## JERSEY EVOLUTION

Here is a look at some of the different UCLA women's soccer jerseys since the program's inception in 1993. Reebok was the original apparel supplier of the Bruins until adidas took over UCLA's all-sport contract in 1999.



## SOCCER TIMELINE (1993-PRESENT)

**Mar. 9, 1993** — The UCLA Athletic Department announces the addition of women's soccer as an NCAA Division-I sport at the university.

**May 25, 1993** — U.S. Women's National Team standout Joy Fawcett is named the first head coach in UCLA history.

**Sept. 7, 1993** — UCLA defeats Southern California College, 11-0 in its first-ever match.

**Sept. 13, 1993** — UCLA and USC meet for the first time with the Bruins posting a 6-0 victory over the Women of Troy in a match at Cal Tech. It marks the first of five-straight wins for the Bruins in the series.

**Nov. 11, 1995** — In the school's first NCAA Tournament appearance, the Bruins fall to the University of Washington, 2-1 in the first round at UCLA.

**Sept. 29, 1996** — Junior forward Traci Arkenberg becomes the first UCLA player to score four goals in a game, as the Bruins defeat UC Irvine, 5-1.

**Nov. 9, 1997** — UCLA claims its first-ever Pac-10 title with a 4-0 victory over Washington State in its final match of the regular season. The Bruins finish the conference season with a perfect 9-0 record.

**Nov. 16, 1997** — After missing the NCAA Tournament in 1996, the Bruins pick up their first-ever tournament victory, upsetting national power Portland, 1-0 in the first round in Portland, Ore. Sophomore Beth Thompson scores the game's only goal off a rebound in the 43rd minute.

**Dec. 3, 1997** — Head coach Joy Fawcett steps down after five seasons with the Bruins. She retires with an all-time record of 65-24-7.

**Dec. 7, 1997** — Traci Arkenberg (first team) and Rhannon Tanaka (third team) are named the school's first-ever All-Americans in women's soccer.

**Jan. 30, 1998** — UCLA hires Loyola Marymount men's head coach and former UCLA assistant coach Todd Saldana as Fawcett's replacement.

**June 13, 1998** — After leading the team in scoring for the fourth straight season, senior Traci Arkenberg is named UCLA's Female Athlete of the Year at the all-sports banquet.

**Nov. 14, 1998** — After receiving a first-round bye in the NCAA Tournament, UCLA drops a 2-0 decision to BYU in the second round at UCLA's North Athletic Field.

**May 21, 1999** — Coming off a 17-4-1 record in his first season as coach, Todd Saldana is named the new UCLA men's head coach replacing longtime coach Sigi Schmid.

**July 8, 1999** — Jillian Ellis is hired as the third head coach in UCLA history. She comes in with an overall record of 19-18 after coaching the previous two seasons at the University of Illinois.

**July 31, 2000** — Jillian Ellis announces the signing of her first UCLA recruiting class. Headlined by U.S. National Team players Nandi Pryce (pictured), Kathryn Lee, Sarah-Gayle Swanson and Jessica Stamp, the class is ranked No. 1 in the country by Soccer Buzz.

**Sept. 11, 2000** — UCLA moves into the top five of the NCSAA rankings for the first time in school history.

**Nov. 7, 2000** — Senior forward Tracey Milburn becomes just the second Bruin to be named Pac-10 Player of the Year.

**Nov. 25, 2000** — UCLA advances to the NCAA College Cup for the first time in school history, defeating Clemson, 2-1 in the NCAA Quarterfinals in Clemson, SC.

**Dec. 3, 2000** — Despite taking an early 1-0 advantage, UCLA falls to top-seeded North Carolina, 2-1 in the NCAA Final. The Bruins are the first Pac-10 team to play in the title match.

**Dec. 7, 2000** — UCLA is ranked No. 2 in the final NSCAA rankings, marking the Bruins' highest-ever national ranking.

**Dec. 10-11, 2000** — Current and former Bruins Skylar Little, Tracey Milburn, Louise Lieberman, Traci Arkenberg and Venus James are selected in the inaugural Women's United Soccer Association (WUSA) Draft. The league is around three years before suspending operations in September of 2003.

**Jan. 19, 2001** — Second year head coach Jillian Ellis is named the NSCAA/adidas National Coach of the Year after guiding the Bruins to the NCAA Final. She is the first Pac-10 women's soccer coach to receive the honor.

**Oct. 7, 2001** — Coming off an opening round victory over William & Mary, UCLA downs No. 25 Princeton, 2-0 to claim the first-ever UCLA Women's Cup title. Senior Stephanie Rigamat scored both Bruin goals in the win.

**Nov. 11, 2001** — In the final match of the regular season, UCLA gets a late goal from Staci Duncan, as the Bruins defeat Stanford, 1-0 to secure the school's third Pac-10 title.

**Feb. 13, 2002** — UCLA signs national high school player of the year Jill Oakes to a letter of intent.

**Sept. 28, 2002** — In an exhibition match at Drake Stadium, UCLA defeats the Mexican National Team, 2-1. Whitney Jones and Stacy Lindstrom score for UCLA, while Bruin forward Iris Mora (pictured), playing for Mexico, scores her team's lone goal.

**Nov. 23, 2002** — UCLA and Texas A&M meet in the third round of the NCAA Tournament at Drake Stadium. Despite outshooting the Aggies, 21-0, the seventh-seeded Bruins fall 3-1 on penalty kicks, ending their season with an 18-4 overall record.

**Nov. 6, 2003** — Junior Goalkeeper Sarah Lombardo becomes the first UCLA player in history to earn first-team Academic All-America honors.

**Dec. 5, 2003** — Playing in its second NCAA College Cup, UCLA falls to top-seeded North Carolina, 3-0 in a semifinal match at the SAS Soccer Park in Cary, NC.

**Dec. 3, 2004** — Playing in Cary, NC for the second year in a row, the 14th-seeded Bruins upset No. 7 Princeton, 2-0 in the NCAA Semifinals.

**Dec. 5, 2004** — In one of the most competitive finals in NCAA history, fourth-seeded Notre Dame edges UCLA, 1-1 (4-3 PKs) in the championship match. It marks the first-ever NCAA title match decided on penalty kicks.

**Nov. 11, 2005** — The Bruins set a new school record for goals scored against a Division-I opponent, defeating Mississippi Valley State, 9-0 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament at Drake Stadium.

**Nov. 25, 2005** — Sophomore midfielder Danesha Adams becomes just the second player in UCLA history to score four goals in one match, as the Bruins defeat second-seeded Virginia, 5-0 in an NCAA Quarterfinal showdown at Drake Stadium. The win is the Bruins' 21st victory of the season, breaking the school record of 20 set in 2001 and 2003.

**Dec. 4, 2005** — Two days after defeating Florida State, 4-0 in the NCAA Semifinals, UCLA faces top-seeded Portland for the national championship at Texas A&M's Aggie Soccer Stadium. The Bruins, who were playing in the final for the second year in a row and the third time in school history, fall 4-0. It marked the first time that UCLA gave up a goal during tournament play, as the Bruins entered the final by outscoring their opponents 25-0.

**Feb. 2, 2006** — UCLA signs what is considered one of the top-two recruiting classes in the nation, headlined by Gatorade National High School Player of the Year Lauren Cheney of Indianapolis, Ind.

**Aug. 16, 2006** — UCLA receives its first-ever No. 1 national ranking, as both *Soccer America* and *Soccer Buzz* list the Bruins as the top team in the nation to begin the year.

**Nov. 5, 2006** — UCLA clinches its fourth-straight Pac-10 title with a 4-0 victory at Oregon State in the final match of the regular season.

**Nov. 24, 2006** — After defeating UNLV, Cal State Fullerton and No. 16 Florida in early-round action, UCLA books its fourth-straight trip to the NCAA College Cup with a 2-1 home victory over No. 6 Portland in the quarterfinals. A second-half penalty kick from freshman Lauren Cheney is the game-winning goal.

**Dec. 1, 2006** — Eventual NCAA Champion and top-seeded North Carolina defeats UCLA, 2-0 in a semifinal showdown in Cary, NC.

**May 29, 2007** — Headlined by U.S. National Team standouts Lauren Barnes, Kylie Wright and Sarah Salazar, UCLA's 2007 recruiting class is ranked No. 1 in the nation by *Soccer Buzz Magazine*.

# TRAINING FACILITIES

## FRANK W. MARSHALL FIELD AT DRAKE STADIUM

The UCLA women's soccer team will begin its eighth year of play on Frank W. Marshall Field at Drake Stadium when the 2007 home season kicks off at the UCLA Women's Cup on Sept. 7. The Bruins, who went 16-0 at home last season, take a 27-match home unbeaten streak into the year.

The stadium, which has served as the on-campus home of the Bruin men's and women's track and field teams since 1969, took on a new look in the spring of 1999 when it was transformed into a state-of-the-art soccer/track & field facility. The stadium provides seating for 11,700 spectators. The cost of the project was \$1.5 million and was made possible by a lead gift from Frank Marshall and Kathleen Kennedy. Marshall is a longtime UCLA soccer fan and was a member of UCLA's first NCAA men's soccer team in 1967.

The grass infield, named the Frank W. Marshall Field, houses a regulation 75-yard by 120-yard soccer field. The UCLA men's and women's soccer teams use this field for competition and the adjacent North Athletic Field for practice. The Bruins previously played their games on the North Athletic Field, as well as on Spaulding Field and Murdock Stadium at El Camino College. UCLA's all-time record on Frank W. Marshall Field is 52-8-1.

Frank W. Marshall Field at Drake Stadium hosted its first-ever regular season soccer game on Sunday, Sept. 17, 2000 when the UCLA men defeated the University of San Francisco, 3-0. The UCLA women first played on the field on Oct. 15, 2000, defeating Oregon, 8-0 in front of 1,742 fans in attendance.

The past seven seasons, Frank W. Marshall Field has served as host of early-round NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament games. In fact, the Bruins take an 11-match NCAA home winning streak into the season. UCLA's last NCAA defeat at home was a third round loss to Texas A&M back in 2002.

## ACOSTA ATHLETIC TRAINING COMPLEX

The two-story Acosta Athletic Complex serves a variety of needs for UCLA's highly competitive intercollegiate athletics program. The Center, which was remodeled in 2006, features UCLA's Athletic Training and Rehabilitation Room, a Speed-Strength & Conditioning Room, Varsity Locker rooms, and The Bud Knapp Football Center. This state-of-the-art facility provides UCLA student-athletes and coaches all of the advantages needed to maximize athletic performance.

## NORTH ATHLETIC FIELD

In order to preserve the surface at Frank W. Marshall Field, both the UCLA men's and women's soccer teams do much of their training at the North Athletic Field, located right behind the John Wooden Athletic Center. Prior to moving to Drake Stadium in 2000, the women played matches at the North Athletic Field from 1993-99, posting a 23-10-5 overall record.

**DANIEL G. GUERRERO**

Director of Athletics

On April 25, 2002, former UCLA Chancellor Albert Carnesale announced that Daniel G. Guerrero had been named UCLA's eighth Director of Athletics, succeeding the retiring Peter Dalis. A former Bruin baseball player, Guerrero, who assumed his duties on July 1, 2002, exudes the pride of a student-athlete who is now calling the shots at his alma mater.

Guerrero, one of the most respected and talented administrators in intercollegiate athletics, has rapidly placed his mark on the program as the director of athletics at UCLA. He is currently serving as the chair of the NCAA's Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group. He is also a member of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee. In June, he was selected 2007 NACDA Division I West Region Athletic Director of the Year.

In his first five years, Guerrero has clearly established a pattern of "image and substance" that few in his profession can match. UCLA stands as the No. 1 University in the nation for NCAA Team Championships (100) won, a number that continues to grow under his direction. UCLA teams have won 14 NCAA national championships (the highest total in the nation in that span), finished second 12 times and have had an additional 17 Top Five finishes. A staggering 94 teams (of 115 possible) have qualified for NCAA post-season competition and the football team has appeared in five bowl games. The program has also won 32 conference championships in 14 different sports, produced 286 All-Americans and featured four Honda Award winners, including the 2003-04 Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year.

Furthermore, during the 2004 Summer Olympic Games in Athens, Greece, 57 Bruins participated as athletes or coaches, representing the United States and 13 other countries. They earned 19 medals, including eight gold medals.

Guerrero came to UCLA from UC Irvine, where he had served as UCI's fifth permanent Director of Athletics for 10 years (1992-2002). The broad competitive success of its athletic teams, the academic excellence of its student-athletes, the development of new and improved facilities and enhanced relations with the UCI community, reflect the progress UC Irvine Athletics experienced under Guerrero's direction. During his tenure, the program continued to accumulate conference championships, garner national rankings, feature graduation rates among the nation's best, and win numerous post-season honors for its student-athletes.

Ken Weiner enters his 14th year overseeing the business operations for the UCLA Athletic Department and is in his 28th year overall with the university.

His duties include the administration and supervision of six Bruin sport programs, including baseball, men's and women's soccer, women's swimming and diving, and men's and women's water polo. During his tenure at UCLA Athletics, his sports have garnered 12 national championships and numerous conference championship titles. He also oversees new business and project development and capital improvements for the department.

Weiner spearheaded the negotiations that resulted in a 20-year agreement between UCLA and the Rose Bowl, including much needed facilities improvements for the football program. In addition, he supervises the athletic facilities division, the operations of UCLA's sports practice and competition venues, game and event operations, department and team travel and UCLA Camps and Clinics.

Weiner is responsible for major capital improvements for Athletics. Project include the renovated J.D. Morgan Intercollegiate Athletics Center and Acosta Student Athlete Training Center and Knapp Football Center, the new Hall of Fame, the Jackie Robinson baseball and Easton softball clubhouse construction and stadium renovations, the Drake Track/Marshall Field renovation, a new golf practice facility, Pauley Pavilion interior upgrades and the North soccer field construction. Current projects underway include the buildout of the Olympic Sport Locker Rooms in the Acosta Center and new baseball field of play at Jackie Robinson Stadium.

The new Spieker Aquatic Center is scheduled to break ground in fall of 2008. Future projects include a major renovation of the historic Pauley Pavilion, upgrade of the baseball stadium clubhouse and practice facilities and construction of a new Academic Studies Center.

Weiner participates on a number of campus steering committees on behalf of Athletics, including the Campus Facilities Coordination, Campus Project Review and the Alumni Advisory Board. Weiner is a member of NACDA and IAAM. He has served on various committees for the NCAA, most recently as chairman of the Men's Water Polo Committee.

Prior to his appointment at UCLA Athletics, Weiner co-founded and served as Associate Director of the UCLA Central Ticket Office and continues to serve as the liaison between the Athletic Department and the CTO. Dr. Gene Block became chancellor of UCLA in summer 2007, taking the helm of a world-class institution comprising 37,000 students and 27,000 faculty and staff, with an annual budget of \$3.7 billion. As chief executive officer, he oversees all aspects of the university's three-part mission of education, research and service.

He also holds appointments on the UCLA faculty in the department of psychiatry and biobehavioral sciences in the David Geffen School of Medicine and in the department of physiological science in the College of Letters and Science.

Previously, Dr. Block served as vice president and provost of the University of Virginia, where he also held the Alumni Council Thomas Jefferson Professorship in Biology. With academic expertise in biological clocks, he conducts research on the neurobiology of circadian rhythms in higher organisms, leading a research lab funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH).

From 1991 to 2002, he directed the National Science Foundation's Science and Technology Center for Biological Timing. In 1997, he was named a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He has invented a number of devices and holds a patent for a non-contact respiratory monitor for the prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome.

Chancellor Block joined the faculty of the University of Virginia in 1978 as an assistant professor of biology. He served as vice provost for research from 1993 to 1998 and then as vice president for research and public service until his appointment as vice president and provost in 2001.

Dr. Block also headed an NIH graduate training program aimed at increasing the number of scientists from underrepresented groups. In 1998, he received the Commonwealth of Virginia's Outstanding Public Service Award for his work with Virginia's business community.

A native of Monticello, NY, Chancellor Block holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from Stanford University and a master's and Ph.D. in psychology from the University of Oregon. He also completed a postdoctoral fellowship at Stanford, working with the late Colin Pittendrigh, "the father of biological timing" and distinguished biologist Donald Kennedy, who later served as president of Stanford.

Dr. Block and his wife Carol have two adult children.
