

2004 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2004 UCLA women's volleyball season saw the Bruins play in their fifth NCAA Regional Final over a six-year span, and saw the program say good-bye to a five-member senior class while seasoning the younger players on the team for seasons to come.

The season opened on a hot night in Northridge, Calif., where UCLA posted a four-game victory over Cal State Northridge in a very warm Matadome. The Bruins then hit the road, traveling to the McDonald's/Texas A&M Invitational where UCLA posted three sweeps over Southern Mississippi, Samford and the then-15th-ranked host Aggies. From College Station, the Bruins made their annual trip to Honolulu for the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Challenge where **Nana Meriwether** opened tournament play with an eye-popping 14 blocks in UCLA's sweep of then-No. 17 Santa Clara before the Bruins and host Wahine tangled in an epic five-game duel in the tournament finale with Hawai'i earning the five-game victory. In that match, senior libero **Chrissie Zartman** truly began her assault on the UCLA record books, posting her first career 30-dig match.

A trip to Salt Lake City saw the Bruins continue an unlucky streak, falling in five games to Utah before rebounding for a four-game victory over BYU to take a 7-2 record into the start of Pac-10 play.

UCLA opened at home against eventual Pac-10 Champion Washington, falling to the Huskies in four games. The Bruins rebounded with four straight wins over Washington State, the Arizona Schools and a 45th consecutive victory over California before dropping a four-game match to Stanford in Pauley Pavilion.

A lackluster performance at USC's Lyon Center and a road sweep of the Oregon schools saw the Bruins take a 6-3 conference record to the midway point of the conference schedule. Notable in that first half was the performance of reserve setter **Tammy Jackson**, who set the Bruins to a five-game victory at Oregon State after senior starter **Krystal McFarland** was sidelined with an ankle injury late in the Oct. 21 sweep of Oregon. Jackson would also set UCLA's five-game heartbreaking loss to Pepperdine in Pauley Pavilion on Oct. 26 before McFarland was able to return to the lineup. The pair split setting duties over Halloween weekend as UCLA split with the Arizona schools in Pauley Pavilion, downing the Sun Devils 3-0 before being swept by the Wildcats on Oct. 30.

A road trip to the Bay Area was next on the schedule. The Bruins dropped a difficult five-game decision at Stanford, but were able to hold on for a dramatic five-game win at California the following night in order to keep the program's unblemished record against the Golden Bears intact. That victory foreshadowed one of UCLA's best efforts of the season, a dramatic five-game dogfight at Pauley Pavilion with the two-time defending NCAA Champion USC Women of Troy, a battle that the Bruins would lose 18-16 in the fifth and final game.

UCLA went on to sweep the Oregon schools and post a win at Oregon State before falling to

Washington in four games on the final day of the regular season to finish fourth in the Pac-10 with an 11-7 conference record. NCAA Tournament play saw the Bruins play host to Loyola Marymount and Long Beach State on the opening weekend at Pauley Pavilion before traveling to Seattle yet again for NCAA Regionals.

In what could be described as the team's best overall match of the season, UCLA defeated the second-seeded Nittany Lions of Penn State 30-24, 22-30, 30-25, 30-28 to advance to the Regional Final against the host Washington Huskies. Another five-game thriller would follow, with a masterful back-row effort from Chrissie Zartman yielding her sixth 30-dig effort of the season in the UCLA loss. Prior to the 2004 season, there had been just five 30-dig matches in the 30+ years of Bruin women's volleyball history. Zartman more than doubled that number in her senior season alone.

Zartman would finish her stellar career with a Pac-10 and UCLA single-season record of 708 digs. On Oct. 25, she became the first purely defensive player in Pac-10 history to earn Player of the Week honors following a 24-dig match in a three-game win over Oregon and a 25-dig performance in UCLA's five-game win over Oregon State. Her 2,034 career digs is also a UCLA and Pac-10 record and ranks fourth in NCAA Division I history.

Zartman earned second-team AVCA All-America honors and was joined at the All-America banquet in Long Beach, Calif., by senior setter McFarland, who earned third-team honors. Zartman was the only Bruin to earn first-team All-Pac-10 honors, but four of her teammates, McFarland, Brynn Murphy, Becky Green and Nana Meriwether earned honorable mention notice.

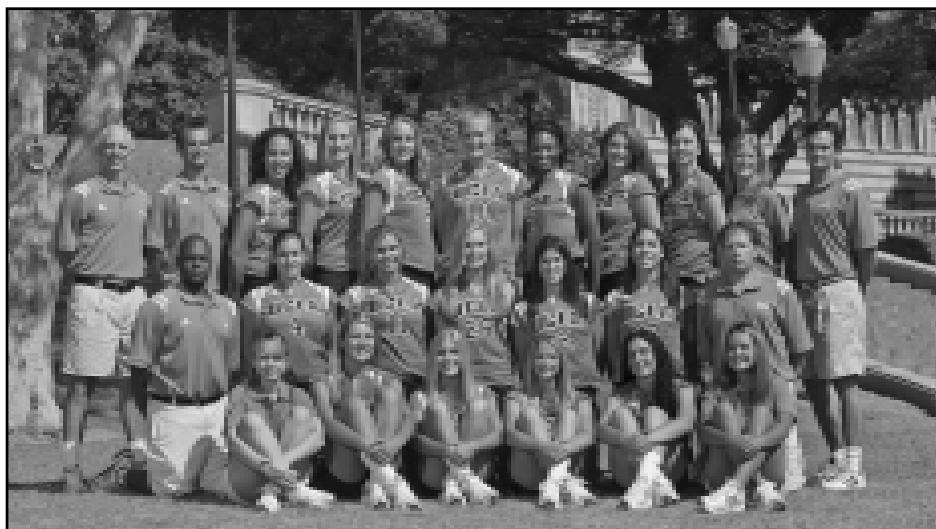

THE PAC-10 CONFERENCE

Entering the 2004-05 season, the Pacific-10 Conference continues to uphold its tradition as the "Conference of Champions."® Pac-10 members have claimed an incredible 84 NCAA team titles over the past nine seasons, for an average of more than eight championships per academic year.

Even more impressive is the breadth of the Pac-10's success, as those 84 team titles over the past nine seasons have come in 21 different men's and women's sports. The Pac-10 has now led the nation in NCAA Championships 39 of the last 44 years and finished second five times.

Spanning nearly a century of outstanding athletics achievement, the Pac-10 has captured 336 NCAA titles (246 men's, 90 women's), far outdistancing the runner-up Big Ten Conference's 197 titles.

The Pac-10 captured 11 NCAA titles in 2003-04, more than double of any other conference. The Pac-10 total of 11 NCAA titles was followed by the Southeastern Conference, which was runner-up with five NCAA crowns, and the Big Ten, which had four. The 11 titles for the Pac-10 is the most for the Conference since it had 11 in 1997-98. The Pac-10 had the most NCAA titles of any conference in women's sports with eight, and tied with the SEC and Big Ten for most in men's sports with three. NCAA team champions from the Pac-10 in 2003-04 came from: UCLA (women's gymnastics, women's golf, softball, women's track and field), STANFORD (men's and women's cross country and women's tennis), USC (women's volleyball and men's and women's water polo) and CALIFORNIA (men's golf).

Since the NCAA began conducting women's championships 23 years ago, Pac-10 members have claimed at least four national titles in a single season on 15 occasions. Overall, the Pac-10 has captured 90 NCAA women's crowns, easily outdistancing the Southeastern Conference, which is second with 60. Pac-10 members have dominated a number of sports, winning 17 softball titles, 15 tennis crowns, nine of the last 14 volleyball titles, 11 of the last 15 trophies in golf and eight of the last 16 in swimming and diving.

Currently, the Pac-10 sponsors 11 men's sports and 11 women's sports. Additionally, the Conference is a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) in four other men's sports and two other women's sports.

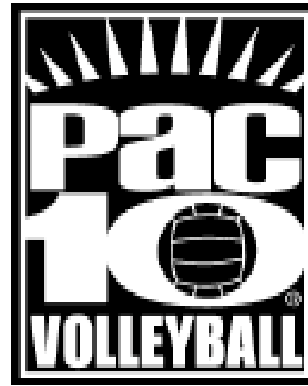
