2004-05 SEASON IN REVIEW



BRUINS ADVANCE TO NCAA ROUND OF 16

For the sixth year in a row and the 23rd time in program history, UCLA advanced to the round of 16 at the season ending NCAA Championships. The Bruins, seeded 10th, cruised through regional competition at the Los Angeles Tennis Center, posting a pair of 4-0 victories over Illinois State and Washington in the first and second rounds respectively. That set up a showdown with seventh-seeded USC in Athens, Ga. Despite defeating the Women of Troy, 5-2 less than a month earlier, UCLA dropped a hard fought 4-3 decision.

ZALAMEDA REACHES NCAA SINGLES SEMIS

Freshman Riza Zalameda capped off an impressive first season of college tennis by reaching the semifinals in singles and the quarterfinals in doubles (w/Daniela Bercek) at the season-ending NCAA Championships. Unseeded in the 64-player singles draw, Zalameda upset second-seeded Julie Coin of Clemson in the quarterfinals, setting up a showdown with third-seeded Audra Cohen of Northwestern in the semifinals. Cohen eventually won the match 6-4, 6-4, ending Zalameda's impressive run. In doubles, Bercek and Zalameda were seeded fourth, however fell in the quarterfinals to Stanford's eventual finalists Amber Liu/Anne Yelsey.

UCLA IN THE FINAL ITA RANKINGS

With a 17-6 overall record, the Bruins checked in at No. 12 in the Final ITA Rankings issued following the NCAA Championships. Individually, UCLA had five singles players and two doubles teams appear in the final rankings. Headlining the list in singles was Daniela Bercek, who checked in at No. 10. She was followed by Riza Zalameda (#18), Laura Gordon (#94), Alex McGoodwin (#102) and Tracy Lin (#105). In doubles, Bercek and Zalameda ended the year at No. 4. Gordon and freshman Elizabeth Lumpkin were ranked No. 58.

BERCEK, ZALAMEDA EARN RACK UP POSTSEASON HONORS

Daniela Bercek and Riza Zalameda earned All-America honors in both singles and doubles in 2005. It marked the second year in a row that Bercek earned the distinction, after she was a singles and doubles All-American in 2004. Zalameda was one of only three freshmen in the country last season to be named an All-American in both singles and doubles. Bercek and Zalameda were also named Pac-10 Doubles Team of the Year, with Bercek earning first-team All-Pac-10 honors and Zalameda appearing on the second team.

MCGOODWIN HEADLINES PAC-10 ALL-ACADEMIC SELECTIONS

First-Team selection Alex McGoodwin headlined a list of four Bruins to earn Pac-10 All-Academic honors in 2005. Following McGoodwin was second-team selection Daniela Bercek. Also appearing on the list were honorable mention selections Sarah Gregg and Laura Gordon.

BRUINS FINISH THIRD IN FINAL PAC-10 STANDINGS

With a 6-2 record in conference play, UCLA finished third, behind Stanford and USC, in the final Pac-10 standings. The Bruins' only two conference losses in 2005 were to those two teams.

LIN AND LUMPKIN REACH INVITATIONAL FINAL IN OJAI

Freshmen Tracy Lin and Elizabeth Lumpkin advanced all the way to the finals of the Invitational Draw at the Pac-10 Championships in Ojai, Calif. As the only UCLA players to reach a final at last year's championships, the duo lost a tightly contested match to Oregon's Ester Bak/Davina Mendiburu, 9-8(6).

ZALAMEDA LEADS TEAM IN OVERALL SINGLES WINS

Riza Zalameda made a quick transition from junior tennis to the college level in 2005, leading UCLA in singles victories, finishing the season with a 31-12 overall record. Even more impressive was the fact that Zalameda, who played a majority of her matches at the No. 2 singles position, did it against some of the best players in the country. She also played three matches at the No. 1 spot, going 3-1 on the year. Following Zalameda in total wins was junior Laura Gordon, who posted a 23-10 overall record, including an 11-1 mark at the No. 6 position.
