doubles apiece from Langenfeld, against Colorado State and UNLV. Langenfeld actually doubled twice in

If you're asking "Who's on First" when it comes to the National Championship banners on UCLA's outfield wall, there are stories to go with every answer.

UCLA's 11 banners feature 14 players with one each for the team's first eight titles and two each for the three most recent crowns. Identifications are as follows:

Banner #1 (1978 AIAW): Sue Enquist (1975-78) was the starting centerfielder for the Bruins and earned the program's first All-America honor in 1978, prior to serving 27 years on UCLA's coaching staff.

Banner #2 (1982 NCAA): Dot Richardson (1981-83) is one of the iconic figures in the sport of softball. A two-time Olympic Gold Medalist for Team USA, Richardson is a practicing orthopedic surgeon in Florida.

Banner #3 (1984 NCAA): Debbie Doom (1982-85) won three NCAA titles during her collegiate career and was the Most Outstanding Player of the inaugural WCWS in 1982.

Banner #4 (1985 NCAA): Tracy Compton (1982-85) earned three NCAA titles as a Bruin and was named to the All-WCWS team in 1985.

Banner #5 (1988 NCAA): Lisa Longaker (1987-90) was named to the NCAA's 25th Anniversary All-WCWS team and was part of UCLA's back-to-back-to-back title teams from 1988-90.

Banner #6 (1989 NCAA): Janice Parks (1986-89) was a 1996 Olympian representing Puerto Rico. A three-time All-American, Parks was a member of the 1989 All-WCWS team for the champion Bruins.

Banner #7 (1990 NCAA): Yvonne Gutierrez (1989-92) was a three-time All-American and three-time All-WCWS selection, winning three NCAA titles during her UCLA

Banner #8 (1992 NCAA): Lisa Fernandez (1990-93) was a Honda Broderick Cup winner, four-time All-American and three-time Olympic Gold Medalist for Team USA. She is currently an assistant coach for UCLA.

Banner #9 (1999 NCAA): Left- Stacey Nuveman (1997-02) NCAA career home run leader, two-time Olympic Gold Medalist for Team USA; Right- Julie Adams (1997-00) Most Outstanding Player of the WCWS, hitting over .600 in the tournament with a separated left shoulder.

Banner #10 (2003 NCAA): Left- Keira Goerl (2001-04) MVP of the WCWS, pitching the first no-hitter in the history of the NCAA Championship Game. Goerl's no-hitter was named one of the "25 Defining Moments" as part of the NCAA's 100th Anniversary celebration; Right- Natasha Watley (2000-03) Honda Broderick Cup winner and fourtime All-American. Olympic Gold Medalist for Team USA in 2004.

Banner #11 (2004 NCAA): Left- Claire Sua (2001-04) hit a solo home run to break up a perfect game in the NCAA Championship game. Two-time All-American; Right- Caitlin Benyi (2003-06) was the 2004 NCAA home run champion, three-time All-American and a 2004 All-WCWS selection.

LEGASPI, SELDEN NAMED TO USA **SOFTBALL WATCH LIST >>**

Senior shortstop Jodie Legaspi and junior pitcher Anjelica Selden are among 50 players named to the Amateur Softball Association's "Watch List" for the USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award.

The award, which will be presented for the sixth time in June, is considered one of the most prestigious honors in college softball and is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by collegiate softball players around the country.

The ASA will announce a list of 25 finalists on April 4. A player does not have to appear on the initial watch list to be considered as a Top-25 finalist, but once the Top 25 is named the remaining finalists must be selected from that list.

Just days before the start of post-season play, a list of 10 finalists will be named and released on May 9. The final three finalists will be announced May 23, while the winner of the 2007 USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award will be announced prior to the start of the 2007 NCAA Women's College World Series in Oklahoma City.

Past winners of this award include UCLA's Stacey Nuveman, Florida State's Jessica Van der Linden and three-time winner Cat Osterman from Texas.

SENIOR LEADERS CRITICAL TO 2007 SUCCESS >>

Eight of UCLA's 17 eligible players on the 2007 roster are seniors, all of whom have experience as starters. The group is versatile and could field an entire team as several can play multiple positions. Four have been regular starters during their Bruin careers, including Lisa Dodd (P/1B), Tara Henry (CF), Whitney Holum (RF/DP) and Jodie Legaspi (SS). Kristen Dedmon has seen several key pinch-hit at-bats during her career, while Jaisa Creps looks to break in as UCLA's starting catcher this season. Rounding out the group are Celina Rubalcaba (2B) and Shana Stewart (OF), both of whom could see playing time this season.

The group would have included nine seniors had Ashley Herrera not suffered a seasonending injury in the opener vs. Texas.
