Chrissie Amorosia (1998-2001) - After graduating from UCLA with a double-major in Political Science and History, Amorosia decided to take a turn at acting. In 2003, she was awarded one of 15 spots in the international Postgraduate Acting program at the Guildfrod School of Acting in England. After finishing the program, Amorosia returned to America, eventually settling in New York. Today, she has acted in several Off-Broadway shows and has also crossed into TV, film, readings and workshops for new plays and musicals and commercial work both online and televised.

Amorosia also works as a photographer at Tavern on the Green and has served as an assistant to Broadway and Off-Broadway producers.

# Key Athletic Department Personnel



Dan Guerrero **Athletic Director** UCLA '74 · 6th Year

On April 25, 2002, former UCLA Chancellor Albert Carnesale announced that Daniel G Guerrero had been named UCLA's eighth

Director of Athletics, succeeding the retiring Peter Dalis. A former Bruin baseball player, Guerrero, who assumed his duties on July 1, 2002, exudes the pride of a student-athlete who is now calling the shots at his alma mater.

Guerrero, one of the most respected and talented administrators in intercollegiate athletics, has rapidly placed his mark on the program as the director of athletics at UCLA. He is currently serving as the chair of the NCAA's Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group. He is also a member of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee. In June, he was selected 2007 NACDA Division I West Region Athletic Director of the Year.

In his first five years, Guerrero has clearly established a pattern of "image and substance" that few in his profession can match. UCLA stands as the No. 1 University in the nation for NCAA Team Championships won (100), a number that continues to grow under his direction. UCLA teams have won 14 NCAA national championships (the highest total in the nation in that span), finished second 12 times and have had an additional 17 Top Five finishes. A staggering 94 teams (of 115 possible) have qualified for NCAA post-season competition and the football team has appeared in five bowl games. The program has also won 32 conference championships in 14 different sports, produced 286 All-Americans and featured four Honda Award winners, including the 2003-04 Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year.

Furthermore, during the 2004 Summer Olympic Games in Athens, Greece, 57 Bruins participated as athletes or coaches, representing the United States and 13 other countries. They earned 19 medals, including eight gold medals.

Guerrero came to UCLA from UC Irvine, where he had served as UCI's fifth permanent Director of Athletics for 10 years (1992-2002). The broad competitive success of its athletic teams, the academic excellence of its student-athletes, the development of new and improved facilities and enhanced relations with the UCI community, reflect the progress UC Irvine Athletics experienced under Guerrero's direction. During his tenure, the program continued to accumulate conference championships, garner national rankings, feature graduation rates among the nation's best, and win numerous postseason honors for its student-athletes.

Born on November 10, 1951 in Tucson, AZ, he is married to the former Anne Marie Aniello and they have two daughters: Jenna (24) and Katie (20).



Ken Weiner **Associate Athletic** Director • UCLA '78 • 14th Year

Ken Weiner enters his 14th year overseeing the business operations for the UCLA Athletic Department and is in his

28th year overall with the university.

His duties include the administration and supervision of six Bruin sport programs, including baseball, men's and women's soccer, women's swimming and diving, and men's and women's water polo. During his tenure at UCLA Athletics, his sports have garnered 12 national championships and numerous conference championship titles. He also oversees new business and project development and capital improvements for the department.

Weiner spearheaded the negotiations that resulted in a 20-year agreement between UCLA and the Rose Bowl, including much needed facilities improvements for the football program. In addition, he supervises the athletic facilities division, the operations of UCLA's sports practice and competition venues, game and event operations, department and team travel and UCLA Camps and Clinics.

Weiner is responsible for major capital improvements for Athletics. Projects include the renovated J.D. Morgan Intercollegiate Athletics Center and Acosta Student Athlete Training Center and Knapp Football Center, the new Hall of Fame, the Jackie Robinson baseball and Easton softball clubhouse construction and stadium renovations, the Drake Track/Marshall Field renovation, a new golf practice facility, Pauley Pavilion interior upgrades and the North soccer field construction. Current projects underway include the buildout of the Olympic Sport Locker Rooms in the Acosta Center and new baseball field of play at Jackie Robinson Stadium.

The new Spieker Aquatic Center is scheduled to break ground in fall of 2008. Future projects include a major renovation of the historic Pauley Pavilion, upgrade of the baseball stadium clubhouse and practice facilities and construction of a new Academic Studies Center.

Weiner participates on a number of campus steering committees on behalf of Athletics, including the Campus Facilities Coordination, Campus Project Review and the Alumni Advisory Board. Weiner is a member of NACDA and IAAM. He has served on various committees for the NCAA, most recently as chairman of the Men's Water Polo Committee.

Prior to his appointment at UCLA Athletics, Weiner co-founded and served as Associate Director of the UCLA Central Ticket Office and continues to serve as the liaison between the Athletic Department and the CTO. He earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology from UCLA in 1978. He and his wife, Caren, have two children, Nicole, 21, and Kevin, 18.



to Seco, veer right on Seco to Arroyo Blvd., turn right on Arroyo. The RBAC is at the end of the street on the left.

# **SPIEKER AQUATIC CENTER**

**Breaking Ground in Spring 2008** 

The UCLA Athletic Department announced the construction of the Spieker Aquatic Center in April 2006. The new aquatic center, to be located at the Sunset Canyon Recreation Center on campus, will house a 52-meter x 25-yard deep-water pool and diving well (1m/3m boards, 5m/10m tower).

Thanks to the generous lead gift of former student-athlete Tod Spieker and his wife Catherine, the aquatic center dream will become reality. Spieker, a 1971 UCLA graduate, swam for the Bruins from 1968-71 and was an All-American in 1969. Presently, he and his family reside in Atherton, Calif.

The UCLA Athletic Department is working in conjunction with UCLA's Cultural and Recreational Affairs to develop the new center. Once completed, the Spieker



Aquatic Center will offer the opportunity to not only host UCLA athletic events, but also Master's swimming events, individual club swim meets and U.S. Water Polo events, along with regional, national and international competition.

Diving will be able to host U.S. Diving Senior National Championships in the new facility. The new pool will also allow UCLA to host annual collegiate and junior diving invitationals (i.e. The Bruin Invite/JO Regionals and Zones, with the hope of hosting a Junior National Championship). The state-of-the-art facility will bring together all three of UCLA's intercollegiate aquatic sports – water polo, swimming and diving – in one venue.

The \$10-million project includes a clubhouse that will contain locker rooms, coaches' offices and meeting rooms which currently do not exist for intercollegiate athletics. The Spieker Aquatic Center will be a lighted facility and will hold 800 spectators in the permanent grand-stand. For large-scale events, UCLA will have the ability to seat an additional 1,700 spectators in temporary seating.

A new deep-water competition swimming pool and related locker and shower facilities will provide the campus with a venue specifically designed for the special needs of its swimming, water polo and diving programs. This facility will allow the campus to regain blocks of time at the Sunset Canyon Recreation Center and Student Activity Center pools.

Tod Spieker is the President of Spieker Companies, a multi-family and apartment complex company located in Palo Alto, Calif. Spieker continues to compete in the Master's swim program and was inducted into the International Master's Swimming Hall of Fame in 2005. The Spieker family gift is currently the second-largest donation in UCLA Athletics' history.
