NO. 1 SEED ON THE LINE AS STANFORD VISITS USC

STANFORD (23-1 Overall/4-0 MPSF) goalkeeper Kate Baldoni anchored a defense which gave up just one fourth quarter goal to No. 4 UCLA this past Saturday, an 8-1 Cardinal win to secure at least the two seed for the MPSF Championship Tournament. Baldoni totaled seven saves as No. 2 Stanford won its 11th straight, elevating to a first-place tie with top-ranked USC, and entering a Saturday (Apr. 13) battle in Los Angeles for the MPSF Tournament No. 1 seed.

USC (20-0 Overall/4-0 MPSF) comes off road victories at No. 11 Loyola Marymount, 17-6, and No. 7 UC Irvine, 11-3. Monica Vavic combined for five goals, including a second quarter hat trick, and is within two goals of 100 for her career of less than two years. Jayde Appel added three goals and four steals over the two wins. USC handed Stanford its only loss, 13-10 on Feb. 24.

CALIFORNIA (15-5 Overall/1-3 MPSF) Pippa Saunders and Ashley Young posted hat tricks in the 11-8 win at San Jose State last Saturday. Dana Ochsner added two goals and recorded a Sunday hat trick at home against Loyola Marymount, a 12-4 win. The Bears travel to CSU Bakersfield Saturday (Apr. 13).

ARIZONA STATE (24-5 Overall/3-2 MPSF) swept through the Brown Invitational, collecting five wins. Alicia Brightwell and Shannon Haas were the scoring leaders with 16 and 15 combined goals, respectively. Goalkeeper E.B. Keeve had 15 of her 57 total saves in the 10-8 win over Hartwick. ASU also topped Brown, Michigan, Marist, and Harvard, and plays its MPSF finale Saturday at home against San Jose State.

CSU BAKERSFIELD (12-20 Overall/0-4 MPSF) split four games at the Brown Invitational, defeating the host Bears, 12-11, and Harvard, 17-12. Paige Tsuruda had three goals and Alex Bayer 12 saves vs. the Crimson. Sam Shead had four goals in the Hartwick game, and Janelle Shelby and Jessica Browning poured in hat tricks against Brown.

UCLA (21-4 Overall/3-2 MPSF) has three games left in the regular season, all at home. Loyola Marymount and Cal Baptist visit this week, followed by the finale on Apr. 19 against USC. The Bruins will then have no worse than the four seed.

SAN JOSE STATE (10-9 Overall/0-4 MPSF) has two conference games remaining, Saturday (Apr. 13) at Arizona State, followed by hosting CSU Bakersfield on Apr. 20. Rae Lekness, Timi Molnar, and Victoria Smith each scored twice vs. Cal.

KATE BALDONI MPSF KAP 7 PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Stanford senior goalkeeper **Kate Baldoni** (Newport Beach, CA/Corona Del Mar HS) recorded seven saves, allowing just one goal which came in the fourth quarter, in the 8-1 win over No. 4 UCLA. The outcome secured at least a two seed in the postseason MPSF Tournament for Stanford.

She shared a team-high three goals in an 11-8 road win over No. 10 San Jose State, including a fourth quarter goal that helped seal the win after being tied with five minutes left. Saunders added another goal during Cal's 12-4 victory over No. 11 Loyola Marymount.
