Defending Champion Bruins to Face No. 6 Miami in NCAA Round of 16

The defending champion UCLA women's tennis team (19-6) has earned a trip to the NCAA Round of 16 beginning this week in College Station, Texas. The Bruins will meet No. 6 Miami (25-4) on Friday at 7:00 a.m. (PST), with the winner of that match moving on to the quarterfinals to face either No. 14 Arkansas or No. 3 Duke on Sunday at 10:00 a.m. (PST).

UCLA-Miami Series History

UCLA takes a 7-3 all-time record against Miami into this Friday's match. The Hurricanes won the last meeting between the two teams, a 4-3 win at the ITA National Team Indoors back in 2006. The last NCAA Tournament meeting between the two teams was in Athens, Ga. in 2006. UCLA, which advanced to the NCAA Final that year, won that quarterfinal encounter by a score of 4-3.

UCLA is 3-5 Against the Field

UCLA's 2009 record against the other 15 teams still alive in the NCAA Tournament stands at 3-5. The Bruins' wins have come over Fresno State (6-1), Florida (4-3) and Washington (5-2). UCLA's five losses have come against Stanford (6-1), Cal (6-1), Baylor (4-3), Georgia Tech (4-3) and Georgia (6-1).

A Year Ago

UCLA captured the program's first NCAA title - and second overall national title - at last year's NCAA Championships in Tulsa, Okla. After opening the tournament with a pair of regional victories over Buffalo and Denver, the Bruins cruised to the title with wins over USC (Rd. of 16), Arkansas (quarterfinals), Florida (semifinals) and Cal (final). In fact, UCLA lost just two points in six tournament matches last year. The Bruins were led last year by an experienced senior class that featured the NCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player Riza Zalameda, along with All-American Tracy Lin, Elizabeth Lumpkin and Alex McGoodwin. The Bruins finished the year with a 24-5 overall record.

Pantic Wins a Thriller Against ASU in NCAA Regional Action

Freshman Nina Pantic turned in one of the most clutch performances in recent UCLA women's tennis history on Sunday, winning the final 10 games of her match to clinch a 4-3 victory over Arizona State in the NCAA Second Round. Pantic, who was on the verge of defeat against ASU's Laila Abdala at court No. 4, stormed back to take the deciding singles match 4-6, 7-5, 6-0. Abdala actually served for the match up 5-3 in the second set, however the Sun Devil senior never won another game. The win was UCLA's third 4-3 victory over Arizona State this season. Prior to that second round match, the Bruins defeated Boston University, 4-0 in the first round.

Schnack, Remyense to Compete in NCAA Individual Draws

Junior Yasmin Schnack and sophomore Andrea Remyense have both been selected to participate in the 64-player NCAA singles draw in College Station, Texas. Schnack, who is ranked No. 15 in the latest Campbell's/ITA Singles Rankings, is a 9-16 seed in the event. Remyense is unseeded. The two players, who are also doubles partners, have earned a No. 3 seed in the 32-team doubles draw. Schnack and Remyense are vying to become the school's first NCAA singles champions since Keri Phebus accomplished the feat back in 1995. UCLA's last NCAA doubles title came just a year ago, as Tracy Lin and Riza Zalameda became the sixth team in school history to win the title.

Schnack Named First-Team All-Pac-10

Yasmin Schnack recently earned first-team All-Pac-10 honors for the first time in her career, as the league announced its all-conference picks last week. She leads the team in singles victories this season, taking a 26-8 overall record into this week's NCAA Regionals. Andrea Remyense was also recognized by the conference, taking home second-team All-Pac-10 honors. *[Complete 2009 All-Pac-10 teams can be found on page 3]*

UCLA in the Campbell's/ITA Rankings

UCLA checked in at No. 11 in the final Campbell's/ITA Rankings of the regular season released last week. Rankings will not be released again until the end of the NCAA Championships. Yasmin Schnack is UCLA's highest ranked player at No. 15. She is followed by No. 57 Andrea Remyense and No. 114 Maya Johansson. In doubles, Remyense and Schnack are ranked No. 3 nationally. Carling Seguso and Stephanie Wetmore are ranked No. 66.

Bruins Win ITA National Team Sportsmanship Award for April

The Hope College men's and UCLA women's tennis teams have been honored as April's recipients of the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) National Team Sportsmanship Award, the ITA announced on May 4. UCLA traveled to Waco, Texas to take on Baylor back on March 14. Upon arrival to the match, the courts had gotten wet due to an overnight shower. Stella and her squad helped dry the courts in the morning and were willing to help in anyway possible. The match was very intense but their players were fair and represented their university in a first class manner. It is because of this that UCLA was honored the award for the month of April.

Bruins on Verge of 20 Wins Again

At 19-4 overall, UCLA is on the verge of registering the program's third straight 20-win season, and fourth in head coach Stella Sampras Webster's 13 years as head coach. The Bruins can reach the 20-win mark with a victory over Miami this Friday.

Schnack Leads Team in Ranked Wins

Junior Yasmin Schnack leads the team this year in wins over ranked opponents with 14. Her highest ranked win on the season came over No. 3 Kelcy McKenna of Arizona State in a dual match on April 10. Andrea Remynse (7) and Maya Johansson (5) are the next two players with the most ranked wins. Remynse is the only other Bruin with a top 10 win, as she defeated fifth-ranked Amanda Fink of USC in the quarterfinals of the ITA West Region Championships back in October.

Johansson/Lind Take Ojai Crown

Although they are not listed as a doubles team in the Bruins NCAA lineup, Maya Johansson and Anna-Viktoria Lind turned in quite a showing two weeks ago in Ojai. The duo captured the Invitational doubles title at the Pac-10 Championships with an 8-2 victory over Stanford's Isamarie Perez/Jennifer Yen in the final. It marked the first time that Johansson and Lind had ever played together.

Seguso Peaking for NAAs

Freshman Carling Seguso appears to be peaking at the right time for the 11th-seeded Bruins, as she has won 11 of her last 12 matches. Seguso, who owns a 26-11 overall record, recently captured the Invitational singles title at the Pac-10 Championships in Ojai, Calif. She didn't drop a set in five matches, culminating with a 6-2, 7-5 victory over Cal's Marion Ravelojaona in the final.

Doubles is Key

UCLA is 16-1 when winning the doubles point this season, meaning that the Bruins have lost the doubles point in five of their six losses. The only match where UCLA was able to recover from losing the doubles point was against Arizona State on April 10, as the Bruins battled back to pull out a 4-3 win on the road.

Schnack, Seguso Tied at 26

Junior Yasmin Schnack (26-9) and freshman Carling Seguso (26-11) are tied for the team lead in singles wins with 26 apiece. The two other Bruins in the 20-win club are Andrea Remynse (20-15) and Nina Pantic (20-11). Schnack's 26 wins are even more impressive when you consider that she has faced 22 ranked opponents this season. The other three players have faced 29 ranked opponents combined.

Georgia Tech Transfer Bolsters Bruin Lineup

Sophomore Maya Johansson has been a key addition to the Bruins this season, as she currently occupies the No. 3 spot in the lineup. As a freshman at Georgia Tech last year, Johansson climbed to No. 6 in the ITA singles rankings after winning the first 12 matches of her collegiate career. She advanced to the semifinals at the prestigious ITA All-American Championships en route to finishing the season with a 29-8 overall record. This year, Johansson is 18-18 overall in singles for the Bruins.

Hoffpauir, Montez Set for 2010

Head coach Stella Sampras Webster has inked two of the nation's top recruits for the 2010 season, as Stephanie Hoffpauir (Escondido, Calif.) and Pamela Montez (La Quinta, Calif./Mexico) have both signed letters of intent to join the Bruins next year. Hoffpauir is currently listed as the nation's No. 9 recruit by the website TennisRecruiting.net. Montez currently owns a world junior ranking of No. 42 and recently captured the women's open title at The Ojai.

Going For 105

The UCLA women's water polo team recently captured the school's 104th NCAA Team Championship on Sunday, defeating USC, 5-4 in the title match in Maryland. UCLA leads the nation in NCAA Team Championships and was the first school to reach 100 NCAA Championships when the women's water polo team won the title in 2007. Stanford ranks second in all-time NCAA Championships. USC is third.

Clinching Wins

Yasmin Schnack, Ashley Joelson and Nina Pantic have all come up big this season in pressure situations. Schnack has done it more than once, twice

winning matches with the score tied 3-3. She won the deciding match in a 4-3 victory over No. 10 Florida at the ITA Team Indoors and duplicated that feat in a 4-3 win over Arizona State on April 10. Joelson's biggest win of the year came in the Bruins' 4-3 upset of No. 10 USC on March 5, as she won a three-setter over Alison Ramos at court No. 5 in the deciding match. Pantic's crucial win came just this past Sunday, as she downed ASU's Laila Abdala, 4-6, 7-5, 6-0 at court No. 4 to put UCLA in the round of 16.

Head Coach Stella Sampras Webster

Stella Sampras Webster, who owns a 229-109 (676) record in her 13th season as head coach, is coming off a dream season in 2008, leading the Bruins to their first NCAA Championship and first national championship since 1981 (AIAW). UCLA finished last season with a 24-5 overall record, marking the most wins for the program since 1982. Seeded No. 7 in last year's tournament, the Bruins' dramatic run to the title culminated with a 4-0 victory over Cal in the final in Tulsa, Okla. It marked the 102nd NCAA title in UCLA history. Sampras Webster also guided the Bruins to their first Pac-10 Championship last year, finishing the conference season with a 7-1 record. She was named Pac-10 Coach of the Year at the end of the season. Few college coaches can match Sampras Webster's ability to continually put their teams in the title hunt year in and year out as, prior to last year's championship season, she guided the program to a pair of second place finishes in 2004 and 2007. In all, Sampras Webster has led the Bruins 11 top 10 finishes in 12 seasons in Westwood. UCLA has also finished in the top 5 nationally on seven occasions (1997, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2007 and 2008).
