MISCELLANEOUS PRESEASON NEWS & NOTES

VETERAN STARTER

Senior guard Norman Powell is UCLA's only returning starter from last season's team. Powell is the Bruins' top returning scorer from 2013-14, having averaged 11.4 points and 2.8 rebounds per game as a junior. Powell, who hails from San Diego, has played in all 105 games for UCLA the past three seasons. He started all 37 games as a junior last season.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS

UCLA has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in three of the last four seasons. Last March, the Bruins earned their 46th trip to the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Regional Semifinals (Sweet 16) after securing consecutive wins against Tulsa and Stephen F. Austin in San Diego.

TOURNEY TITLE

Last season, UCLA won the Pac-12 Tournament title for the first time since 2008 and for the fourth time in program history. The Bruins won three games in as many days, defeating Oregon, Stanford and Arizona. Kyle Anderson earned tournament Most Outstanding Player accolades, leading UCLA in the title game with 21 points and 15 rebounds.

TALENTED NEWCOMERS

UCLA's team features three players who were high school McDonald's All-Americans who are set to take the floor for the first time as Bruins – sophomore Isaac Hamilton and freshmen Kevon Looney and Thomas Welsh. Including junior Tony Parker, UCLA has four players who secured high school McDonald's All-America honors on this season's roster.

YEAR TWO

Head coach Steve Alford enters his 24th season as a college basketball head coach, his second year with UCLA. Alford helped the Bruins engineer a 28-9 record in 2013-14, tying the school record for single-season victories by a UCLA head coach in his first season (Gene Bartow had 28 wins in 1975-76). Alford has gone 491-244 overall in 23 seasons as a head coach.

MAJOR STRIDES

Junior forward/center Tony Parker saw his playing time increase dramatically in 2013-14. Having played just 6.3 minutes per game in 33 contests as a freshman, Parker averaged 6.9 points and 4.4 rebounds in 17.2 minutes per game last season, competing in all 37 games (making nine starts). Parker shot a team-leading 60.2 percent from the field last season.

UCLA'S SCHEDULE

The Bruins 2014-15 schedule will feature at least nine teams that competed in last season's NCAA Tournament. Three of UCLA's upcoming opponents – Arizona, Kentucky and Stanford – advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 one year ago. In all, six Pac-12 Conference teams earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2013-14.

HEIGHT ADVANTAGE

UCLA's roster features six players of at least 6-foot-9 and no players under 6-foot-3. Incoming freshmen Thomas Welsh (7-foot-0), G.G. Goloman (6-foot-10) and Kevon Looney (6-foot-9) will immediately add length and height to the Bruins' lineup in 2014-15.

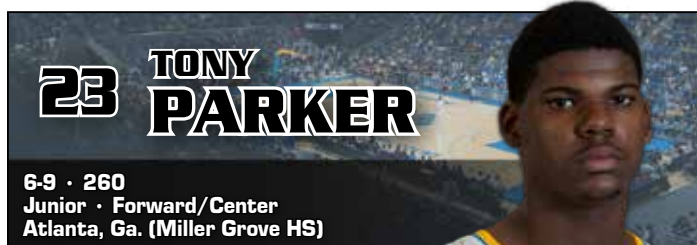
